UCFACTS

- >> After starting 2018 with two wins before missing the week three game due to Hurricane Florence, the Knights enter the fourth week of the season still holding the nation's longest winning streak at 15 games. A victory over FAU would give UCF the American Athletic Conference record for consecutive wins with 16.
- >> At 13-0, last season marked UCF's first ever perfect campaign and the Knights broke the program record for consecutive victories, previously winning nine in a row during the 2013 season.
- >> At the helm for UCF is new head coach Josh Heupel. Heupel begins his first stint as a head coach after leading Missouri's offense to new heights over the last two years as the Tigers' offensive coordinator. The former Oklahoma All-American also spent time as the Sooners' offensive coordinator from 2011-14.
- >> The Knights have started 2-0 under Heupel, winning at UConn and then taking out FCS opponent South Carolina State in week two. UCF is currently second in the nation in total offense (609.0) and fifth in the nation in scoring defense (8.5) after shutting out the Bulldogs.
- >> A trio of UCF safeties came up with interceptions in week two's win over South Carolina State. Richie Grant's pick was his second in as many game after being named to The American's Weekly Honor Roll following his first career interception at UConn.
- >> The Knights rose in the AP Top 25 Poll withouth playing, climbing to 16th while remaining at 18th in the Amway Coaches Poll, keeping UCF as the highest ranked team in the state of Florida and in The American.
- >> The UCF offense led the nation in scoring with 48.2 points per game last season. Having scored 30 or more points in each of their 13 games, and now the first two of 2018, the Knights own the longest current streak of games with 30+ points at 15.

LAST TIME OUT

In front of the third-largest home-opening crowd in school history, UCF moved to 2-0 on the season with a 38-0 victory over South Carolina State (0-2) Saturday night at Spectrum Stadium. UCF fans filled nearly every seat in the house to the tune of 43,269, including a large boisterous group of students.

That crowd was treated to the first shutout by a Knight defense since the 2016 season-opener. Ironically, that contest was also a 38-0 victory over South Carolina State.

On Saturday, the Knights' defense created three turnovers for the second straight week. A trio of interceptions from Richie Grant, Kyle Gibson and Antwan Collier - helped keep the Bulldogs off the scoreboard. In addition to the takeaways, Black and Gold defenders accounted for 11 tackles behind the line of scrimmage, including 4 sacks. Titus Davis and Brendon Hayes tallied sacks, as did defensive backs Nevelle Clarke and Rashard Causey.

The Knights' offense had its own fair share of turnovers, also giving up three interceptions. Despite the miscues, UCF still racked up 566 yards of total offense, averaged 6.3 yards per play and scored plenty of points.

The Knights were also successful in the third phase of the game. A.J. Wooten blocked a field goal attempt, which helped preserve the shutout and also allowed Gibson to return the ball deep into South Carolina State territory. Otis Anderson returned the first South Carolina State punt of the game 48 yards to the Bulldogs' 39-yard line. Three plays later, Adrian Killins scored the first of his two rushing touchdowns to put the Knights up 7-0.



ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

UCFASTER

- >> The Knights have scored on 14 of their 22 possessions this season (not including) end-ofhalf, running-out-the clock scenarios. That's a rate of 64 percent.
- >> The Knights scored touchdowns on eight of their nine possessions last week (excluding end-of-half, run-out-the clock scenarios).
- >> Of UCF's 14 scoring drives, 13 have taken less than 2:39 off the clock.
- >> Four of the Knights' scoring drives vs. South Carolina State took less than 45 seconds.

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- >> As a department, UCF has gone 10+ years (21 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+.
- >> This past spring, UCF Athletics posted a department-record 3.33 grade-point average. Last spring, more than 73 percent of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a 3.0 or better, with 34 percent earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 41 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
- >> The Knights' football team boasts a 984 NCAA Academic Progress Rate score. That ranks UCF No. 14 among all FBS institutions and No. 7 among public, non-military schools.
- >> As a department, UCF's NCAA Graduation Success Rate is at 94 percent. In the November ranking, UCF was No. 7 in the nation among FBS institutions. For four straight years, the Knights have boasted the best GSR among NCAA Division I FBS public institutions.

