For 47 years, Peak Vista Community Health Centers has been dedicated to creating healthier lives and continues to bridge health care and innovation to meet the needs of our communities by providing high-quality, compassionate care. With your ongoing support, Peak Vista proudly served over 92,000 patients in 2017.

2017 was a year of innovation at Peak Vista. We focused on identifying new internal approaches to address the shortage of primary care physicians in the United States. Our Education Health Initiative (EHI) consisted of a four-tier plan that began with Peak Vista's Family Medicine Residency program (FMR) focused on providing exceptional training and development for new physicians. This approach allowed us to begin the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) Primary Care Fellowship, providing opportunities for recently graduated APRNs to transition seamlessly from the academy to the clinical setting.

With the success of both FMR and APRN, Peak Vista was able to become a host clinic for the National Institute for Medical Assistant Advancement (NIMAA), an important new nonprofit training program that will help shape our health care workforce and we proudly adapted our own Grow Your Own (GYO) Dental Assistant Program – and accelerated program that includes a four-week didactic period and up to eight weeks of hands-on training with three expert trainers.

At Peak Vista, we will continue to utilize our strengths and the clarity of purpose – always putting the patient first. We are grateful for your unwavering support and will continue to challenge ourselves by striving to make the health care experience better for our patients, physicians and staff. By uniting the passion and commitment of Board Members, donors, community members and nonprofits, we can support healthier communities that will continue to change lives for years to come.

## WHO WE ARE

Peak Vista Community Health Centers is a leading advocate and health care provider for individuals and families with limited access to quality care in the Pikes Peak and East Central regions of Colorado. Quality health care is often defined as providing the health care services a patient needs, when they need it and in the right way. Our nearly 900 dedicated health care providers, clinical support staff and administrative professionals are committed to providing quality patient-centered medical, dental and behavioral health care in the communities we serve. Peak Vista is fortunate to be supported by many volunteers, partner agencies, grantors and donors who help us sustain our mission.

## WHAT WE DO

Peak Vista is dedicated to providing exceptional health care services in its 26 health centers spread across 20 service locations while maintaining fiscal accountability and responsibility. We leverage every dollar granted by the Federal government into \$9 of care. As the health care home for more than 92,000 patients, Peak Vista cares for an average of 1,400 patients daily, who live in nine counties in Colorado.

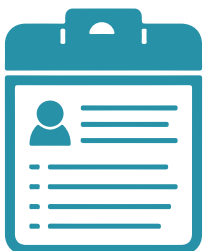

# ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSE (APRN) FELLOWSHIP

Peak Vista's Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) Primary Care Fellowship graduated its inaugural class of five Fellows in August 2016. The program exceeded expectations by providing four technically strong, mission-oriented Nurse Practitioners for Peak Vista and one for a sister FQHC in Olathe, Colorado. Peak Vista's second class of Fellows began in September 2017.



## FAMILY MEDICINE RESIDENCY (FMR) PROGRAM

With the support of numerous community partners, Peak Vista's Family Medicine Residency (FMR) program welcomed its second class of nine Residents in July 2017. After two weeks of orientation, the Residents began a series of rotations through a prescribed schedule of requirements. The Residency selection committee is currently interviewing and ranking its next class of Residents. First and second-year Residents are required to take a national comprehension academic test. Peak Vista's inaugural Residents scored above the national average.

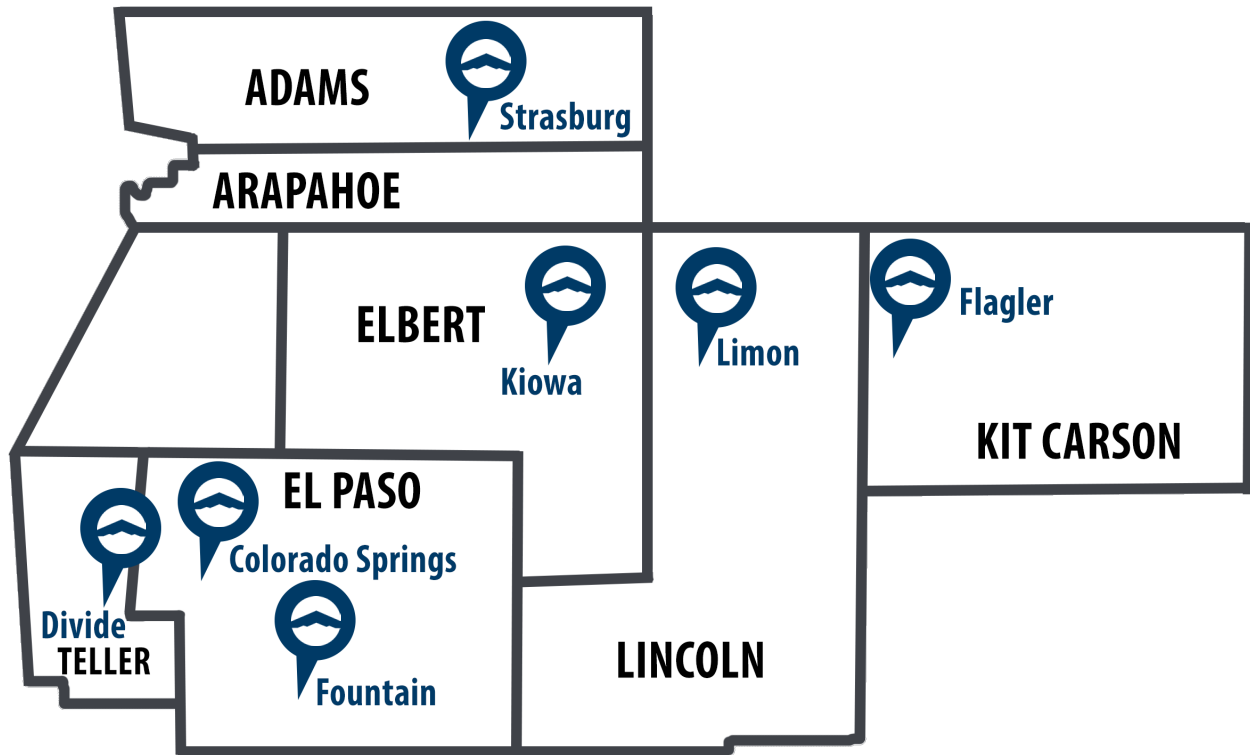
