### KNIGHT NOTES

#### leading off

- The Knights make their first trip to Eck Stadium, looking to bounce back from a series loss at Cincinnati last weekend.
- Both ball clubs are looking up at The American standings as the second half of league play begins.
- With a sweep this weekend, Greg Lovelady will become the fastest coach to 100 wins in program history.

#### a look back

- The Knights dropped their first midweek contest of the year on Tuesday night to FAU, falling 5-3.
- UCF took a two-run lead, only to see it evaporate with a four-spot by the Owls in the sixth.
- Starting pitcher Jordan Spicer tossed five scoreless innings.
- Matthew Mika drove in a pair of runs and was the catalyst for all three scores.

#### midweek vs. weekend

- After difficult weekend series, the Knights have always found a way to bounce back in midweek contests with a record of 9-1, compared to a 13-14 mark on weekends.
- The Knights have five players hitting above .400 in midweek contests (at least 20 Abs), while weekend hitters only have a pair above .300.
- The pitching staff has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.43 on the weekend, compared to a 1.74 mark in midweeks.

#### error free is the way to be

- The Knights did not make an error in six of the previous seven games heading into the FAU midweek game.
- UCF has played error free in 16 games this season with a record of 12-4.
- The .976 fielding percentage is on pace to be the mark since 2015's .986 and the third best in program history.

#### starting pitching

- The starting pitching staff for the Knights has a 13-8 mark on the year with a 3.65 ERA and a .245 opponent batting average.
- Grant Schuermann has been the only pitcher to feature in a starting lineup every week and leads the team with a 2.18 ERA.
- In contrast, opponents' starters are 4-15 on the year with a 5.59 ERA.

#### starting hot

- UCF has struck early, scoring in the first inning in 19 games this season.
- The Knights have outscored opponents 36-15 in the first inning this season and 60-34 over the first two innings.
- Ray Alejo and Tyler Osik have combined to hit .458 with 10 RBI in opening frames.
- The Black and Gold is 64-20 when scoring first in the Greg Lovelady era.

#### walk this way

- UCF is fourth in The American with 168 walks on the year and are on pace for its 10th straight campaign with at least 200 walks.
- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 41 free passes (31 walks and 10 hit by pitches)
- Mika has cut down his strikeout rate considerably this season and punched out just 21 times in 164 plate appearances.

### willy, willy (dilly, dilly)

- Pitcher Chris Williams has only issued five walks to 33 strikeouts in six starts this season.
- The righty climbed up to second in the nation with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 15.6 and a .54 walks allowed per nine innings after his start against USF.
- The redshirt senior missed the start of the year due to an NCAA suspension, stemming from his time as a member of the UCF club baseball team as a freshman.

### offensive power players

- UCF has a pair of players hitting over .300 this season, with two more hitting above .290, and a team slugging percentage of .409.
- The Knights have 107 extra base hits - 70 doubles, seven triples and 30 home runs.
- The Black and Gold have produced with runners in scoring position with a .276 clip in those situations, led by Ray Alejo's .375 (14-40).

### prime time performers

- The Knights have produced 82 multi-hit performances, including 18 three-hit games and one four-hit outing.
- Dallas Beaver has totaled 11 multi-RBI games.
- Kyle Kemp and Jeffrey Hakanson have been clutch out of the bullpen with 28 and 45 strikeouts, respectively.
- The starting pitchers have amassed 11 quality starts, topped by six from Grant Schuermann.

### what's up wingo

- Dalton Wingo has been the main choice in right field after making just 23 starts in 2018.
- The sophomore has 26 RBI on the season with a pair of home runs.
- His consistent play can be attributed to prescription lenses that he started wearing during the offseason.

### midweek madness

- The Knights are 9-1 in midweeks this season, including wins over No. 3 Florida and No. 14 Florida State.
- Matthew Mika leads the team with a .417 clip and 12 RBI.
- Ray Alejo and Tyler Osik have combined for 26 RBI over those 10 games.
- The pitching staff has 95 strikeouts to 59 walks with a 3.54 ERA.

- The redshirt junior is 39th in the nation with 53 hits and leads the team with a .560 slugging percentage.
- Always a speedster, Alejo has 11 stolen bases.

### pitching injuries

- The pitching corps has been decimated due to injuries this season.
- Joe Sheridan and David Litchfield are two arms still rehabbing from injuries in 2018.
- Trevor Holloway continues to work his way back from an injury that has sidelined him since the ECU series.
- Of the 18 arms on the team this year, seven have missed significant time due to injuries.
- David Litchfield made the trip for Wichita State, his first time with the team in a year and a half.

### benny the jet

- Freshman Ben McCabe has found his footing at the plate with a .267 clip in 20 games this season.
- The rookie is one of three players on the team with a triple and a home run in 2019.
- The Sarasota catcher has also hosed a trio of runners trying to steal on him this season.

