UCFACTS

- ▶ The Knights enter the second week of the 2018 season holding the nation's longest winning streak at 14 games.
- ▶ At 13-0, last season marked UCF's first ever perfect campaign and the Knights broke the program record for consecutive victories, previously winning nine in a row during the 2013 season.
- ▶ At the helm for UCF is new head coach Josh Heupel. Heupel begins his first stint as a head coach after leading Missouri's offense to new heights over the last two years as the Tigers' offensive coordinator. The former Oklahoma All-American also spent time as the Sooners' OC from 2011-14.
- ▶ In Heupel's first game as head coach, his Knights torched UConn for 652 yards of total offense, recorded three takeaways on defense, and didn't allow a sack or turn it over in UCF's 56-17 victory over UConn on Aug. 30.
- ▶ UCF is 30-9 all-time in home openers. The Knights have won nine out of their last 10 home openers and the other two times UCF took on South Carolina State, it was its home opener. The Knights hold a 2-0 advantage over the Bulldogs in the all-time series.
- ▶ The Knights came into the 2018 season ranked 21st in the AP Top 25 Poll and 23rd in the Amway Coaches Poll. It marked the first time UCF has been ranked in the Top 25 going into a season.
- ▶ The UCF offense led the nation in scoring with 48.2 points per game. Having scored 30 or more points in each of their 13 games, and now the first of 2018, the Knights own the longest current streak of games with 30+ points at 14.
- ▶ McKenzie Milton had an impressive sophomore season, earning AAC Offensive Player of the Year, Archie Griffin National Player of the Year Award, AAC Championship Outstanding Player of the Game, and 2018 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl Offensive MVP honors. The UCF quarterback finished eighth in the Heisman voting after setting multiple program records, and started things out in 2018 by throwing for 346 yards and five touchdowns in the win over UConn.

The offense -- paced by Justin Holman's three total touchdowns -- took a while to get their own fireworks going. But UCF's 91 offensive plays eventually ended up in a 38-0 victory over South Carolina State.

LAST TIME OUT

In the first ever game of the Josh Heupel era the UCF football team did not disappoint. The Knights offense racked up 652 yards of total offense, the defense came away with three turnovers, and UCF laid a 56-17 beatdown on UConn Thursday night at Rentschler Field.

Quarterback McKenzie Milton got his #Hisman campaign off to a solid start, throwing for 346 yards and five touchdowns. It was the ninth 300-yard passing game of Milton's career and the fifth time he's thrown for four touchdowns or more. The offense was ridiculously efficient. UCF scored in 2 minutes, 39 seconds or less on each of its scoring drives. The Knights scored on 8-of-9 offensive possessions (not including running the clock out at the end of each half). The Knights put up 14 points in each quarter.

Wide receiver Tre Nixon had a great Knights' debut. He hauled in five passes for 101 yards and two touchdowns. Greg McCrae, Otis Anderson and Gabriel Davis also caught touchdown passes, while Anderson, Adrian Killins Jr. and Darriel Mack Jr. each reached paydirt on the ground as well.

Defensively, the Knights bent a bit, but didn't break. UCF held UConn to just 17 points, despite the Huskies holding the ball for 38:08 and tallying 486 yards of offense. The Knights created three turnovers, as well. The first turnover came on the opening possession of the contest with UConn at the Knights' 36-yard line, when senior linebacker Pat Jasinski forced a fumble and junior defensive back Richie Grant recovered. Grant tallied the second takeaway as well. With UConn at the UCF 25-yard line and the Knights holding a 28-10 lead, Grant stepped in front of a David Pindell pass to end the threat.



ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

EFFICIENT, EXPLOSIVE OFFENSE

- ▶ Only two teams scored more **points per minute of possession time** than UCF last week. The **Knights scored 56 points in just 21:52** of possession to average **2.56 points per minute** of possession.
- ▶ Only **Nevada (2.93)** and **Oregon (2.64)** had better **"offensive efficiency"** in the first week of the season. In fact, **only 10 teams** in the nation **averaged 2.0** or better.
- ▶ **The Knights scored touchdowns on eight of their nine possessions** last week (excluding end-of-half, run-out-the clock scenarios).
- ▶ Of those eight scoring drives, **none took longer than 2:39**.

