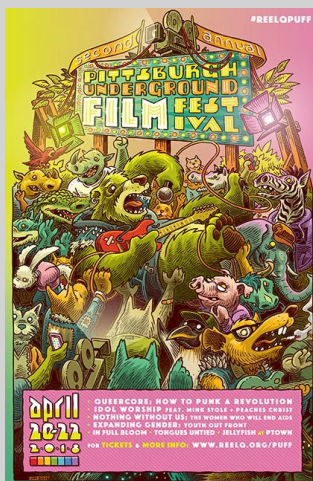


You're Invited: Allies Ball, April 21, 2018
