### UCFACTS

- ▶ After starting 2018 with three wins, the Knights enter their fourth game of the season still holding the nation's longest winning streak at 16 games. A victory over Pittsburgh would extend the streak to 17, which is both a UCF and American Athletic Conference record.
- ▶ At the helm for UCF is new head coach Josh Heupel. Heupel begins his first stint as a head coach after leading Missouri's offense to new heights over the last two years as the Tigers' offensive coordinator. The former Oklahoma All-American also spent time as the Sooners' offensive coordinator from 2011-14.
- ▶ The Knights have started 3-0 under Heupel, winning against UConn, South Carolina State and Florida Atlantic. After leading the nation in scoring last season (48.2ppg), UCF is currently ninth in the nation in scoring offense (50.0ppg) and fourth in the nation in total offense (587.7ypg).
- ▶ The UCF defense has gotten it done through turnovers again in 2018. Last season, the Knights finished second in the nation with a +1.31 turnover margin and with nine turnovers through three games this season, UCF currently ranks fifth in all of FBS with a margin of +2.00.
- ▶ The Black and Gold offense has been stellar on crucial third downs. UCF leads the entire nation in third down conversion percentage through three games, having connected on 22-of-34 (65.7 percent).
- ▶ The Knights moved up in both national polls again this week. Rising three spots, UCF now ranks 13th in the AP Top 25 Poll. Up four spots in the Amway Coaches Poll, the Knights came in at 14th this week. It marks the highest that the program has ranked during the season outside the historic 2017 campaign.
- ▶ With three straight wins to start the 2018 season, it marks just the third time in the program's FBS history that UCF has begun a season 3-0. The other two times were 2013 and 2017, each of which concluded with a New Year's Six Bowl.

Pittsburgh opened the game in strong fashion as Lowell Robinson returned the opening kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown. The Panthers scored six times in the first half, as the visitors led 38-0 at intermission. The Panthers increased the lead to 45-0 with 10:26 to play in the third quarter after LaRod Stephens-Howling scored on a six-yard run. Then sophomore tailback Kevin Smith capped a UCF drive with a one-yard scoring run for the Knights' only score.

## LAST TIME OUT

McKenzie Milton accounted for six touchdowns to lead the No. 16 UCF football team to a 56-36 win over FAU Friday night at Spectrum Stadium. Milton scored three rushing touchdowns and passed for three more. The junior signal-caller was 21-of-32 passing for 306 yards and did not throw an interception. He was also the Knights' leading rusher vs. the Owls, carrying the ball 13 times for 81 yards.

Senior tight end Michael Colubiale had his best outing as a Knight. He recorded career-bests for receptions and yards receiving, hauling in six Milton aerials for 84 yards. Gabriel Davis caught five passes for 91 yards and a score. Dredrick Snelson and Marlon Williams also caught touchdown passes on the night.

Williams' TD catch was huge for momentum. The Knights led 14-0 after one quarter. FAU answered with 17 unanswered points to go on top 17-14 with just 1:34 remaining before halftime. But Milton and the Knights raced down the field, going 78 yards in just 1:03. The final 21 yards of that were covered by the Milton-to-Williams connection.

That touchdown put the Knights on top 21-17 at the intermission. UCF never trailed again. The Knights added to their lead on the first possession of the second half. They went 68 yards in 10 plays – capped by a 9-yard run from Milton – to take a 28-17 advantage.

While the defense gave up 36 points and 447 yards, the Black and Gold created three turnovers to help keep the Owls at bay. For the third consecutive game, the Knights created three turnovers. It was the second straight game with three picks.



## ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

### UCFASTER

- ▶ The Knights have **scored on 21 of their 33 possessions** this season (not including) end-of-half, running-out-the clock scenarios. That's a rate of **64 percent**.
- ▶ The Knights **scored touchdowns on 8 of their 12 possessions vs. FAU** (excluding end-of-half, run-out-the clock scenarios).
- ▶ Of UCF's 22 scoring drives, **16 have taken less than 2:39** off the clock.
- ▶ **Four of the Knights' scoring drives vs. South Carolina State took less than 45 seconds.**

### AWESOME ACADEMICS

- ▶ As a department, UCF has gone **10+ years (21 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+**.
- ▶ This **past spring**, UCF Athletics posted a **department-record 3.33** grade-point average. Last spring, more than **73 percent** of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a **3.0 or better**, with 34 percent earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 41 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
- ▶ The **Knights' football team boasts a 984 NCAA Academic Progress Rate** score. That ranks UCF **No. 14 among all FBS institutions and No. 7 among public, non-military schools**.
- ▶ As a department, **UCF's NCAA Graduation Success Rate is at 94 percent**. In the November ranking, **UCF was No. 7 in the nation** among FBS institutions. For **four straight years, the Knights have boasted the best GSR among NCAA Division I FBS public institutions**.

### THESE GUYS ARE OFFENSIVE

- ▶ UCF boasted the **No. 1 scoring offense** in the nation, averaging **48.2 points per game** in 2017. After three games **this season, UCF is No. 9**, averaging **50.0 points per game**.
- ▶ The Knights have now scored **30+ points in 16 consecutive** games.
- ▶ **No other team** in the nation **scored 30 or more** in **each game** last season.
- ▶ UCF scored **50+ points in 5 games** and **60+ 4 times** in 2017. Both were **school records**. With last week's **56-point output vs. FAU**, the Knights have scored **50 or more in 7 of their last 16** games. UCF has scored **40+ in 11 of its last 16** games.
- ▶ The Knights rank **No. 4 in the nation in total offense**, averaging **587.7 yards per game**.

### DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!

- ▶ UCF averaged **more than 10 explosive plays** per game (plays of **20 yards or more**) in 2017. The Knights are on the **same pace this season**, tallying **31 explosive plays (10.3 per game)**.
- ▶ Of the 136 explosive plays in 2017, **Knights returning** in 2018 accounted for **71 of them (52.2 percent)**. That number goes up to **101 (74.2 percent)** if you give **McKenzie Milton** credit for pass plays of 20+ yards.
- ▶ Of **this season's 31 explosive plays, 7 have gone for TDs**.

### BAKING TURNOVERS

- ▶ UCF has **created 3 turnovers in each of its first 3 contests**. The Knights rank **No. 7** in the nation in **turnovers gained** (NCAA ranks overall number, not per game).
- ▶ **Interceptions** have accounted for **7 of the Knights' 9 takeaways**. UCF ranks **No. 2 in the nation** in that category (NCAA ranks overall number, not per game).
- ▶ The Knights are **No. 5** in the nation in **turnover margin (+2.0/game)** this season.
- ▶ UCF **has not lost the turnover battle** in a game this season.
- ▶ The Knights are **No. 12 in the nation in turnovers lost**. In **2 of 3 games** (UConn and FAU), **UCF has not committed a turnover**.
- ▶ UCF was **No. 2 in the nation in turnover margin at +1.31** per game in 2017. The Knights **only lost the turnover battle twice** last season.

### THOROUGH ON THIRD DOWN

- ▶ UCF is **No. 1 in the nation in 3rd-down efficiency**.
- ▶ The Knights have converted **22-of-34** opportunities on third down (**65.7 percent**).

### PERFECTION

- ▶ With its Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl victory over Auburn, UCF completed its **first undefeated season in school history**.
- ▶ The victory over Auburn also **extended a school record for consecutive victories**, making it 13. **Three victories this season** have pushed the **nation's longest streak to 16** straight.

## OFFENSIVE NOTES

### #HISMAN CANDIDATE

Take your pick of alliterative nicknames, but magical, money, masterful all fit the bill. Junior quarterback **McKenzie Milton** finished **eighth in voting for the Heisman Trophy** and was awarded the **Archie Griffin Award** as the **nation's best player** by the Touchdown Club of Columbus in 2017. He recorded **7 300-yard passing games** last season, **tied for the most** on the UCF charts. He passed for **37 TDs** and **4,037 yards**, both school records. Milton ranked **No. 2** in the nation in **passing efficiency (179.3)**, **No. 4** in **total offense (357.7)**, **No. 4** in **completion percentage (.671)** and **No. 5** in **points responsible for (20.8 per game)**.

### QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

Milton also ranked **No. 4** in the nation last season in **passing touchdowns (37)**, even though he **didn't play in the 4th quarter in 6 of UCF's 13 games**. Milton ranks **No. 5** in the nation in **points responsible for per game**. With **12 TDs** responsible for this season, he has accounted for **72 points (24.0/game)**. Milton accounted for **6 TDs (3 rushing, 3 passing) vs. FAU**. He extended his streak of **consecutive games with a TD pass to 17**. Milton ranks **No. 6** in the nation in **total offense** and **No. 15** in **passing yards per game**. Milton is the **only QB** on the Knights' roster who has started a game. Redshirt freshman **Darriel Mack Jr.** busted off a **70-yard TD run** at UConn. That run was the **2nd-longest TD run by a UCF QB** ever (**Daunte Culpepper**, 75 yds at Kent State in 1997).

### COUBS CAN CATCH

Senior **Michael Colubiale** (aka "Coub") had a **career night vs. FAU**. The 6th-year (see below) tight end caught **6 passes for 84 yards (both career-best marks)**. Colubiale **leads the Knights in 3rd-down receptions for first downs with 3**.

### RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

Sophomore **Gabriel Davis** has been **Milton's favorite target** this season. He is **No. 2** in the **AAC** and **No. 17** in the nation in **receptions/game (6.7)**. He also has **3 TDs to lead the team**. Junior **Dredrick Snelson** has also been productive. He is **averaging 5.0 catches per game**. **Five** different Knights receivers have caught **TD passes** this season -- **Davis (3), Tre Nixon (2), Snelson (1), Marlon Williams (1), Otis Anderson (1)**. Ole Miss transfer **Nixon** had a **stellar debut. 5 catches for 101 yds and 2 TDs at UConn**. **Unexpected additions** -- In May, **Nixon** was granted **immediate eligibility** by the NCAA. Nixon saw action in 10 games at Mississippi last season. He was the Florida Dairy Farmers Class 7A Player of the Year in 2015. In June, more good news came as tight end **Michael Colubiale** was granted a **sixth year** for a medical hardship after missing much of 2015. **Colubiale** is the **only Knights TE** who has ever **caught a pass** in NCAA FBS action.

**Adrian Killins Jr.** received a great deal of **hype from YouTube/Twitter football commentator @TJ\_LSUDAD** when he busted an **87-yard TD run at Michigan** and a **100-yard kick return at ECU last in 2016**. Killins also lit up the Internet, Twitter, etc. numerous times last season. His **96-yard sprint** off right tackle vs. Memphis **broke UCF and American Athletic Conference records** for longest rush, longest TD rush and longest play from scrimmage.

### RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

**Killins** has **3 career 100-yard rushing games** including a **career-best 146 at SMU** last year. **Killins** scored **two rushing TDs vs. SC State**, marking his **4th career multi-TD performance**. **Otis Anderson** is listed as **both receiver and running back**. He was **UCF's leading rusher vs. UConn, Temple and Memphis** in **The American Championship** in 2017. **Anderson** also ranks **No. 9** in the nation with an **18.8-yard average on punt returns**. Former walk-on **Greg McCrae** was **awarded a scholarship** early in 2018 preseason camp.

### OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

UCF ranks **No. 1** in the nation in **tackles for loss allowed (1.67 per game)**. The Knights are **No. 4** in **sacks allowed (0.33/game)**. FAU scored the **first and only sack** against the Knights **last week**. Senior tackle **Wyatt Miller** has now **started 37 games**. Junior center **Jordan Johnson** has **started 28 straight games**. Senior guard **Tyler Hudanick** has **started 20 games** dating back to his freshman season.