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- ▶ As a department, UCF has gone **10+ years (21 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+**.
- ▶ This **past spring**, UCF Athletics posted a **department-record 3.33** grade-point average. Last spring, more than **73 percent** of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a **3.0 or better**, with 34 percent earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 41 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
- ▶ The **Knights' football team boasts a 984 NCAA Academic Progress Rate** score. That ranks UCF **No. 14 among all FBS institutions** and **No. 7 among public, non-military schools**.
- ▶ As a department, **UCF's NCAA Graduation Success Rate** is at **94 percent**. In the November ranking, **UCF was No. 7 in the nation** among FBS institutions. For **four straight years, the Knights have boasted the best GSR among NCAA Division I FBS public institutions**.

THESE GUYS ARE OFFENSIVE

- ▶ UCF boasted the **No. 1 scoring offense** in the nation, averaging **48.2 points per game** in 2017. After Week 1 **this season, UCF is No. 12** after scoring 56 vs. UConn.
- ▶ Knight **returners accounted for 62 percent** of the points scored last season, including 119 by kicker Matthew Wright, 66 from running back Adrian Killins Jr., 54 from wide receiver Dredrick Snelson and 48 apiece from running back Taj McGowan and quarterback McKenzie Milton.
- ▶ In fact, the 389 points UCF returners scored last year equal 60 points more than Knight opponents scored in 2017.
- ▶ UCF scored **50+ points in 5 games** and **60+ 4 times** in 2017. Both were **school records**. With last week's 56-point output vs. UConn, the Knights have scored **50 or more in 6 of their last 14** games. UCF has scored **40+ in 10 of its last 14 games**.
- ▶ **No other team** in the nation scored **30 or more** in **each game** last season.

DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!

- ▶ UCF averaged **more than 10 explosive plays** per game (plays of **20 yards or more**) in 2017. The Knights were right **on target in the season opener**, tallying **10 explosive plays**.
- ▶ Of the 136 explosive plays in 2017, **Knights returning** in 2018 accounted for **71 of them (52.2 percent)**. That number goes up to **101 (74.2 percent)** if you give **McKenzie Milton** credit for pass plays of 20+ yards.
- ▶ For the 2017 season, **UCF had 136 explosive plays** of 20+ yards, with **36 resulting in TDs**. **Of last week's 10 explosive plays, 3 went for TDs**.
- ▶ **Adrian Killins Jr.** was responsible for the **longest run of the season** in 2017, a **school-record 96-yard** jaunt against Memphis. **Gabriel Davis** hauled in the **longest reception** of the year, an **80-yard TD strike** from Milton at SMU.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- ▶ UCF was **No. 2 in the nation in turnover margin at +1.31** per game last year. The Knights only **lost the turnover battle twice** last season.
- ▶ The Knights **only turned the ball over 15 times** in 13 games, while **creating 32 turnovers**.
- ▶ Those **trends continued** in the 2018 **season opener**. UCF **created 3 turnovers** and didn't turn it over once. The **+3 margin after Week 1** ranks **No. 7** in the nation.

