leading off

- Coming off a 3-1 week at home, the Knights will hit the road for four straight games.
- UCF is seventh in The American after picking up its second conference series win of the year last week against Memphis
- The Knights retook the conference lead in stolen bases with 77 after going 12-for-14 last week

a look back

- The Knights improved to 11-1 in midweek contests on Tuesday night with a 9-7 win in 11 innings at North Florida.
- UCF rallied to tie the game in the top of the ninth, before scoring four runs in the 11th.
- The Black and Gold improve to 4-1 in extra-inning contests.

0 to 100 real quick

- With the win on Skinner Strong Knight in the series opener against Memphis, head coach Greg Lovelady became the fastest coach to 100 wins in program history.
- Lovelady eclipsed the mark in 159 games, beating legendary coach Jay Bergman to the mark by 31 contests.
- The third-year skipper is also the only coach in program history to make an NCAA Regional in his first year in charge.

lyon in wait

- Freshman Jay Lyons was thrust into the starting lineup last week against Bethune-Cookman.
- The rookie hit .412 with four RBI in his first four starts.
- Lyons came up clutch with two three-hit games, including a walk-off single to clinch the weekend series against Memphis.

marvel at mika

- Matthew Mika has been on fire over the last 10 games with a .316 clip, 10 RBI, 10 walks and eight stolen bases.
- Mika stole three bases over the weekend to move into a tie for third in program history with 80 in a career.
- The senior is one of four Knights hitting above .300 and has driven in 30 runs on the year.
- The recent surge should be no surprise with Avengers Endgame out. Mika is the biggest Marvel fan... like seriously... that's not hyperbole. He's consistently immersed in movies, comics or podcasts about his favorite superheroes.

beaver bashes

- Dallas Beaver has been on fire as of late, vaulting himself into a tie for the team lead with a .331 clip at the dish, after hitting a team-high .414 over the last 15 games.
- The junior leads the team with 42 RBI, 48 free passes and eight home runs.
- His 38 walks rank 29th in the nation.
- Beaver finished his undergraduate degree in two years in criminal justice and is already past the halfway point of his master's degree in criminal justice and public administration.

UCFACTS

good to see you litch

- David Litchfield made his UCF debut against Memphis, throwing one inning with a strikeout, hitting 93 mph.
- The redshirt sophomore missed all of last season due to Tommy John's surgery.
- Prior to signing with UCF he was the Florida League Cy Young winner in 2017.

midweek vs. weekend

- After difficult weekend series, the Knights have always found a way to bounce back in midweek contests with a record of 11-1, compared to a 16-17 mark on weekends.
- The Knights have three players hitting above .400 in midweek contests (at least 20 Abs), while weekend hitters only have a pair above .300.
- The pitching staff has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.33 on the weekend, compared to a 1.45 mark in midweeks.

leadoff dingers

- UCF notched hits third straight 40-home run season over the weekend with three bombs against Memphis.
- The Knights have launched 15 homers to start an inning, while three have started games.
- Ray Alejo leads the team with four leadoff pumps, including the first pitch of the game against USF.

starting pitching

- The starting pitching staff for the Knights has a 15-10 mark on the year with a 4.25 ERA and a .257 opponent batting average.
- Grant Schuermann has been the only pitcher to feature in a starting lineup every week and leads the team with a 3.59 ERA.
- In contrast, opponents' starters are 6-17 on the year with a 5.72 ERA.

error free is the way to be

- The Knights did not make an error in six of the previous seven games heading into the FAU midweek game.
- UCF has played error free in 16 games this season with a record of 12-4.
- The .975 fielding percentage is on pace to be the mark since 2015's .986 and the third best in program history.

starting hot

- UCF has struck early, scoring in the first inning in 23 games this season.
- The Knights have outscored opponents 42-27 in the first inning this season and 71-52 over the first two innings.
- Ray Alejo and Tyler Osik have combined to hit .421 with 11 RBI in opening frames.
- The Black and Gold is 64-22 when scoring first in the Greg Lovelady era.

walk this way

- UCF is fourth in The American with 218 walks on the year and record its 10th straight 200-walk campaign.
- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 48 free passes (38 walks and 10 hit by pitches)
- Mika has cut down his strikeout rate considerably this season and punched out just 26 times in 207 plate appearances.

willy, willy (dilly, dilly)

- Pitcher Chris Williams has only issued six walks to 53 strikeouts this season.
- The righty climbed up to second in the nation with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 15.6 and a .54 walks allowed per nine innings after his start against USF.
- The redshirt senior missed the start of the year due to an NCAA suspension, stemming from his time as a member of the UCF club baseball team as a freshman.
- He currently sits seventh in the nation with a 8.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

offensive power players

- UCF has a quartet of players hitting over .300 this season and a team slugging percentage of .422.
- The Knights have 135 extra base hits - 84 doubles, nine triples and 42 home runs.
- The Black and Gold have produced with runners in scoring position with a .267 clip in those situations, led by Ray Alejo's .352 (19-54).

prime time performers

- The Knights have produced 106 multi-hit performances, including 27 three-hit games and one four-hit outing.
- Dallas Beaver has totaled a team-high 13 multi-RBI games.
- Jeffrey Hakanson and Garrett Westberg have been clutch out of the pen with 45 and 52 strikeouts, respectively.
- The starting pitchers have amassed 12 quality starts, topped by six from Grant Schuermann.

what's up wingo

- Dalton Wingo has been the main choice in right field after making just 23 starts in 2018.
- The sophomore has 33 RBI on the season with four of home runs.
- His consistent play can be attributed to prescription lenses that he started wearing during the offseason.

mika is #ucfast (pronounced ucf fast)

- Matthew Mika enters the weekend with a team-leading 24 stolen bases on the year.
- The senior moved into a tie for third in program history with 80 career swiptes.
- Mika leads The American and ranks 21st in the nation.
- Prior to the season, Mika claimed 2019 as his year...seriously.

- The power slugger hit the first grand slam of the year against Jacksonville, the first for UCF since 2018, when Osik hit a grand slam against Cincinnati.

early vs. late

- The offense has come out on first in the opening three innings, scoring 105 of 279 total runs.
- The Knights have a team batting average of .274 with 91 RBI in that span.
- Conversely, UCF has been outscored 20-16 in ninth innings.

- Chandler Robertson has made a big jump in the starting lineup in 2019, hitting .264 on the year.
- The senior has 39 hits, with seven extra base knocks, to go along with 13 RBI.
- He's already bested his total starts (16), hits (16) and steals (0) from 2018.
- He also set a career high with a 12-game on-base streak.

playing small ball

- Greg Lovelady does not shy away from having his team bunt for hits.
- UCF has 18 bunt singles this season, as well as 32 sacrifice bunts.
- Chandler Robertson leads the team with five bunt singles, while Brandon Hernandez has eight sac bunts.

yo soy kemp

- Kyle Kemp set a season-high five strikeouts against Penn State.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012

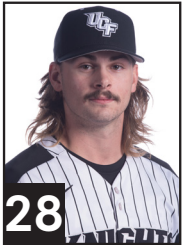

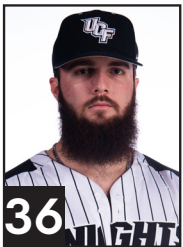
