- UCF will roll with the same rotation for the fifth straight week, with Grant Schuermann on Friday, Chris Williams on Saturday and Sunday's starter yet to be announced.
- Head coach Greg Lovelady enters the weekend one win shy of his 100th victory at UCF, making him the fastest coach to hit that mark in program history.

a look back

- UCF improved to 10-1 in midweek contests on Tuesday afternoon with a 5-4 win over Bethune-Cookman.
- Matthew Mika bookended the game with a solo homer in the first inning and a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 10th.
- Freshman Jay Lyons, making his first career start, reached base four times, including a bases-loaded walk, and made several key picks at first to seal the win.

we are #skinnerstrong

- Friday is one of the most important nights on the UCF calendar with Joe Skinner Knight.
- Joe, a local standout ball player, signed to play for the Knights starting in 2017, but he tragically passed away from a rare form of leukemia in the spring of 2016.
- He was close with many of the players on the team, including the current class of juniors.
- Dallas Beaver, Joe's best friend, wears No. 38 to honor Skinner.
- The Knights will wear special Joe Skinner jerseys on Friday to celebrate a month-long fundraising drive for the Skinner Strong Foundation to battle pediatric cancer.

busy weekend ahead

- For the penultimate home series of the year this weekend against Memphis, the Knights will hold a trio of promotional nights.
- On Friday, UCF will conclude their annual month-long campaign of giving to the Skinner Strong Foundation with Skinner Strong Knight.
- Saturday will be Military Appreciation Day. The Knights will honor those who served and continue to serve our country.
- Sunday will be Oviedo Day, where the Knights will give thanks to a local community.

- Senior Matthew Mika has surged over the last three games with a trio of home runs, eight RBI and an OPS of 1.542.
- The senior swiped his team-leading 21st base on Tuesday to give him sole possession of fourth in program history with 77 stolen bases.

UCFACTS

beaver bashes

- Dallas Beaver has been on a roll over the last 15 games with a .429 clip at the plate and an OPS of 1.119.
- The junior is 30th in the nation this season with 35 walks.
- Beaver's batting average on the season ticked up to .316 and is on a six-game hitting streak entering the weekend.

midweek vs. weekend

- After difficult weekend series, the Knights have always found a way to bounce back in midweek contests with a record of 10-1, compared to a 14-16 mark on weekends.
- The Knights have three players hitting above .400 in midweek contests (at least 20 Abs), while weekend hitters only have a pair above .300.
- The pitching staff has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.40 on the weekend, compared to a 1.48 mark in midweeks.

leadoff dingers

- UCF is two home runs away from its third straight season with at least 40 dingers.
- The Knights have launched 15 homers to start an inning, while three have started games.
- Ray Alejo leads the team with four leadoff pumps, including the first pitch of the game against USF.

starting pitching

- The starting pitching staff for the Knights has a 14-9 mark on the year with a 3.93 ERA and a .253 opponent batting average.
- Grant Schuermann has been the only pitcher to feature in a starting lineup every week and leads the team with a 3.16 ERA.
- In contrast, opponents' starters are 5-16 on the year with a 5.71 ERA.

error free is the way to be

- The Knights did not make an error in six of the previous seven games heading into the FAU midweek game.
- UCF has played error free in 16 games this season with a record of 12-4.
- The .975 fielding percentage is on pace to be the mark since 2015's .986 and the third best in program history.

starting hot

- UCF has struck early, scoring in the first inning in 22 games this season.
- The Knights have outscored opponents 39-20 in the first inning this season and 65-44 over the first two innings.
- Ray Alejo and Tyler Osik have combined to hit .427 with 11 RBI in opening frames.
- The Black and Gold is 64-22 when scoring first in the Greg Lovelady era.

walk this way

- UCF is fourth in The American with 194 walks on the year and are on pace for its 10th straight campaign with at least 200 walks.
- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 45 free passes (35 walks and 10 hit by pitches)
- Mika has cut down his strikeout rate considerably this season and punched out just 23 times in 186 plate appearances.

wily, wily (dilly, dilly)

- Pitcher Chris Williams has only issued five walks to 33 strikeouts in his first six starts this season.
- The righty climbed up to second in the nation with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 15.6 and a .54 walks allowed per nine innings after his start against USF.
- The redshirt senior missed the start of the year due to an NCAA suspension, stemming from his time as a member of the UCF club baseball team as a freshman.
- He currently sits 13th in the country with a 7.5 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

offensive power players

- UCF has a trio of players hitting over .300 this season, with one more hitting above .290, and a team slugging percentage of .418.
- The Knights have 122 extra base hits - 77 doubles, seven triples and 38 home runs.
- The Black and Gold have produced with runners in scoring position with a .266 clip in those situations, led by Ray Alejo's .347 (17-49).

prime time performers

- The Knights have produced 92 multi-hit performances, including 20 three-hit games and one four-hit outing.
- Dallas Beaver has totaled 11 multi-RBI games.
- Jeffrey Hakanson and Garrett Westberg have been clutch out of the pen with 41 and 50 strikeouts, respectively.
- The starting pitchers have amassed 11 quality starts, topped by six from Grant Schuermann.

what's up wingo

- Dalton Wingo has been the main choice in right field after making just 23 starts in 2018.
- The sophomore has 30 RBI on the season with four of home runs.
- His consistent play can be attributed to prescription lenses that he started wearing during the offseason.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

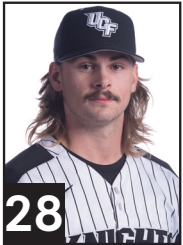

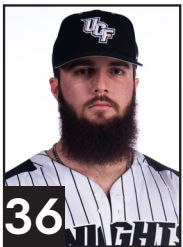

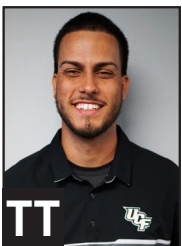
