UCFACTS

SETTING THE SCENE

- Fresh off a road win, the Knights return home for a war, the War on I-4 to be exact.
- UCF remains in third place in the American Athletic Conference standings and will look to stay there against rising South Florida, which sits in a tie for fourth in the standings.
- At 17-5, it is UCF's best 22-game start since the 2003-04 campaign and at 7-3 in league play, it's the Knights' best ever 10-game start to AAC action.

THE WAR ON I-4

- UCF and South Florida square off on Wednesday in one of two games this season as part of the annual War On I-4 Rivalry Series.
- The Knights have defeated the Bulls each of the last six times out, but South Florida owns a 22-15 advantage in the all-time series.
- Last season, UCF won 71-69 in Tampa and 72-57 in Orlando.
- UCF, which has won the department-wide War On I-4 series each of the last two seasons, currently leads the third annual series by a score of 30-6 with three more points on the line Wednesday.

HOLDING THE LEAD

- The veteran group for UCF has been solid in holding a lead in 2018-19.
- UCF is a perfect 17-0 when leading with two minutes remaining in the game.
- Conversely, the Knights are 0-5 when tied or trailing with two minutes left on the clock.

AWESOME AUBREY

- Aubrey Dawkins has been named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week twice, and earned American Weekly Honor Roll accolades once this season.
- He is currently second on the team and 11th in The American with 15.5 points per game.
- Dawkins is also second on the team 5.3 rebounds per game.
- His 78.9 percent mark from the free throw line leads the Knights and ranks seventh in the AAC.
- Dawkins scored in double figures in his first 18 games as a Knight, the first player to do so in UCF's Division I era, and has scored in double figures in 20 of 22 games this season.
- He went for a season-high 26 points on 9-of-12 shooting in Sunday's win at SMU.

OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

- Known for their defense the last few years under Johnny Dawkins, the Knights have been extremely efficient offensively in 2018-19.
- UCF leads The American in field goal percentage, shooting 46.8 percent from the floor.
- The Knights have shot over 50 percent seven times and under 40 percent just twice this season.
- In the win over Temple on Jan. 2, the Knights shot a season-high 60.4 percent from the field.

The War On I-4 dates back to 1972 when UCF and South Florida first met on the hardwood. On Feb. 22, 1972 the Bulls won 115-96 in Tampa.

South Florida dominated the series for a while, winning 18 of the first 22 matchups between the two teams. The Knights' first win in the series was on Nov. 30, 1974.

UCF began to get back in it, winning three out of four between 2008 and 2012, and have dominated since both teams joined the American Athletic Conference.

The Knights have won eight out of 10 games played since the 2013-14 season, including each of the last six. The Bulls' last victory was near the end of the 2014-15 season in Tampa.

Last year, the Knights won 71-69 in Tampa and 72-57 in Orlando to sweep the season series.

The UCF Athletics Department as a whole has won the War On I-4 Rivalry Series each of the first two years of its official existence.

This year, the Knights currently lead the series 30-6 with three more points up for grabs on Wednesday.

KNIGHT NOTES

DOMINATING DEFENSE

- It's the defense that has dominated under Dawkins though, holding opponents to a combined 38.10 percent from the floor the previous two seasons, which led the nation during that time.
Only two teams in the nation were ranked in the top six in scoring defense in both 2016-17 and 2017-18, UCF and Virginia.
The Knights led the nation in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to 36.5 percent, and in 2017-18 they ranked third in the nation in scoring defense at 61.7.
UCF ranks second in The American in field goal percentage defense (39.5) and third in scoring defense (64.5), having held seven opponents to less than 60 points.
The Knights are 9-0 when allowing 63 points or less and 7-0 when holding opponents to less than 36 percent shooting from the field.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- A veteran group, UCF is one of the best in the nation at not turning the ball over, ranking 20th in all of NCAA Division I with just 257 turnovers.
With 11.7 turnovers per game, the Knights would destroy the program record for fewest turnovers per game in a season if it ended today (13.0).
UCF has had five games this season with single digit turnovers, including a season-best of six against Stetson.

