leading off

- UCF heads into its final non-conference game before play in The American starts this weekend with a record of 14-6, the second-best mark in the league.
- The Knights travel to Florida State, looking to snap a five-game slide against the Seminoles.
- The Black and Gold opened the year playing 19 of the first 20 on the road. Now, the Knights will play four straight away from home.

a look back

- The Knights won their fourth series of the year over the weekend against VCU.
- The pitching staff struck out 33 batters, opposed to just three walks.
- The offense churned out two games with 10-plus hits, including a season-high 16 in the series opener.

top heavy

- The top of the UCF produced some staggering numbers against VCU, combining for a .488 clip at the plate with 15 RBI and scoring 16 of the Knights 21 runs on the weekend.
- Ray Alejo hit .533 and totaled a team-high 14 total bases with five runs scored. He also hit for the weekend cycle.
- Dallas Beaver launched two home runs and brought in six runs for a 1.100 slugging percentage, along with four walks.
- Matthew Mika added a pair of RBI and two steals.

oh no, o yeah

- Tyler Osik has filled the void of 2018 draftee Rylan Thomas, by hitting .385 to start the year with a .564 slugging clip.
- Osik has the team's longest on-base streak at 18 games, as well as a seven-game hitting streak.
- The redshirt senior has eight extra base hits, five doubles and three home runs, to go along with perfect 7-for-7 when stealing.
- He is the son of Keith Osik a 10-year Major League player, spending seven with Pittsburgh.

honored by the american

- Osik hit a blistering .524 with five RBI and nine runs scored over the last week to earn The American Player of the Week award.
- Sunday starter Trevor Holloway earned Honor Roll status for seven shutout innings with seven strikeouts, numbers that would normally earn Pitcher of the Week laurels... if it were not for the perfect game thrown by ECU's Jake Kuchmaner against Maryland last weekend.
- Chris Williams was the first Knight to be recognized by The American this season.

no base is safe

- UCF has 41 swipes through the opening 20 games to rank 15th in the nation and first in the league.
- The Knights have stolen third 10 times and home once.
- Matthew Mika, Tyler Osik and Ray Alejo lead the way with 28 combined swipes.
- Mika and Alejo were the top returning duo in the nation with 61 combined steals in 2018.

- Matthew Mika enters the weekend with a team-leading 12 stolen bases on the year.
- The senior is tied with Mike Myers (00-02) and Tony Marrillia (92-95) for the eighth most in program history and is two back of sixth.
- Mika leads The American and ranks 31st in the nation.
- Prior to the season, Mika claimed 2019 as his year...seriously.

wolf chili on three

- UCF ranks second in The American and 23rd in the nation with 10.3 strikeouts per nine innings.
- The Knights have struck out at least 10 batters in 14 games this season.
- UCF is 11-1 this season when striking out at least 10 batters and 57-25 in the Greg Lovelady era.
- When the Knights get a big strikeout, the dugout will normally yell wolf chili on three.

the long ball

- The Knights have 16 home runs on the season, which ranks fourth in The American.
- After a pair of pumps against VCU, Dallas Beaver pulled level with Ray Alejo for the team lead with four.
- UCF has hit multiple homers in a game three times this season, including a season-high four against Auburn on Feb. 24.

locking it down

- UCF has held opponents to two or fewer runs eight times this season.
- Limiting opponent scoring has been a huge emphasis of the Greg Lovelady era, as the Knights are 53-2 when allowing two or fewer runs.
- The Knights have converted on six of their eight save opportunities, led by Jeff Hakanson's career-best five.

beaver bash

- Dallas Beaver leads the team with 21 RBI this season.
- He made a huge jump from 1 RBI as a freshman to 30 last season and is on pace to set a new career high.
- The junior set a career high with three runs scored and three RBI in the series opener against VCU.
- Beaver has split time between catcher (12 starts) and first base (8 starts).
- He also took the team lead with 15 walks and seven hit by pitches.

ray raykes

- Ray Alejo nearly hit for the cycle against Penn State on March 9, just missing a single to complete the feat.
- He nearly hit for the cycle in the series opener against VCU, missing out on a double on a 4-for-6 night.
- The redshirt senior has a .621 slugging percentage from a team-high 12 extra base hits, including three triples.
- The last player to hit for the cycle was Tommy Williams vs. Fairfield on March 15, 2015.

chan's the man

- Chandler Robertson has made a big jump in the starting lineup in 2019, hitting .306 through 17 games.
- The senior has 21 hits, with two extra base knocks, to go along with seven RBI.
- He's already bested his total starts (16), hits (16) and steals (0) from 2018.

playing small ball

- Greg Lovelady does not shy away from having his team bunt for hits.
- UCF has 11 bunt singles this season, as well as 12 sacrifice bunts.
- Chandler Robertson and Ray Alejo lead the team with four bunt singles.

yo soy kemp

- Kyle Kemp continued his impressive run out of the bullpen over the weekend with a season-high five strikeouts against Penn State.
- He is the lone bullpen arm not to give up an earned run, due largely to an .027 opponent batting average.
- Kemp is one of two graduate transfers on the team this season, along with Grant Schuermann.

benny the babe

- Ben McCabe entered the season as the third choice catcher, but has made the most of his opportunities.
- The rookie catcher recorded his first career RBI, extra base hit and multi-hit game against Ball State.
- The freshman is also 2-for-2 as a pinch hitter.

jeff jams

- Reliever Jeffrey Hakanson has embraced his role as the go-to arm out of the pen with a 1.69 ERA and an opposing batting average of .088 in 10 2/3 innings of work through the first three weeks of the year.
- The sophomore has extended to a career-long 2 2/3 innings twice this year, including a save against No. 3 Florida.
- The righty has converted five of his six save opportunities.

coming home

- Matthew Mika stole home against Florida on Feb. 27.
- The Knights have now stolen home four times since the start of 2018, led by Ray Alejo with two.
- Prior to Jackson Webb doing it against Wichita State last year, the last time the Knights swiped home came back in 2013 with James Vasquez against Texas Tech on Feb. 23.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012

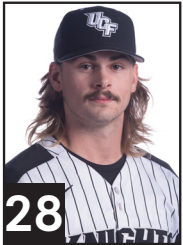

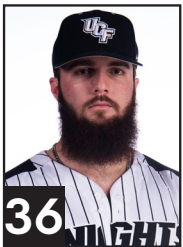

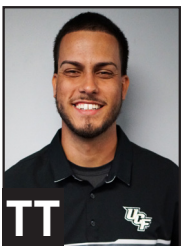
