# **INTRO**

Established in 2002, Tom Dixon is a British luxury design brand which is represented in 90 countries. Specialising in furniture, lighting and accessories, Tom Dixon has hubs in London, Milan, Hong Kong, New York, Tokyo, Hangzhou, Beijing and Shanghai. With an aesthetic that is intrinsically inspired by the brand's British roots, the products are internationally recognised and appreciated for their pioneering use of materials and techniques.

Founder and eponymous Creative Director Tom Dixon is a restless innovator who rose to prominence in the mid-1980s as a maverick, untrained designer with a line in welded salvage furniture.


While working with the Italian giant Cappellini he designed the widely acclaimed 'S' Chair. In the late 90s Tom became Creative Director at Habitat and rejuvenated the brand while maintaining Terence Conran's vision of enriching everyday life through simple, modern design.

In 2001, Tom was awarded an OBE by Her Majesty the Queen for his services to British design. In 2014 he was awarded 'Designer of The Year' at Maison & Objet, Paris. In 2019, he received a silver medal for Best Garden at the RHS Chelsea Flower Show and in the same year, was awarded the prestigious London Design Medal at the British Land Celebration of Design Awards.

Tom is one of the industry's most feted British designers and is internationally heralded as a significantly original talent.

Best-selling products such as Beat, Melt, S-Chair and Wingback are instantly recognisable and have been acquired by the world's most famous museums including the Victoria & Albert Museum, London; MOMA, New York; and the Centre Pompidou, Paris.

## **LED**



Beat incandescent vs. Beat LED output

It has taken one hundred years for electro luminescence to become THE revolution that has reshaped the lighting world.

Ten years ago, LED lighting was seen as ugly, expensive and unsophisticated. Yet through government legislation, technological innovation, mass-production and the designing of new and inventive lighting objects, we have seen a sustainable revolution in luminosity.

For any designer, when technology progresses, new possibilities appear and we have embraced the LED on many levels. It allows us to design new shapes, to illuminate in a different way than was previously imaginable, and just as importantly, to make lights that use 80% less electricity.


When it comes to sustainability there is still a lot of work that needs to be done but one story

that is worth telling is LED. Although the underpinning technology has been around for almost a hundred years - it was in 1962 that the present format was patented – it has taken another 50 years for the price and quality of light to become acceptable to the consumer.

Recognising the demand and need for a more energy efficient future, in 2019, we introduced the latest in high performance LED technology to our expanding lighting range. A custommade Tom Dixon LED ring and driver module was integrated into our existing best seller Melt and launched into two new collections, Spring and Opal.

In 2021, we have continued the upgrade and introduced the LED module into Beat, Copper, Mirror Ball and Void.



# **BURST**



For many years we have been making bigger clusters of pendant lamps, which seem to be replacing more conventional chandeliers in lobbies, in dining rooms or in entrance halls.

Burst is a way of getting an even more dynamic and three-dimensional array of lighting, without lots of dangling wires.

It's intended for filling larger spaces and ceiling voids and it was inspired by an interest in molecular structures and the forward-thinking space age.


With its chrome or copper aesthetic and geometric configuration, this enormous lighting fixture is of heroic proportions and impossible to ignore.

Large in scale and highly reflective, Burst is made up of 12 spherical orbs which explode from a single point construction to create a spectacular chandelier, available in copper and chrome finishes.



Intended to create an extravagantly proportioned spotlight that could warm the greenish hue of early LEDs and create a more appealing luminosity, the Copper shade is an over-sized, blow moulded and perfectly reflective globe that kick started the craze for copper in interiors the world over.

The Copper shade is created by exploding a thin layer of pure metal onto the surface of a polycarbonate globe. Copper then achieves its perfect mirror finish by the technical process of vacuum metallisation.

The Copper family includes 25cm and 45cm diameter round pendants and a wide pendant in copper and black finishes.





We are obsessed with spherical objects. In our perpetual quest for the purest forms, Globe stands out as the most minimal of the lot.

A spherical orb, highly mirrored and perfectly reflective during the day, when switched on reveals a multiplicity of internal reflections from the integral LED.

Reminiscent of ancient witch balls, hollowed spheres of coloured glass which were used to ward off evil spirits, Globe is available in copper and chrome finishes in pendant form, a floor light and a spectacular chandelier, Burst.



# **MELT**






Obsessed with the idea of creating an imperfect, organic and naturalistic lighting object, Melt was created in collaboration with Front, a Swedish design collective.

With Melt, our experiments in the technologically advanced field of vacuum metallisation takes on a new twist.

The light bouncing and reflecting around the uneven surfaces creates an attractive, mildly hallucinogenic light, akin to molten glass, the interior of a melting glacier, or images of deep space.

The latest additions to the Melt family include the Melt large chandelier, a configuration of seven organic and imperfect orbs which explode from a central hub to create a dynamic lighting sculpture of infinite reflections.



# **MIRROR BALL**

Sometimes your biggest failure could be your biggest success. For Mirror Ball, the aim was to produce a completely spherical, highly mirrored object that would disappear into its surroundings.

Instead, it does the opposite and is an ultra-visible, highly reflective object that mirrors its environment. One of the most identifiable Tom Dixon products, inspired by the famous space helmet and by disco balls.

Mirror Ball is lightweight yet robust and is created through a process of blow moulding and vacuum metallisation to achieve perfect spheres with abundant and unusual luminosity.











