

TX-E Connect - Outdoor

1. Product Overview

The TX-E Connect - Outdoor is a water-resistant, pole or wall-mountable NAT router bridging Wi-Fi HaLow (IEEE 802.11ah) and 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi networks. It delivers reliable wireless links up to 1 km using Wi-Fi HaLow while remaining compatible with standard Wi-Fi devices.

Either radio can act as the network uplink, with the other serving as a local access point for up to 10 devices. Uplink mode configured through tx-e.com.au/setup.

- Wi-Fi HaLow range up to 1 km (line of sight)
- Supports up to 10 simultaneous client connections
- USB Type-C powered
- Pole or Wall-mountable ASA enclosure, brackets included

- Operating temperature: -20°C to +75°C
