leading off

- The Knights will face USF for a three-game series in the War On I-4.
- The two ballclubs find themselves looking up at the American Athletic Conference after two tough series to start league play.
- This weekend marks the first meeting between the two sides at John Euliano Park since 2017, when the Knights clinched The American Regular Season Championship.

a look back

- The Knights exploded for a season-high 13 runs at Stetson for a 13-4 win.
- Ray Alejo, Dallas Beaver and Matthew Mika combined to drive in six runs and record 12 hits.
- UCF improved to 26-0 when scoring 10 runs or more in the Greg Lovelady era.

war on i-4

- With two wins, the Knights will capture the War On I-4 title for the third straight year in the third season of the competition.
- UCF owns a commanding 39-6 lead. Each baseball game counts as two points.
- The Knights are 6-1 this season against the Bulls across all sports, in addition to finishing in front of USF in cross country and indoor track & field at the American Athletic Conference Championships.

getting in touch with our roots

- The Knights will celebrate their roots on Friday with Citronaut Knight.
- UCF will sport special Citronaut caps, which include the new Canaveral Blue.
- The Citronaut, an anthropomorphic orange, made his first appearance in the Florida Tech student handbook in 1968-69.
- The last time the Citronaut made an appearance at John Euliano Park was during Citronaut Day on May 10, 2014.

offensive power players

- UCF has five players hitting over .300 this season with a team slugging percentage of .412.
- The Knights have 79 extra base hits – 51 doubles, five triples and 24 home runs.
- The Black and Gold have produced with runners in scoring position with a .291 clip in those situations, led by Ray Alejo's .414 (12-29).

walk this way

- UCF is fourth in The American with 126 walks on the year and are on pace for its 10th straight campaign with at least 200 bases on balls.
- Dallas Beaver and Matthew Mika enter the weekend tied for the team lead with 20 walks, while Beaver is second in the conference in hit by pitches.
- Mika has cut down his strikeout rate considerably this season and punched out just 12 times in 126 plate appearances.

- The Knights are 8-0 in midweeks this season, including wins over No. 3 Florida and No. 14 Florida State.
- Rookie Ben McCabe has made the most of his opportunities during the week with a .462 clip (6-for-13).
- Dallas Beaver and Tyler Osik have combined for 19 RBI over those six games.
- The pitching staff has 72 strikeouts to 38 walks with a 3.63 ERA.

prime time performers

- The Knights have produced 64 multi-hit performances, including 15 three-hit games and one four-hit outing, led by Ray Alejo's 14.
- Dallas Beaver has totaled 10 multi-RBI games.
- Kyle Kemp and Jeffrey Hakanson have been clutch out of the bullpen with 27 and 31 strikeouts, respectively.
- The starting pitchers have amassed eight quality starts, topped by four from Grant Schuermann.

what's up wingo

- Dalton Wingo has been the main choice in right field after making just 23 starts in 2018.

ray keeps rayking

- Ray Alejo sits second on the team with a .360 clip at the plate and 21 RBI, well above his .264 batting average through 29 games last season.
- The redshirt junior is 17th in the nation with 45 hits and leads the team with a .616 slugging percentage.
- Always a speedster, Alejo is fourth in the conference with 10 stolen bases.

scoring early

- UCF has wasted little time getting on the board early this season, outscoring opponents 29-15 in the first inning.
- The Knights have scored in the first inning in 15 games this season, while opponents have scratched a run across in the opening frame just eight times.
- The Black and Gold is 61-18 when scoring first in the Greg Lovelady era.

oh no, o yeah

- Tyler Osik continues to pave the way offensively with a .363 batting average, on pace for the 10th best clip in program history.
- The redshirt senior is second on the team with 21 RBI and second with five home runs.
- Osik is 7-for-8 when stealing this season and has 27 runs scored.

- Matthew Mika has settled into a .326 batting average and 11 RBI in the three-spot.

early vs. late

- The offense has come out on first in the opening three innings, scoring 66 of 171 total runs (.385)
- The Knights have a team batting average of .290 with 59 RBI and 26 extra base hits in that span.

- The top of the UCF or produced some staggering numbers against VCU, combining for a .488 clip at the plate with 15 RBI and scoring 16 of the Knights 21 runs on the weekend.
- Alejo, Osik and Mika have combined for 104 of UCF's 227 hits this season and scored 66 runs.
- Add in Beaver to that mix and the top four have 15 homers, while the rest of the squad has six.
- The quartet has 44 extra base hits and is 31-for-37 when stealing.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012