### oh no, o yeah

- Tyler Osik continues to pave the way offensively with a .336 batting average.
- The redshirt senior is second on the team with 30 RBI and leads with seven home runs.
- Osik is 7-for-8 when stealing this season and has 33 runs scored.
- The power slugger hit the first grand slam of the year against Jacksonville, the first for UCF since 2018, when Osik hit a grand slam against Cincinnati.

### DOC COMES UP CLUTCH

At a 1978 Texas Rangers-Baltimore Orioles game, George "Doc" Medich (who had been a medical student at the University of Pittsburgh before becoming a professional baseball player) saved the life of a fan in the stands who was suffering from a heart attack.

### DODGEBALL

In the mid-1800s, you could be put out between the bases by having the ball thrown directly at you. Players were resistant when the rule was changed — "patching," as it was known, was an important and masculine part of the game.

## UCFACTS

### early vs. late

- The offense has come out on first in the opening three innings, scoring 84 of 215 total runs (.393)
- The Knights have a team batting average of .282 with 75 RBI and 36 extra base hits in that span.
- Conversely, UCF has been outscored 17-13 in ninth innings.

### #ucfuel (ucf fuel)

- The Black and Gold has 9.15 strikeouts per nine innings, led by a bullpen cadre of 11.3 and a starting group with 7.2 strikeouts per nine innings
- The Knights have struck out at least 10 batters in 18 games this season.

- UCF is second in The American with 58 stolen bases.
- The Knights have stolen third 20 times and home once.
- Mika and Alejo were the top returning duo in the nation with 61 combined steals in 2018.
- The Black and Gold is going for its first back-to-back-to-back 100-steal seasons since 1988.

### going, going, gone

- The Knights have 30 home runs on the season, which ranks fourth in The American.
- Osik leads the team with seven
- Alejo has led off two games this season with a homer, including one on the first pitch of the series opener against USF.
- UCF has hit multiple homers in a game four times this season, including a season-high four against Auburn on Feb. 24.

### locking it down

- UCF has held opponents to two or fewer runs 14 times this season.
- Limiting opponent scoring has been a huge emphasis of the Greg Lovelady era, as the Knights are 59-2 when allowing two or fewer runs.
- The Knights have converted on eight of 10 save opportunities, led by Jeff Hakanson's career-best five.

### beaver bash

- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 34 RBI this season.
- He made a huge jump from 1 RBI as a freshman to 30 last season.
- The junior set a career high with three runs scored and three RBI in the series opener against VCU.
- Beaver has split time between catcher (17 starts), first base (10 starts) and third base (6 starts).
- He is hitting .778 with runners on third with less than two outs (14-for-18).

### ray raykes

- Ray Alejo nearly hit for the cycle against Penn State on March 9, just missing a single to complete the feat.
- He nearly hit for the cycle in the series opener against VCU, missing out on a double on a 4-for-6 night.
- The last player to hit for the cycle was Tommy Williams vs. Fairfield on March 15, 2015.

### chan's the man

- Chandler Robertson has made a big jump in the starting lineup in 2019, hitting .306 through 17 games.
- The senior has 34 hits, with four extra base knocks, to go along with nine RBI.
- He's already bested his total starts (16), hits (16) and steals (0) from 2018.
- He also set a career high with a 12-game on-base streak.

### playing small ball

- Greg Lovelady does not shy away from having his team bunt for hits.
- UCF has 16 bunt singles this season, as well as 26 sacrifice bunts.
- Chandler Robertson leads the team with five bunt singles.

### yo soy kemp

- Kyle Kemp continued his impressive run out of the bullpen over the weekend with a season-high five strikeouts against Penn State.
- He did not allow an earned run through his first nine appearances, due largely to an .027 opponent batting average. (One hit in 12 innings)
- Kemp is one of two graduate transfers on the team this season, along with Grant Schuermann.
- He also has two saves on the year, good for second on the team.

### honored by the american

- Chris Williams garnered his second American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week laurel in Week 8 after tossing 6 1/3 innings of scoreless ball with six strikeouts.
- Tyler Osik was named the Player of the Week after the Yale and VCU series.
- In addition to three main honors, UCF has received five spots on the weekly honor roll.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012

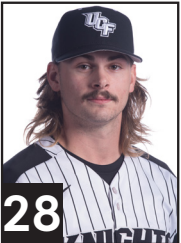

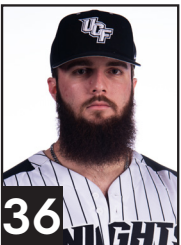

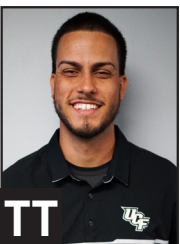
