Pupil Distance (PD) Release

Because the "PD" is not part of an eye examination; neither techs nor doctors take this measurement. The pupil distance is used in the manufacturing of the lenses for eye glasses and is the responsibility of the person selling the glasses.

With the advent of online spectacle sales, we have concerns with the quality and safety of these lenses and frames especially in children. Foreign companies may not provide the safety measures that are standard in our country. Patients that choose to order eye glasses on line will need their "pupil distance" prior to placing their order.

PD with Spectacle verification and adjustment charge: \$30.00

Our fee will include measurement of the PD, glasses checked for appropriate fit, prescription verified and adjustments to the frame when necessary. (We will not be responsible for any breakage.)

PD's can be requested at the Optical Department.

I understand that eyeglasses made without proper measurements may not function as prescribed by your child's eye doctor.

Pupillary distance measurement changes with growth of the child. PD's should not be used beyond 1 year of the measurements.
