

IRA Qualified Charitable Distributions



ABOUT

Qualified Charitable Distributions, (QCDs) are a way to use IRA charitable giving for lasting community impact. Individuals ages 70 ½ or older may transfer funds directly from a traditional IRA to a qualified charitable organization. Rather than taking a taxable withdrawal, then making a donation, the funds move directly from the IRA to the charity.

BENEFITS

- Distributions excluded from gross income.
- Charitable gifts given from pre-taxed assets.
- Distributions can help satisfy a donor's Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs).
- Provides a convenient way for donors to support the charitable causes they care about.
- Provides necessary, sustainable support to GRC.
- Turns your retirement assets into meaningful, lasting impact in your community for generations to come.

NEXT STEPS

- Contact your IRA custodian: Ask for their Qualified Charitable Distribution Form or request instructions for making a charitable distribution.

- Complete the transaction by year-end to count for the current tax year, and toward your Required Minimum Distribution, if applicable.