THESE GUYS ARE OFFENSIVE

- >> UCF boasted the No. 1 scoring offense in the nation, averaging 48.2 points per game in 2017. After Week 2 this season, UCF is No. 15, averaging 47.0 points per game.
- >> The Knights have now scored **30+ points in 15 consecutive** games.
- >> No other team in the nation scored 30 or more in each game last season.
- >> UCF scored 50+ points in 5 games and 60+ 4 times in 2017. Both were school records. With Week 1's 56-point output vs. UConn, the Knights have scored 50 or more in 6 of their last 15 games. UCF has scored 40+ in 10 of its last 15 games.
- >> The Knights rank No. 2 in the nation in total offense, averaging 609 yards per game.

DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!

- >> UCF averaged more than 10 explosive plays per game (plays of 20 yards or more) in 2017. The Knights are on the same pace this season, tallying 21 explosive plays (10.5 per game).
- ▶ Of the 136 explosive plays in 2017, Knights returning in 2018 accounted for 71 of them (52.2 percent). That number goes up to 101 (74.2 percent) if you give McKenzie Milton credit for pass plays of 20+ yards.
- >> For the 2017 season, UCF had 136 explosive plays of 20+ yards, with 36 resulting in TDs. Of this season's 21 explosive plays, 4 have gone for TDs.
- >> Adrian Killins Jr. was responsible for the longest run of the season in 2017, a school-record 96-yard jaunt against Memphis. Gabriel Davis hauled in the longest reception of the year, an 80-yard TD strike from Milton at SMU.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- >> UCF has created 3 turnovers in each of its first 2 contests. The Knights rank No. 26 in the nation in turnovers gained (NCAA ranks overall number, not per game).
- >> Interceptions have accounted for 4 of the Knights' 6 takeaways. UCF ranks No. 16 in the nation in that category (NCAA ranks overall number, not per game).
- → The Knights are No. 15 in the nation in turnover margin (+1.50/game) this season.
- >> UCF has not lost the turnover battle in a game this season.
- **▶** UCF was **No. 2** in the nation in turnover margin at +1.31 per game in 2017. The Knights only lost the turnover battle twice last season.
- >> The 2017 Knights only turned the ball over 15 times in 13 games, while creating 32 turnovers.

PERFECTION

- >> With its Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl victory over Auburn, UCF completed its first undefeated season in school history.
- >> The victory over Auburn also extended a school record for consecutive victories, making it 13. Two victories this season have pushed the school-record streak to 15 straight.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

#HISMAN CANDIDATE

>> Take your pick of alliterative nicknames, but magical, money, masterful all fit the bill. Junior quarterback McKenzie Milton was one of the best signal-callers in the nation last season. As a sophomore, he finished eighth in voting for the Heisman Trophy and was awarded the Archie Griffin Award as the nation's best player by the Touchdown Club of Columbus. He recorded 7 300-yard games last season, tied for the most on the UCF charts. He passed for 37 TDs and 4,037 yards, both school records. Milton ranked No. 2 in the nation in passing efficiency (179.3), No. 4 in total offense (357.7), No. 4 in completion percentage (.671) and No. 5 in points responsible for (20.8 per game).

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- ▶ Milton also ranked No. 4 in the nation last season in passing touchdowns (37), even though he didn't play in the 4th quarter in 6 of UCF's 13 games.
- >> Milton picked up right where he left off in the opener. He was 24-of-32 for 346 yards and 5 TDs vs. UConn. It was his fifth career game with 4+ passing TDs and his third with 5.
- >> Milton was a bit out of rhythm vs. SC State, tossing three interceptions. But he extended his streak of consecutive games with a TD pass to 16.
- Milton is the only QB on the Knights' roster who has started a game.
- >> Redshirt freshman Darriel Mack Jr. busted off a 70-yard TD run at UConn. That run was the 2nd-longest TD run by a UCF QB ever (Daunte Culpepper, 75 yds at Kent State in 1997).

DYNAMIC DAVIS

>> Gabriel Davis led the Knights in receiving vs. SC State. The sophomore recorded careerhighs with 5 receptions and 111 yards. It was Davis' first 100-yard receiving game as a Knight. Davis' 13-yard TD grab last week was his second of the season. Davis has started every game in his UCF career, a streak of 15 consecutive.

RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- >> Junior Dredrick Snelson has also been productive. He is averaging 5.5 catches per game.
- >> Snelson got hot late in the second quarter at UConn. He caught three consecutive passes for 12, 26 and 31 yards, accounting for 69 of the 74 yards in a scoring drive.
- >> Ole Miss transfer Tre Nixon had a stellar debut for UCF. He caught 5 balls for 101 yards and 2 TDs at UConn in the season-opener.
- >> 7 different receivers (not including RBs) have caught at least one ball this year.
- >> Unexpected additions -- In May, Nixon was granted immediate eligibility by the NCAA. Nixon saw action in 10 games at Mississippi last season. He was the Florida Dairy Farmers Class 7A Player of the Year in 2015. In June, more good news came as tight end Michael Colubiale was granted a sixth year for a medical hardship after missing much of 2015.
- >> Colubiale is the only Knights TE who has ever caught a pass in NCAA FBS action.

HE GOOOOONE! (COPYRIGHT @TJ_LSUDAD)

➤ Adrian Killins Jr. received a great deal of hype from YouTube/Twitter football commentator @TJ LSUDAD when he busted an 87-yard TD run at Michigan and a 100-yard kick return at ECU last in 2016. Killins also lit up the Internet, Twitter, etc. numerous times last season. His 96-yard sprint off right tackle vs. Memphis broke UCF and American Athletic Conference records for longest rush, longest TD rush and longest play from scrimmage.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- >> Killins has 3 career 100-yard rushing games including a career-best 146 at SMU last year.
- **>> Killins** scored **two rushing TDs vs. SC State**, marking his **4th career multi-TD** performance.
- >> Otis Anderson is listed as both receiver and running back. He was UCF's leading rusher vs. UConn, Temple and Memphis in The American Championship in 2017.
- **▶ Anderson** also ranks **No. 2** in the nation with an **18.8-yard average** on **punt returns**.
- >> Former walk-on Greg McCrae was awarded a scholarship early in 2018 preseason camp.
- >> Killins (11.1) and McCrae (12.4) both averaged more than 10 yards per carry vs SC State.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- >> Senior tackle Wyatt Miller has now started 36 games.
- >> Junior center Jordan Johnson has started 27 straight games.
- >> Senior guard Tyler Hudanick has started 19 games dating back to his freshman season.
- >> Red-shirt freshman Cole Schneider made his first career start at right guard in Week 1.



DEFENSIVE NOTES

SAVAGE PAT

▶ Middle linebacker Pat Jasinski led the team with 104 tackles in 2017. "Savage Pat" may look a bit more business-like this season with his fresh haircut, but it has been business as usual this season. He has led the team in tackles in both games, tallying 11 vs. UConn and 8 vs. SC State. In addition to production on the field, he'll be looked to even more this season for leadership on the defense.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- >> Jasinski's average of 6.0 solo tackles/game ranks him No. 14 in the nation, No. 2 in AAC.
- >> Jasinski was the Knights' top tackler in 7-of-13 games last season.
- >> Jasinski ranked No. 75 in the nation and No. 8 in The American with 104 total tackles last season.
- >> Jasinski has played in all 40 games with 21 starts during his career.
- >> As a redshirt freshman, Eric Mitchell recorded 14 tackles last season. He has already eclipsed that mark with 15 total tackles.
- >> True freshman Eriq Gilyard has seen a good deal of action in his first two games, backing up Jasinski. Gilyard has tallied 7 tackles, including half a tackle for-loss.

NO FLY ZONE

▶ The Knights racked up 20 interceptions last season, which ranked No. 2 in the nation. Of those 20 interceptions, 13 were tallied by the secondary. While UCF lost shutdown cornerback Mike Hughes in the first round of the NFL Draft, plenty of experience -- and interceptions -- return. Safety Kyle Gibson tied for the team lead with four INTs last year, while cornerback Brandon Moore, cornerback Nevelle Clarke and safety Antwan Collier also picked off opposing quarterbacks last season. The Knights have 4 INTs already this season and all 4 have come from safeties.

SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- **>>** Gibson was a First-Team All-Conference selection in 2017. He tallied his first INT of the year against SC State. He's also tied for the team lead with 2 PBUs.
- **>>** Grant has 2 interceptions this season to rank No. 2 in the nation (INT/gm). He saw action in all 13 games as a backup last season, but has started the first two games in 2018.
- >> Grant ranks third on the team and first among defensive backs with 14 total tackles.
- **▶** Cornerback **Brandon (Bam) Moore started 7 games** in 2017. He played in all **13 contests**. Moore tallied **31 total tackles**, including **3 TFLs**. He **broke up 8 passes** as well, which ranked **No. 2 on the team**.
- >> Collier recorded his first career start at UConn, filling in for Gibson who was out for the first half after a targeting penalty in the Peach Bowl. Collier tallied his second career INT vs.
- >> The Knights have broken up 12 passes, 8 by the secondary, including 2 each for Gibson and Clarke.

WOOT WOOT!

>> Junior defensive tackle AJ Wooten has now blocked a kick in each of his three seasons. His blocked field goal attempt vs. SC State helped preserve a shutout and was his third career blocked kick. His previous two blocks came on PATs.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- >> Senior Titus Davis moved to defensive end this year. He had been playing outside linebacker in the 3-4 scheme used the last two seasons. Davis made his 15th consecutive start and picked up his first sack of the season last week vs. SC State.
- >> Junior Brendon Hayes made his first career start last week and recorded his first sack of the season.
- >> True freshman Randy Charlton started in his first-ever collegiate game at UConn.
- >> Joey Connors recorded his first start since the 2015 season in Week 1 at UConn. Connors was tied for No. 3 on the team with 4 pass breakups in 2017.
- >> Wooten, Connors and Davis have started both games this season on the D-Line.
- → The Knights have plenty of depth up front. Six defensive linemen recorded at least 5 tackles in 2017. Davis, Connors, Hill, Wooten, Aaron Cochran and Hayes each made a minimum of 5 stops last season.

AUTO-MATT-IC

➤ Senior kicker Matthew Wright is in his fourth season as the Knights' placekicker, handling field goals and point-after touchdowns. For his career, he is 149-of-152 on PATs (.980), which ranks No. 2 on the UCF career charts. He is also No. 3 on the career field-goal accuracy chart at 44-of-58 (.759).

SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

- >> Wright also handles kickoff duties. He is averaging 60.3 yards per kickoff.
- >> Wright now has 281 points kicking in his career and is No. 4 on the career kick scoring chart at UCF. He is one of only eight UCF kickers ever to record 200 points or more. He is on pace to easily break the career kick scoring record of 314 by Shawn Moffitt (2011-14) and would be just the second kicker in UCF history to score more than 300 points.
- ➤ Mac Loudermilk might be the most interesting punter in the nation, with his long hair and mountain man beard. He and his specialist mates also like to have a little fun. Last season, he hit a career-best 69-yard punt vs. UConn and added a 62-yarder at Temple. He celebrated both by hitting imaginary home runs, complete with bat-flip.
- **▶ Loudermilk** pinned opponnents **inside the 20-yard line** on **nearly half** his punts (22-of-46) last season.
- >> Loudermilk is also the Knights' holder for PATs and FGs.
- >> Loudermilk can do a bit of everything. His versatility was on display in the season-opening victory over FIU last season. Loudermilk's three punts vs. FIU were downed inside the 20-yard line. He also served as the holder on PAT/field goal attempts. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he successfully converted a pass to tight end Jordan Franks for a 2-point conversion. In the 2016 Spring Game, Loudermilk was playing tight end and hauled in a long TD reception.
- **>> Caleb Perez** returns as the Knights' starting **long snapper**, completing the triumvirate of returning specialists. He **did not have a bad snap** on punts, field goals or PATs **last season**.



UCF VP/AD Danny White: "I'm thrilled to welcome Josh and his family to UCF. I believe we've identified one of the brightest offensive minds in college football. His offensive system is very similar to what we've been running. I know he's going to utilize all the great talent on our roster and continue to add to it. He's no stranger to success, winning a national championship as a quarterback and leading a number of extremely high-powered offensive teams. Coach Heupel is in coaching for the right reasons. He cares about his student-athletes and that's one of the most important attributes I look for in a coach."

Tiger Turnaround

Heupel comes to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/ quarterbacks coach at Missouri for the past two seasons.

In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou was ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also No. 14 in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 touchdowns. He followed that up with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record and nation-leading 44 touchdown tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/ quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of their starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Sooner Success

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-toback national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to OU as a full-time assistant.

He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total



National Championship Playing Career

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