PERFECTION

- ▶ With its Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl victory over Auburn, UCF completed its **first undefeated season in school history**.
- ▶ The victory over Auburn also **extended a school record** for **consecutive victories**, making it 13. Last week's **win at UConn** pushed the school-record **streak to 14** straight.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

#HISMAN CANDIDATE

Take your pick of alliterative nicknames, but magical, money, masterful all fit the bill. Junior quarterback **McKenzie Milton** was **one of the best signal-callers in the nation** last season. As a sophomore, he finished **eighth in voting for the Heisman Trophy** and was awarded the **Archie Griffin Award** as the nation's best player by the Touchdown Club of Columbus. He recorded **7 300-yard games** last season, **tied for the most** on the UCF charts. He passed for **37 TDs** and **4,037 yards, both school records**. Milton ranked **No. 2** in the nation in **passing efficiency (179.3)**, **No. 4** in **total offense (357.7)**, **No. 4** in **completion percentage (.671)** and **No. 5** in **points responsible for (20.8 per game)**.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- Milton also ranked **No. 4** in the nation in **passing touchdowns (37)**, even though he **didn't play in the 4th quarter in 6 of UCF's 13 games**.
- Milton **picked up right where he left off** in the opener. He was **24-of-32** for **346 yards** and **5 TDs** vs. UConn. It was his **fifth career game with 4+ passing TDs** and his **third with 5**.
- Milton is the **only QB** on the Knights' roster **who has started a game**.
- Redshirt freshman **Darriel Mack Jr.** saw the **first game action** of his career last week. Mack took advantage of the opportunity, busting off a **70-yard TD** run and **completing both his pass attempts**. Mack's **70-yard jaunt** was the **second-longest TD run by a UCF QB** ever (**Daunte Culpepper** went 75 at Kent State in 1997).

DYNAMIC DEBUT

Tre Nixon led the Knights in receiving in the **season-opener**. The Ole Miss transfer recorded **5 receptions** for **101 yards** and **2 TDs**. After tallying one collegiate reception (last season) for the Rebels, Nixon has quickly become a favorite target for Milton. Nixon's **34-yard TD** grab last week put UCF up 14-0 in the first quarter. He added an **11-yard TD** catch in the third quarter to make it 42-10. His performance also marked his **first collegiate start**.

RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- Junior **Dredrick Snelson** was also productive in the opener. He tallied a **team-best** (tied with **Gabriel Davis**) **6 receptions** for 90 yards.
- Snelson got **hot late in the second quarter** at UConn. He caught **three consecutive passes** for **12, 26 and 31 yards**, accounting for **69 of the 74 yards** in a scoring drive.
- Davis was a starter virtually from the moment he walked on campus. As a **true freshman last season**, he **started all 13 games**. His **80-yard TD** vs. SMU was the **longest of the season**.
- Davis notched his **14th consecutive start** at UConn, scoring a **second-quarter TD**.
- 7 different receivers** (not including RBs) caught **at least one ball** in the season-opener.
- Unexpected additions** -- In May, **Nixon** was granted **immediate eligibility** by the NCAA. Nixon saw action in 10 games at Mississippi last season. He was the Florida Dairy Farmers Class 7A Player of the Year in 2015. In June, more good news came as tight end **Michael Colubiale** was granted a **sixth year** for a medical hardship after missing much of 2015.
- Colubiale is the **only Knights TE** who has ever **caught a pass** in NCAA FBS action.

HE GOOOOOONE! (COPYRIGHT @TJ_LSUDAD)

Adrian Killins Jr. received a great deal of **hype from YouTube/Twitter football commentator @TJ_LSUDAD** when he busted an **87-yard TD** run at Michigan and a **100-yard kick return** at ECU last in 2016. Killins also lit up the Internet, Twitter, etc. numerous times last season. His **96-yard sprint** off right tackle vs. Memphis **broke UCF and American Athletic Conference records** for longest rush, longest TD rush and longest play from scrimmage.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- Killins has **three career 100-yard rushing games** including a **career-best 146 at SMU**.
- Anderson is listed as **both receiver and running back**. He was **UCF's leading rusher vs. UConn, Temple and Memphis in The American Championship**.
- Former walk-on **Greg McCrae** was **awarded a scholarship** early in 2018 preseason camp.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- Senior tackle **Wyatt Miller** has now **started 35 games**.
- Junior center **Jordan Johnson** has **started 26 straight games**.
- Senior guard **Tyler Hudanick** has **started 18 games** dating back to his freshman season.
- Redshirt freshman **Cole Schneider** made his **first career start** at right guard last week.