BIG SHOT BARRY

- BJ Taylor has led UCF in scoring each of his three seasons on the court, and now his 16.7 points per game leads the Knights and ranks seventh in The American in 2018-19.
The Orlando native was named the Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason First Team All-Conference in The American.
If he continues pace, Taylor could become the first player in UCF's D1 era to average 15+ points per game in three consecutive seasons.
With a knack of getting to the line, Taylor ranks fifth all-time at UCF with 397 free throws and is 22nd in the nation this season with 128 free throws made.
He also ranks ninth all-time with 288 assists and ninth with 160 three-pointers.
Over the last two games, Taylor has totaled 14 assists and just two turnovers.

TAYLOR ALREADY IN THE CLUB

- Taylor became the 19th player in UCF history to join the 1,000-Point Club when he achieved the feat Feb. 21, 2018 at Tulsa.
Taylor scored 1,000 points in just 66 games, believed to be the third fastest in UCF's Division I history behind Ken Leeks (1988-92) and Darryl Davis (1991-95).
He now has 1,459 in his career, passing former teammate Matt Williams, Marcus Jordan and most recently D'Quarius Stewart for ninth place in program history.
Taylor is one of just four players in UCF history to rank in the top 10 in program history in both points and assists.

TACKO TIME

- Tacko Fall leads The American and ranks 10th in the nation with 2.64 blocks per game.
He also leads the league with a 76.2 field goal percentage and would lead the nation if he made enough field goals per game to qualify.
Accumulating 253 blocks in his career, Fall has taken over the all-time lead in career blocks at UCF, passing Keith Clanton (227).
The 7-foot-6 center was named to the Myrtle Beach Invitational's All-Tournament Team and was on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Preseason Watch List for the nation's best center.
The Knights are 12-1 this season when Fall scores in double figures.
Fall became the 20th member of UCF's 1,000-Point Club with 13 points against Houston.

FALL FACTS

- Among the 40 tallest living human beings in the world.
At 7-foot-6, he is the tallest player in NCAA Division I basketball and taller than any NBA player.
Hand Length: 10.5 inches | Wingspan: 8 feet, 4 inches | Shoe Size: 22
Successfully won all 22 tipoffs this season and each of the last 26 dating back to last season.

BATTLING ON THE BOARDS

- The Knights hold a slight +1.3 advantage in rebounds over their opponents, but when they're doing it well it leads to wins.
UCF is 13-0 on the season when outrebounding its opponent, and 15-0 when matching or bettering its opponent's rebound total.
The Knights rank fifth in the league with 36.8 rebounds per game, but are just eighth in rebounding defense, allowing 35.5 per contest.

KNIGHT NOTES

MR. SMITH GOES TO THE HOLE

- Collin Smith has been a key contributor in his first season on the court for the Knights, starting all but one game.
- The 6-foot-11 versatile forward is fourth on the team with 8.3 points per game and third with 5.2 rebounds per contest.
- After starting the year 13-of-30, has shot 34-of-44 (77.3%) from the free throw line since Dec. 2
- Scored a season-high 18 points, dished out a career-high five assists and grabbed 10 boards for his third double-double of the season in the win at SMU.

TERRELL TERRIFIC

- Terrell Allen has had a stellar 2018-19 campaign, averaging 6.8 points and ranking seventh in the American with 4.0 assists per game.
- Allen also ranks fourth in the league and 20th in the nation with a 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- He has had at least four assists in all but seven games this season.
- Allen is shooting lights out beyond the arc, converting 19 of his 42 attempts on the year.
- The point guard had a career day in the win over Saint Joseph's in the semifinal of the Myrtle Beach Invitational, scoring a career-high 22 points on a career-best four three-pointers.

