Re: COMPLIANCE OF TRITHOR® TERMITE PROTECTION WITH THE BUILDING CODE OF AUSTRALIA AND AUSTRALIAN STANDARDS.

I am writing to provide advice on the compliance TRITHOR with respect to recent changes to the Building Code of Australia and the manner in which it references various Australian Standards.

TRITHOR TERMITE PROTECTION meets the performance requirements of the *Australian Standard AS 3660 Termite Management, Part 3 Assessment criteria for termite management systems; Second edition AS 3660.3:2014*. This is the Standard now recognised by the Building Code of Australia.

Appropriate data confirming compliance has been reviewed and accepted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA); and the Australian Building Codes Board (ABCB) who have approved it under their CodeMark™ program. Compliance with CodeMark confirms TRITHOR meets the Building Code of Australia (BCA) requirements, and that expert review has considered the data generated remains compliant with the updated Australian Standard 2014 version of the Standard.

The Standard AS 3660.3 recognises thAPVMA as the Pesticides Registrar, the government body responsible for the registration of pesticides and assigned with the responsibility to coordinate the registration scheme.