DEFENSIVE NOTES

SAVAGE PAT

▶ Middle linebacker **Pat Jasinski** led the team with **104 tackles** in 2017. “Savage Pat” may look a bit more business-like this season with his fresh haircut, but it was **business as usual vs. UConn** last week. He **led the team with 11 total stops**. In addition to production on the field, he’ll be looked to even more this season for **leadership** on the defense.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

▶ **Jasinski** ranked **No. 75 in the nation** and **No. 8 in The American** with **104 total tackles** last season. His **Week 1 total of 10 solo stops** vs. UConn ranks him **No. 9 in the nation** and **No. 1 in the AAC**.

▶ **Jasinski** was the Knights’ **top tackler in 7-of-13** games last season.

▶ **Jasinski** has played in all **39 games with 20 starts** during his career.

▶ **As a redshirt freshman, Eric Mitchell** recorded **14 tackles last season**. He **made his first career start vs. UConn** last week and is already in double digits with **10 total tackles**.

▶ True freshman **Eriq Gilyard** saw a good deal of action in his **collegiate debut**, backing up **Jasinski**. Gilyard **tallied 3 tackles**, including **half a tackle for-loss**.

NO FLY ZONE

▶ The Knights racked up **20 interceptions last season**, which ranked **No. 2 in the nation**. Of those 20 interceptions, 13 were tallied by the secondary. While UCF lost shutdown cornerback **Mike Hughes** in the first round of the **NFL Draft**, plenty of experience -- and interceptions -- return. Safety **Kyle Gibson** tied for the team lead with **four INTs** last year, while cornerback **Brandon Moore**, cornerback **Nevelle Clarke** and safety **Antwan Collier** also **picked off opposing quarterbacks** last season. In the season opener **last week at UConn**, junior **Richie Grant** tallied his **first career INT**.

SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

▶ **Gibson** was a **First-Team All-Conference** selection in 2017. In addition to his **4 INTs**, Gibson tallied **4 pass breakups** and made **64 total tackles**, which ranked sixth on the team.

▶ **Grant** saw action in all **13 games** as a backup last season. He recorded **32 tackles**, **2 PBUs** and **1 forced fumble**. **Last week’s game** was his **first career start**.

▶ Cornerback **Brandon (Bam) Moore** started **7 games** in 2017. He played in all **13 contests**. Moore tallied **31 total tackles**, including **3 TFLs**. He **broke up 8 passes** as well, which ranked **No. 2 on the team**. Bam tallied **5 stops** and **1 pass breakup** last week at **UConn**.

▶ **Collier** recorded his **first career start** at UConn, filling in for **Gibson** who was out for the first half after a **targeting penalty in the Peach Bowl**. **Collier** tallied **9 total tackles**, all in the **first half**, vs. the Huskies.

▶ The Knights **broke up 9 passes** last week, **6 by the secondary**, including **2 each** for **Gibson** and **Clarke** and **1 each** for **Moore** and **Collier**.

TRYSTEN = TFL

▶ Junior defensive tackle **Trysten Hill** was in the **backfield all night at UConn** last week. Hill made **4 stops**, **2 for a loss of yardage**. **Last season**, Hill recorded **20 tackles**, with **4.5 tackles for-loss**.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

▶ **Titus Davis** moved to **defensive end** this year. He had been playing **outside linebacker** in the 3-4 scheme used the last two seasons. Davis made his **14th consecutive start** and tallied **2 tackles last week** at UConn.

▶ True freshman **Randy Charlton** started in his **first-ever collegiate game**. The youngster was productive, too. He tallied **2 total tackles** and a **pass breakup**.

▶ **Joey Connors** recorded his **first start since the 2015 season** at UConn. **Connors** was also tied for **No. 3 on the team** with **4 pass breakups in 2017**.