BEATEN BY BUZZER

- The Knights are 17-5 on the season, but two of their five losses came from buzzer-beaters.
- The Black and Gold's first loss was to FAU as an Owl airball led to a buzzer-beating putback with no time on the clock.
- The team's second non-conference defeat was on the road at Missouri, which needed a three-pointer with no time left on the clock to send the game into overtime.

FASTEST TO FIFTY

- With the win over Grambling State, Johnny Dawkins eclipsed 50 victories as the head coach at the University of Central Florida.
- He is the fastest head coach to 50 wins in UCF's Division I era.
- Dawkins has won 216 games in his career overall.

LIVING IN THE 90S

- UCF scored 90 or more points in back-to-back wins over Georgia Southern and Stetson, putting up 95 against Georgia Southern and 90 in the victory over Stetson.
- It marked the first time the Knights had put up 90 points in back-to-back games since the 2013-14 season.
- The 95 points against Georgia Southern were the most ever for a Johnny Dawkins coached UCF team and the most by any Knights team since putting up 101 against Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 22, 2015.

DAWKINS DOUBLE

- This season there is double the Dawkins for UCF, as Coach Dawkins' son Aubrey is healthy and available to play for the 2018-19 campaign.
- A transfer from Michigan, where he started 22 games over two years, averaging 6.7 points per game, Dawkins sat out 2016-17 and then missed all of 2017-18 due to injury.
- Dawkins has been named among the best players in the American Athletic Conference heading into this season and one of the best transfer players in the nation.

TALKIN' DAWKINS

- After the win on opening night, Johnny Dawkins now has over 200 wins in his career, having spent eight seasons at the helm of the Stanford Cardinal before arriving in Orlando.
- The former Naismith Player of the Year at Duke also coached under his former Coach, Mike Krzyzewski, from 1998 to 2008.
- After his first season at UCF, Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Ben Jobe and Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year awards.

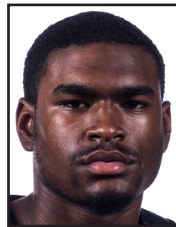

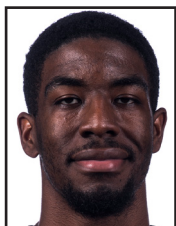

Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016 and has had immediate success in his first two seasons with the Knights.

Dawkins took over a 12-18 squad that hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13 and led the Knights to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever – in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion

SMU in the semifinals.

A season full of firsts, UCF hosted its first NIT game in 2016-17, defeating Colorado for the program's first ever win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first ever sell-out crowd at CFE Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final Four.

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all of NCAA Division I in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year.

Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards his first season at UCF, but he also guided a number of his players to accomplishments along the way.

2016-17 Individual Honors

- Tacko Fall was named The American Defensive Player of the Year, Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America, and finalist for Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award
- B.J. Taylor earned Second Team All-Conference honors from The American after leading UCF with 17.4 points per game
- Matt Williams set new UCF records for three-pointers in a career, in a season and in a game, before signing a professional contract with the Miami Heat

In year two at the helm, Dawkins had to deal with significant injuries to his three best players. His son, Aubrey Dawkins, missed the entire season with a shoulder injury, B.J. Taylor missed the first half of the season, and Tacko Fall missed the second half of the year. Taylor and Fall only played one game together.

Through the injuries, Dawkins led the Knights to a 19-13 record, second only to his first season record in the last five years of UCF Basketball.

The team also had a number of firsts in year two under Dawkins.

- First win over Memphis on the road

And the defense was as good as ever in Dawkins' second year coaching the Black and Gold.

In two years, Johnny Dawkins has led UCF to new heights on the basketball court, but he has done an even better job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team GPA over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history. They then did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 this spring.

STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.



DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. He also currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, an independent committee of current and former coaches, charged with promoting ethical conduct through leadership, education and mentoring opportunities, while identifying key issues challenging the coaching community.
