All members of the meeting were informed about the change in project organisation. Rauni Jaskari will replace Tero Reunanen as the content leader from 1.8.2018. Tero will deliver relevant information to Rauni before change-over.

2. Company visits done in Turku region.

Several companies has been visited and interviewed in Turku Region by Rauni and Tero. Several issues has been raised during visits.

- Engineering companies prefer to have mechanical engineer education added to model so would participate.
- Contracting studies has been an issue as long term temporary contracts are very binding for companies' point of view. Agreement cannot be permanent as fixed cannot be stopped. Company proposals has been that student would work for university.
- How the holidays are planned?
- How students are paid during the studies? How it is affecting to government support for students? Committing companies to the piloting phase.
- As a summary ENGINE model needs to be developed based on feedback given by the companies and taken into consideration TUAS possibilities and Finnish legislations regarding the studies.
- Jassi will add the questionnaire results to the workspace on week 25.

### 3. Proposal for the ENGINE model

Tero presented the proposal for the Engine Curriculum. Study plan is four years. In the beginning their studies students will spend three days at university and two days at company. Later more time is spent at the company. Tero will upload the proposed model to Radical workspace.

Ludger Schneider-Störmann commented that two party contract with student and company would give stronger commitment from the company as it is in Aschaffenburg.