▶ The Knights have **plenty of depth up front**. **Six defensive linemen** recorded at least 5 tackles in 2017. **Davis, Connors, Hill, AJ Wooten, Aaron Cochran** and **Brendon Hayes** each made a minimum of 5 stops last season.

▶ In the **season-opener** last week, **9 different defensive linemen** recorded tackles.

AUTO-MATT-IC

▶▶ Senior kicker **Matthew Wright** is in his **fourth season as the Knights' placekicker**, handling **field goals and point-after touchdowns**. For his career, he is **144-of-147 on PATs (.980)**, which ranks **No. 2 on the UCF career charts**. He is also **No. 3 on the career field-goal accuracy chart at 43-of-57 (.754)**.

SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

- ▶▶ **Wright** also handles **kickoff duties**. He averaged **62.9 yards per kickoff** last week.
- ▶▶ **Wright** now has **273 points kicking in his career** and is **No. 4 on the career kick scoring chart at UCF**. He is one of **only eight UCF kickers ever to record 200 points or more**. He is **on pace to easily break the career kick scoring record of 314 by Shawn Moffitt (2011-14)** and **would be just the second kicker in UCF history to score more than 300 points**.
- ▶▶ **Mac Loudermilk** might be the most interesting punter in the nation, with his **long hair and mountain man beard**. He and his specialist mates also like to have a **little fun**. Last season, he hit a **career-best 69-yard punt** vs. UConn and added a **62-yarder** at Temple. He celebrated both by hitting **imaginary home runs**, complete with **bat-flip**.
- ▶▶ **Loudermilk** pinned opponents **inside the 20-yard line on nearly half his punts (22-of-46)** last season.
- ▶▶ **Loudermilk** is also the Knights' **holder for PATs and FGs**.
- ▶▶ **Loudermilk** can do a **bit of everything**. His versatility was on display in the season-opening victory over FIU last season. Loudermilk's **three punts** vs. FIU were downed **inside the 20-yard line**. He also served as the **holder on PAT/field goal attempts**. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he successfully **converted a pass** to tight end **Jordan Franks** for a **2-point conversion**. In the **2016 Spring Game**, Loudermilk was playing tight end and hauled in a **long TD reception**.
- ▶▶ **Caleb Perez** returns as the Knights' starting **long snapper**, completing the triumvirate of returning specialists. He **did not have a bad snap** on punts, field goals or PATs **last season**.

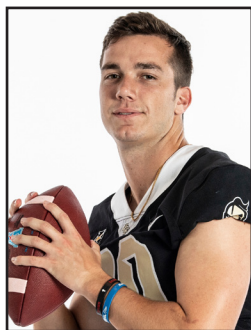

Josh Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF Football. UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Daniel J. White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017.

Quotable

UCF Head Coach Josh Heupel: "I'm extremely excited about the opportunity to represent UCF. What makes this opportunity so unique is the vision of the leadership from President John Hitt, Provost Dale Whittaker and Director of Athletics Danny White. Their vision for this becoming one of the premier programs in the country makes this an exciting opportunity. That vision, the amazing campus, along with the recruiting base not only allows you to have immediate success but sustained success. I'm very excited to get a staff together and get to work with our wonderful student-athletes."

UCF VP/AD Danny White: "I'm thrilled to welcome Josh and his family to UCF. I believe we've identified one of the brightest offensive minds in college football. His offensive system is very similar to what we've been running. I know he's going to utilize all the great talent on our roster and continue to add to it. He's no stranger to success, winning a national championship as a quarterback and leading a number of extremely high-powered offensive teams. Coach Heupel is in coaching for the right reasons. He cares about his student-athletes and that's one of the most important attributes I look for in a coach."

Tiger Turnaround

Heupel comes to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for the past two seasons.

In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou was ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also No. 14 in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 touchdowns. He followed that up with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record and nation-leading 44 touchdown tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of their starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Sooner Success

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to OU as a full-time assistant.

He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.



National Championship Playing Career

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
