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CRYOSURGERY

1. Within a few hours the treated areas will develop redness and swelling. Sometimes a blister will form. If the blister is painful or large, it may be drained using a sterile pin.
2. Gently clean the treated areas with soap and water and apply plain Vaseline Jelly or Polysporin Ointment; only if open wound develops. Apply a Band-Aid if needed.
3. Tylenol can be used for pain, but is often not needed.
4. The treatment site will often crust and peel as it heals. Please do not pick at the site of treatment.

Most growths should resolve after 2-3 weeks, except for warts, which often require multiple treatments. If the growth persists after a treatment, please call the office for further instructions.