## DEFENSIVE NOTES

### SAVAGE PAT

▶ Middle linebacker **Pat Jasinski** led the team with **104 tackles** in 2017. “Savage Pat” may look a bit more business-like this season with his fresh haircut, but it has been **business as usual** this season. He **led the team in tackles in the first 2 games**, tallying **11 vs. UConn** and **8 vs. SC State**. In addition to production on the field, he’ll be looked to even more this season for **leadership** on the defense.

### LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- ▶ The linebacker corps **picked off 3 passes last week**. **Jasinski, Eric Mitchell** and **Shawn Burgess-Becker** (Pick 6), each recorded interceptions vs. FAU.
- ▶ **Jasinski’s average of 8.7 tackles/game** ranks him **No. 56 in the nation, No. 5 in AAC**.
- ▶ **Jasinski** was the Knights’ **top tackler in 7-of-13** games last season.
- ▶ **Jasinski** ranked **No. 75 in the nation** and **No. 8 in the AAC** with **104 tackles** last season.
- ▶ **Jasinski** has played in all **41 games with 22 starts** during his career.
- ▶ **As a redshirt freshman, Mitchell** recorded **14 tackles last season**. He has **already eclipsed** that mark **with 18 total tackles**.

### NO FLY ZONE

▶ The Knights racked up **20 interceptions last season**, which ranked **No. 2 in the nation**. Of those 20 interceptions, 13 were tallied by the secondary. While UCF lost shutdown cornerback **Mike Hughes** in the first round of the **NFL Draft**, plenty of experience -- and interceptions -- return. Safety **Kyle Gibson** tied for the team lead with **four INTs** last year, while cornerback **Brandon Moore**, cornerback **Nevelle Clarke** and safety **Antwan Collier** also **picked off opposing quarterbacks** last season. The Knights have **7 INTs already this season** with **4 coming from defensive backs**.

### SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- ▶ **Gibson** was a **First-Team All-Conference** selection in 2017. He tallied his **first INT of the year against SC State**. He’s also tied for the **team lead with 3 PBUs**.
- ▶ **Richie Grant** has **2 interceptions this season** to rank **No. 10 in the nation (INT/gm)**. He saw action in **all 13 games** as a backup last season, but **has started the first 3 games** in 2018.
- ▶ **Grant** ranks **No. 18** in the nation in **solo tackles**, averaging **6.0/game**.
- ▶ Cornerback **Brandon (Bam) Moore** **started 7 games** in 2017. He played in all **13 contests**. Moore tallied **31 total tackles**, including **3 TFLs**. He **broke up 8 passes** as well, which ranked **No. 2 on the team**.
- ▶ **Collier** had his **first career start** at UConn, filling in for **Gibson** who was out for the first half after a **targeting penalty in the Peach Bowl**. **Collier** tallied his **second career INT** vs. SC State.
- ▶ The Knights have **broken up 19 passes, 13 by DBs**, including **3 each for Gibson, Moore and Clarke**.
- ▶ Two **DBs** are tied for the **team lead in tackles for loss**. **Clarke** and **Rashard Causey** each have **3 TFLs**.

### WOOT WOOT!

▶ Junior defensive tackle **AJ Wooten** has now **blocked a kick in each of his three seasons**. His **blocked field goal attempt vs. SC State** helped preserve a shutout and was his **third career blocked kick**. His previous two blocks came on PATs.

### DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- ▶ Senior **Titus Davis** moved to **defensive end** this year. He had been playing **outside linebacker** in the 3-4 scheme used the last two seasons. Davis made his **16th consecutive start** last week.
- ▶ Junior **Brendon Hayes** has **started the last two games**. SC State was his **first career start**.
- ▶ Of the Knights’ **4 sacks**, **Hayes** and **Davis** account for **half of them (1 each)**.
- ▶ True freshman **Randy Charlton** **started** in his **first-ever collegiate game at UConn**.
- ▶ **Joey Connors** recorded his **first start since the 2015 season in Week 1** at UConn and has **started all 3 games**.
- ▶ **Connors** was tied for **No. 3 on the team** with **4 pass breakups in 2017**.
- ▶ **Wooten, Connors** and **Davis** have **started all 3 games** this season on the D-Line.
- ▶ The Knights have **plenty of depth** up front. **13 defensive linemen** have recorded **at least 2 tackles** this season.

