## **Peak Vista's Breakfast of Champions to Feature Gary Hall, Jr. on November 12**

**COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo.** – Peak Vista Community Health Centers Foundation announced today that its annual fundraising event, the Breakfast of Champions, will feature Gary Hall, Jr. a five time Olympic Gold Medal swimmer, as keynote speaker.

“Gary has a unique health story to share,” said Pam McManus, President and CEO of Peak Vista Community Health Centers. “Right before the Olympic trials for the 2000 Games, he was diagnosed with Type I diabetes.” With support from his family, coach and a team of doctors and specialists, Hall made adjustments to his lifestyle and training regimen in order to continue his dream of competing in the Sydney Games. He won gold swimming the 50-meter freestyle in just under 22 seconds. In three Olympic Games, Hall won 10 medals and was inducted into the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame in 2012.

The 2015 Breakfast of Champions will be held on November 12 from 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. at the Broadmoor International Center. The Breakfast supports Peak Vista Community Health Centers, a non-profit organization which provides medical, dental and behavioral health services for working families, women, children, seniors and homeless individuals.
