



Protect your crew, get vaccinated against two!

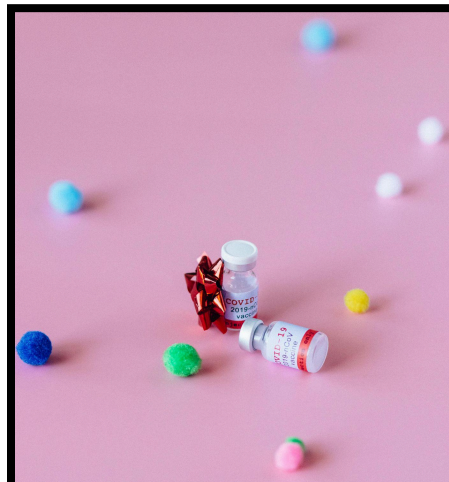
You've come this far keeping everyone healthy and don't want COVID or the flu to be the thing that brings your family down. Activities through school or sports and upcoming holiday travel and get togethers mean we're getting together for good times. COVID and flu vaccination protects kids and teens so they're less likely to have serious illness.

We have had so many families get vaccinated at CAP so far! Thank you for protecting your family and your community! We have many openings at upcoming vaccine only clinics in the next 2 months. We anticipate flu and COVID illness to peak during the upcoming holiday season, so we encourage you and your family to get vaccinated before Thanksgiving!

Important notes:

- Flu and COVID vaccines are SEPARATE injections. There is NO combo vaccine. Our flu vaccine is Flulaval (GSK). Our COVID vaccine is Pfizer.
- All existing patients 6 months and older can get either/ both flu and COVID vaccines.
- Parents can only get flu vaccine. We are not vaccinating grandparents or other adult caregivers.
- All eligible patients will be offered flu and COVID vaccines at well visits and med checks. You can also discuss with your provider if your child is well enough to receive their vaccines at a sick visit.
- Well visits or med checks will be offered up to 2 family members to get vaccines. You will be asked during your preregistration of your child's visit if you want up to 2 family members to also get vaccines. We cannot add on more than 2. You must complete preregistration > 24 hours before your scheduled visit.

BEYFORTUS

Beyfortus (nirsevimab) is the FDA approved long acting monoclonal antibody given as a single intramuscular injection to prevent respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) infection and associated hospitalizations.

Who is eligible?

- Infants < 8 months old born during or entering their first RSV season *and* mother did not receive Abrysvo > 2 weeks before baby was born *and* infant has not previously received Beyfortus.
- Children ages 8-19 months who are at increased risk of severe RSV disease, reviewed by your provider, and entering their 2nd RSV season.

What is CAP's plan for launching Beyfortus this season?

- If your infant or child has an upcoming well visit and is of an eligible age, you will be offered Beyfortus at your visit.
- You *cannot* use our normal website self-schedule buttons. If your child is eligible but does not have a well visit coming up, please request an appointment [here](#).
- Your child may NOT receive Beyfortus at a flu/ COVID clinic or a nurse visit for other catch-up vaccines.
- Ongoing administration will depend upon supply.
- We will NOT be able to administer to children who do not meet criteria.
- At your visit, you will be asked to stay for 15 minutes after the injection for observation.

Please do NOT call the office to ask about availability or to schedule flu vaccine, COVID vaccine or Beyfortus. We need our phone lines open for urgent concerns. What you see on the self-schedule calendar is what is available at that moment!