### AUTO-MATT-IC

► Senior kicker **Matthew Wright** is in his **fourth season** as the Knights' placekicker, handling **field goals and point-after touchdowns**. For his career, he is **157-of-160 on PATs (.981)**, which ranks **No. 2 on the UCF career charts**. He is also **No. 3 on the career field-goal accuracy chart at 44-of-58 (.759)**.

### SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

- **Wright** also handles **kickoff duties**. He is averaging **58.3 yards per kickoff**.
- **Wright** now has **289 points kicking in his career** and is **No. 3 on the career kick scoring chart at UCF**. He is one of **only eight UCF kickers ever to record 200 points or more**. He is **on pace to easily break the career kick scoring record of 314 by Shawn Moffitt (2011-14) and would be just the second kicker in UCF history to score more than 300 points**.
- **Mac Loudermilk** might be the most interesting punter in the nation, with his **long hair and mountain man beard**. He and his specialist mates also like to have a **little fun**. Last season, he hit a **career-best 69-yard punt** vs. UConn and added a **62-yarder** at Temple. He celebrated both by hitting **imaginary home runs**, complete with **bat-flip**.
- **Loudermilk** has **punted 7 times** this season with **2 efforts of 50+** and **2 inside the 20**.
- **Loudermilk** is also the Knights' **holder for PATs and FGs**.
- **Loudermilk** can do a **bit of everything**. His versatility was on display in the season-opening victory over FIU in 2017. **Loudermilk's three punts vs. FIU were downed inside the 20-yard line**. He also served as the **holder on PAT/field goal attempts**. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he successfully **converted a pass** to tight end **Jordan Franks** for a **2-point conversion**. In the **2016 Spring Game**, Loudermilk was playing tight end and hauled in a **long TD reception**.
- **Caleb Perez** returns as the Knights' starting **long snapper**, completing the triumvirate of returning specialists. He **did not have a bad snap** on punts, field goals or PATs **last season**.

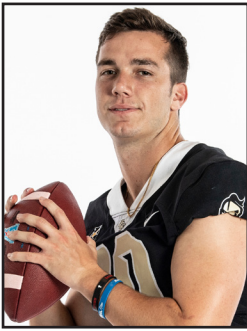

Josh Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF Football. UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Daniel J. White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017.

**Quotable**

UCF Head Coach Josh Heupel: "I'm extremely excited about the opportunity to represent UCF. What makes this opportunity so unique is the vision of the leadership from President John Hitt, Provost Dale Whittaker and Director of Athletics Danny White. Their vision for this becoming one of the premier programs in the country makes this an exciting opportunity. That vision, the amazing campus, along with the recruiting base not only allows you to have immediate success but sustained success. I'm very excited to get a staff together and get to work with our wonderful student-athletes."

UCF VP/AD Danny White: "I'm thrilled to welcome Josh and his family to UCF. I believe we've identified one of the brightest offensive minds in college football. His offensive system is very similar to what we've been running. I know he's going to utilize all the great talent on our roster and continue to add to it. He's no stranger to success, winning a national championship as a quarterback and leading a number of extremely high-powered offensive teams. Coach Heupel is in coaching for the right reasons. He cares about his student-athletes and that's one of the most important attributes I look for in a coach."

**Tiger Turnaround**

Heupel comes to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for the past two seasons.

In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou was ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also No. 14 in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 touchdowns. He followed that up with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record and nation-leading 44 touchdown tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of their starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

**Sooner Success**

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to OU as a full-time assistant.

He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.



**National Championship Playing Career**

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