## **OPAL**





Opal is a family of translucent globes using our own custom recipe of tinted white opalescent polycarbonate.

Opal Pendants, Opal Cone Floor Light and Cork Dining Table

Semi translucent, they maintain an ethereal ghostliness in the daylight and at night form a perfectly illuminated sphere.


Coupled with our Tom Dixon LED, the OPAL range emits a soft, diffused and flattering light. The softness of the lightbulb shape is achieved through a blow-moulded custom combination of opalescent plastic. This process works to achieve an organic form as well a delicate translucency.



# **BEAT**






Hand spun from solid sheets of brass; the interior of each piece bears the beaten marks of its maker. The creation of each Beat light is part of an ancient process that takes four days to complete.

Our Beat lights are recognised in homes, restaurants and hotels the world over and are available in a range of pendants, floor and table lights. The finishes include: black with a brass interior, brushed brass with a brass interior and white with a brass interior.



## **SPRING**





SPRING is a series of pendant lamps made up of stainless-steel strips.

Pliant ribbons of stainless steel have been arranged like a whisk around our custom-made dimmable Tom Dixon LED module.


The semi-transparent shape thus created can be adjusted to a variety of silhouettes - from a flat arrangement reminiscent of a spirograph drawing, to a flying saucer configuration and on to a fuller shape akin to a pumpkin.

# **VOID LED**





Semi-precious metals pressed, spun and brazed into complex double-walled shades, Void is the result of a challenge to create a luminous pendant that mysteriously conceals its light source.


Inspired by vacuum flasks, Void is made from pure metal formed into a complex doublewalled shade.


They are then hand polished to a mirror finish before being applied with a lacquer to maintain the high gloss finish.





Aptly named Sphere, Cone and Surface, the shapes of Press are reminiscent of shipping buoys and children's toys.

The ribbed glass creates diffusion of the light source and projects linear and stripy patterns.


Bold in silhouette and simple in function they are manufactured by dropping massive globs of molten glass at 1,200 degrees centigrade, pressed in iron moulds under tons of pressure to create immensely durable lights.

Press Surface light is rated IP55 and is suitable for installation in living areas, bathroom Zone 2 and sheltered outdoor areas.





#### The Mass family is proudly manufactured in the UK and made from one single extruded box section of brass.

By using the most familiar unit in furniture construction – the plank – and presenting a series of familiar objects in a highly polished gold hued metal, Tom Dixon manages to make domestic archetypes into monumental heavyweight sculpture.

The rectangular plank is used in a multitude of configurations and will eventually be presented as a made to measure construction set, with a series of predetermined junctions that allow architects and interior designers the liberty to construct their own Mass artefact.

The new and improved Mass family is a development from the previous Mass products, which were made of brass-clad mango wood. The new solid brass products have been designed with longevity in mind and are made with a noble material which will stand the test of time.

In the Mass collection, you will see a series of experiments in materiality and repetition, where Tom's current obsession with basic units multiplied is turned into an abundance of sculptural experiments in function.

Designed in London and engineered in the Southwest countryside, in Dorset by skilled metalworkers, the Mass collection also includes a Console Table, 2M Table, Coat Stand and Bookshelf.







#### **FAT**



Fat, our upholstery chair range is designed to hug the body and allows for multiple sitting positions.

The extreme simplicity of the components is a testament to form following function, whilst maintaining a humorous silhouette and a reductionist aesthetic. Quite a balancing act.

Fat is made from moulded foam with a metal leg in high gloss black lacquer and made to order upholstery. Manufactured in Europe, hand finished and upholstered by experienced craftsmen. The Fat family has expanded with the launch of 2-Seater and 3-Seater Sofas, Bar Stool and Chaise Longue now available.





#### **WINGBACK**

Wingback was inspired by traditional 17th century Wingback and balloonback archetypes and was developed for the Shoreditch House Member's Club.

Its expressive sweeping curves allows designers to specify Wingback in the centre of spaces as a sculptural intervention rather than merely a piece of seating.

The wings provide convenient acoustic protection for mobile phone use and a headrest for quick snoozes.







A tactile material which has been used for millennia in nautical, construction, apparel and food applications, Cork is the ultimate traditional material fit for the future.



A family of candleholders, bookends, vases and tables, each with their own distinct silhouette, colouration and personality.



Press is a series of heavyweight grooved vases, bowls and candleholders made of fat, chunky coils of pure and clear transparent glass.





## **TANK**



Tank takes its sculptural cue from the functional shapes and volumes of scientific glassware.

Minimal yet decorative for a multiplicity of purposes of drinking, pouring, storing and displaying food and drink, the range forms bold building blocks of table-top architecture.

Tank is made from mouth-blown clear glass, finished with the same precision as cut crystal.

Our adventures in glass originate in the lab, with the curiosities of conical shapes and scientific apparatus. Ultra-simple and rigorously functional, the traditional lab kit is an underlying influence across our tabletop glassware.

Each object is ornamented with real liquid gold and colourants, hand-painted with our signature copper detailing and our logo is sand-blasted on the base.





## **FOG**





For a long time, Tom wanted to go beyond the realm of candles and diffusers and explore different methods of scenting the home, and Fog is his first experiment in incense.


Brew recognises coffee making as a form of art and coffee drinking as one of our few remaining contemporary rituals.
