Processed categories of personal data and storage time of personal data	Personal data processed in relation to private individuals and storage time: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• name, email and company• newsletter language: Finnish, English If a private individual unsubscribes a newsletter or another marketing communication order, they will be automatically erased from the system.
Regular information sources	In terms of private individuals, personal data is gathered from the newsletter subscription form and through a separate consent by the individual.

<p>Receivers and receiver groups or personal data</p>	<p>Personal data are processed in information systems, the technical maintenance of which is handled by the following parties:</p> <p>Microsoft Apsis</p> <p>Turku University of Applied Sciences and the above mentioned parties have an agreement according to which the parties act as personal data processors.</p>
<p>Essential information regarding transmitting of data to third countries (outside the EU or ETA countries)</p>	<p>Data will not be transmitted outside the EU and ETA.</p>
<p>Principles of data protection of the register</p>	<p>In the information systems relating to operations, users have personal access rights to the systems. The user rights are restricted according to tasks and roles. Separate instructions regarding data processing are provided.</p> <p>The servers maintained by Turku University of Applied Sciences are located in secured and monitored premises.</p>
<p>Data subject rights and responsibilities</p>	<p>As set out in the GDPR, data subjects have the right:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to access the data held about them by the data controller unless otherwise expressly provided by law • to review the personal data held about them by the data controller and have any inaccurate or incomplete data revised • to have their data erased (not applicable if the lawful basis for processing personal data is legal obligation or public interest) • to restrict the processing of their personal data • to object to the processing of their personal data if the lawful basis for processing personal data is public interest or legitimate interest • to request the transfer of personal data, which they have submitted to the data controller, to another data controller if the lawful basis for processing personal data is consent or contract • to withdraw their consent for processing their personal data • to be notified of the rectification or erasure of their data or the restriction of processing their data

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In addition, data subjects shall have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing (data subjects may give separate consent for automated decision-making) <p>Personal data will not be used for profiling purposes. We describe the processing activities undertaken during the CICAT2025 project as clearly and transparently as possible in this privacy policy and will strive to further develop this policy. We will notify data subjects of any changes that affect their rights under this policy as prescribed by law. Data subjects may exercise their rights by contacting the contact person or data protection officer identified above.
