Frequently Asked Questions About Research

What is a clinical trial?

A clinical trial is a research study in which patients who volunteer are provided innovative, state-of-the-art health care. Study patients are given opportunities to gain access to new treatments that are not yet available to the public. Clinical trial participants play active roles in their health care while contributing to medical research with a goal of improving quality of life among patients battling their same condition.

What kinds of studies can I participate in?

Generally, there are four types of trials:

1. Prevention options.
2. New treatments or new ways to use existing treatments.
3. New screening and diagnostic techniques.
4. Options for improving the quality of life for people who have serious medical conditions.

Do I need medical insurance to participate in a study?

No medical insurance is necessary to participate in any clinical studies. All study medications and procedures are provided free of cost.

Am I compensated for participating in clinic trials?

Eligible participants will receive compensation for time and travel. Compensation varies from study to study.
