#### leading off

- The Knights return home to John Euliano Park to open a four-game homestand, starting Wednesday against North Florida.
- UCF is looking to snap a three-game skid after being swept over the weekend for the first time since 2017.
- The Black and Gold is 5-1 against teams from the Sunshine State, with 11 more games against teams from Florida after Wednesday night.

#### a look back

- UCF hit the road for a four-game road swing.
- The four games came against teams that were ranked as high as 14 in at least one of the national polls.
- The Black and Gold struck for six runs in the fifth to knock off Florida State.
- The Knights suffered their first sweep since 2017, despite taking a first-inning lead in all three games at ECU.

#### ray keeps rayking

- Ray Alejo sits second on the team with a .377 clip at the plate and 17 RBI, well above his .292 batting average through 24 games last season.
- The redshirt junior is eighth in the nation with 40 hits and leads the team with a .651 slugging percentage.
- Always a speedster, Alejo is second in the conference with 10 stolen bases.

#### starting early

- The Knights have started hot in the opening two innings this season, outscoring opponents 44-25.
- Offensively, the bats are hitting .336, led by .500 batting average (13-26).
- The Black and Gold has also tallied 19 extra base hits, including five home runs.

#### we are #skinnerstrong

- Starting tonight, the Knights opened their annual Skinner Strong Fundraising campaign.
- The month-long drive raises money for the Skinner Strong Foundation to help combat pediatric cancer.
- Joe Skinner was a local standout who signed to play for UCF, but tragically passed away in the spring of 2016.

- Tyler Osik continues to pave the way offensively with a .385 batting average, good for sixth in the conference.

- Osik is also a perfect 7-for-7 when stealing this season and sits second in The American with 24 runs scored.

#### wolf chili on three

- UCF ranks second in The American and 24th in the nation with 10.5 strikeouts per nine innings.
- The Knights have struck out at least 10 batters in 15 games this season.
- UCF is 13-2 this season when striking out at least 10 batters and 58-25 in the Greg Lovelady era.

- The senior is tied with Mike Myers (00-02) and Tony Marrillia (92-95) for the eighth most in program history and is two back of sixth.
- Mika leads The American and ranks 40th in the nation.
- Prior to the season, Mika claimed 2019 as his year...seriously.

- The top of the UCF or produced some staggering numbers against VCU, combining for a .488 clip at the plate with 15 RBI and scoring 16 of the Knights 21 runs on the weekend.
- Alejo, Osik and Mika have combined for 104 of UCF's 227 hits this season and scored 66 runs.
- Add in Beaver to that mix and the top four have 15 homers, while the rest of the squad has six.
- The quartet has 44 extra base hits and is 31-for-37 when stealing.

no base is safe

- UCF is first in The American with 45 stolen bases.
- The Knights have stolen third 16 times and home once.
- Mika and Alejo were the top returning duo in the nation with 61 combined steals in 2018.
- The Black and Gold is going for its first back-to-back-to-back 100-steal seasons since 1988.

going, going, gone

- The Knights have 21 home runs on the season, which ranks fourth in The American.
- Alejo and Beaver matched each other with pumps at ECU to stay tied for the team lead with five.
- UCF has hit multiple homers in a game three times this season, including a season-high four against Auburn on Feb. 24.

locking it down

- UCF has held opponents to two or fewer runs eight times this season.
- Limiting opponent scoring has been a huge emphasis of the Greg Lovelady era, as the Knights are 53-2 when allowing two or fewer runs.
- The Knights have converted on seven of nine save opportunities, led by Jeff Hakanson's career-best five.

beaver bash

- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 26 RBI this season.
- He made a huge jump from 1 RBI as a freshman to 30 last season and is on pace to set a new career high.
- The junior set a career high with three runs scored and three RBI in the series opener against VCU.
- Beaver has split time between catcher (13 starts) and first base (8 starts).
- He also took the team lead with 17 walks and seven hit by pitches.

ray raykes

- Ray Alejo nearly hit for the cycle against Penn State on March 9, just missing a single to complete the feat.
- He nearly hit for the cycle in the series opener against VCU, missing out on a double on a 4-for-6 night.
- The redshirt senior has a .615 slugging percentage from a team-high 12 extra base hits, including three triples.
- The last player to hit for the cycle was Tommy Williams vs. Fairfield on March 15, 2015.

chan's the man

- Chandler Robertson has made a big jump in the starting lineup in 2019, hitting .306 through 17 games.
- The senior has 25 hits, with two extra base knocks, to go along with eight RBI.
- He's already bested his total starts (16), hits (16) and steals (0) from 2018.

playing small ball

- Greg Lovelady does not shy away from having his team bunt for hits.
- UCF has 12 bunt singles this season, as well as 15 sacrifice bunts.
- Chandler Robertson leads the team with five bunt singles.

yo soy kemp

- Kyle Kemp continued his impressive run out of the bullpen over the weekend with a season-high five strikeouts against Penn State.
- He did not allow an earned run through his first nine appearances, due largely to an .027 opponent batting average. (one hit in 12 innings)
- Kemp is one of two graduate transfers on the team this season, along with Grant Schuermann.

- Osik hit a blistering .524 with five RBI and nine runs scored over the against Yale and VCU to earn The American Player of the Week.
- Sunday starter Trevor Holloway earned Honor Roll status for seven shutout innings with seven strikeouts, numbers that would normally earn Pitcher of the Week laurels... if it were not for the perfect game thrown by ECU's Jake Kuchmaner against Maryland last weekend.
- Chris Williams was the first Knight to be recognized by The American this season.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012

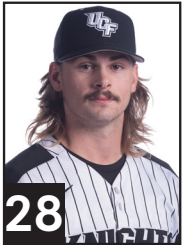

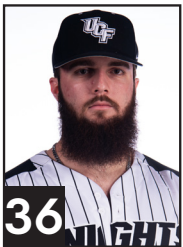
