## KNIGHT NOTES

### leading off

- The Knights enter the final series of the regular season this weekend with a 9-12 mark and in seventh place in The American, just two games back of fourth.
- This weekend will be the final home series for the 10 senior members of the 2019 squad, capped with a Senior Knight on Saturday.
- UCF has put itself back in the postseason conversation after climbing up 32 spots in the RPI over the last three weeks to 44 after Tuesday night's win at FAU.
- The Black and Gold enter the weekend riding a season-long five-game winning streak, which includes wins over No. 18 Miami and No. 29 FAU.

### a look back

- The Knights launched five home runs to outlast FAU on Tuesday night, 13-10.
- Dalton Wingo went 4-for-5 with three home runs and six RBI to lead the way offensively.
- Garrett Westberg fired 2 2/3 innings of shutout ball to pick up his third save of the year.

### sunshine state champs

- With the win over FAU on Tuesday, the Knights now have a victory over every Florida opponent on its 2019 schedule.
- UCF beat No. 3 Florida, No. 14 Florida State and No. 18 Miami, marking the first time since 1985 the Knights knocked off all three.
- The Black and Gold went 15-1 against Sunshine State opponents in the regular season.

### wingo whack-em-all

- Wingo's three-home run game was the first for UCF since 2001, when Chad Ehmsberger did it on the road at Samford.
- The three home runs also tied the program record for home runs in a game, becoming just the fourth Knight to accomplish the feat.
- The sophomore nearly hit for the home run cycle with a solo shot in the third, a three-run blast in the first and a two-run homer in the eighth.

### senior sendoff

- UCF will honor its 10 senior members this weekend during the final homestand of the regular season.
- The senior class features two four-year players, six two-year members and a pair of graduate transfers.
- Together this group has posted 132 victories, including the program's first American Athletic Conference title in 2017.
- Entering the weekend, the pitching staff has totaled 32 victories, 475 strikeouts and 3.72 ERA.
- Offensively, the group has 260 RBI, 29 home runs and 121 stolen bases.

### monster mash

- With a season-high five homers against FAU, the Knights topped the 50-dingers mark this season.
- It's the fifth time in the last 10 seasons the Knights have totaled at least 50 homers, including two of Greg Lovelady's three seasons at UCF.
- While Dallas Beaver extended his team-leading tally to 11 on the year, Tyler Osik's homer on Tuesday gave him the UCF active career lead with 19.

**UCFACTS**

**cracking top 10s**  
 • Senior Chris Williams became just the 11th pitcher in program history to amass 200 strikeouts in a career.  
 • On top of ranking third in school history with 83 steals, Matthew Mika is ninth with an .834 stolen base percentage.  
 • With his next appearance, Garrett Westberg will crack the single-season top 10 for appearances with his 28th outing.

**locking it down**  
 • UCF has held opponents to two or fewer runs 16 times this season.  
 • Limiting opponent scoring has been a huge emphasis of the Greg Lovelady era, as the Knights are 61-2 when allowing two or fewer runs.  
 • The Knights have converted on 15 of 17 save opportunities, led by Jeff Hakanson's career-best six.

**0 to 100 real quick**  
 • With the win on Skinner Strong Knight in the series opener against Memphis, head coach Greg Lovelady became the fastest coach to 100 wins in program history.  
 • Lovelady eclipsed the mark in 159 games, beating legendary coach Jay Bergman to the mark by 31 contests.  
 • The third-year skipper is also the only coach in program history to make a NCAA Regional in his first year in charge.

**senior standard**  
 • With less than two weeks remaining in the regular season, the Knights are preparing to honor the 10 senior members of the 2019 squad.  
 • Eight of the seniors completed their degrees and graduated, while two more will wrap up their studies in the coming months.  
 • Offensively, the seniors have accounted for 101 RBI and 18 home runs with 48 stole bases.  
 • The senior arms have 242 strikeouts over 274 1/3 innings of work with 15 wins over 97 appearances in 2019.

**getting hot**  
 • UCF enters the week with a five-game winning streak, the longest patch this season.  
 • Dallas Beaver, Dalton Wingo and Brandon Hernandez have combined to drive in 34 runs over the last 10 games.  
 • Matthew Mika has a .375 clip at the plate with 12 RBI and is 11-for-13 when stealing over the Knights' last 15 contests.

**keeping it close**  
 • UCF has had its fair share of close games this season with 24 being decided by two runs or fewer.  
 • The Knights are 8-4 in one-run games and 7-5 in two-run games.  
 • The Black and Gold enter the weekend with 13 of its last 16 games decided by three runs or less.

**marvel at mika**  
 • Matthew Mika has been on fire over the last 10 games with a .378 clip, two RBI, nine walks and six stolen bases.  
 • The senior is one of four Knights hitting above .300 and has driven in 32 runs on the year.  
 • The recent surge should be no surprise with Avengers Endgame out. Mika is the biggest Marvel fan... like seriously... that's not hyperbole. He's consistently immersed in movies, comics or podcasts about his favorite superheroes.

**beaver bashes**  
 • Dallas Beaver has been on fire as of late, vaulting himself into third on the team with a .315 clip.  
 • The junior leads the team with 44 RBI, 49 free passes and 11 home runs.  
 • His 39 walks rank 63rd in the nation.  
 • Beaver finished his undergraduate degree in two years in criminal justice and is already past the halfway point of his master's degree in criminal justice and public administration.

**good to see you litch**  
 • David Litchfield made his UCF debut against Memphis, throwing one inning with a strikeout, hitting 93 mph.  
 • The redshirt sophomore missed all of last season due to Tommy John's surgery.  
 • Litchfield earned his first career win at Tulane, in just his second career appearance.  
 • Prior to signing with UCF he was the Florida League Cy Young winner in 2017.

**lyon in wait**  
 • Freshman Jay Lyons was thrust into the starting lineup three weeks ago against Bethune-Cookman.  
 • The rookie hit .412 with four RBI in his first four starts.  
 • Lyons came up clutch with two three-hit games, including a walk-off single to clinch the weekend series against Memphis.

**midweek vs. weekend**  
 • After difficult weekend series, the Knights have always found a way to bounce back in midweek contests with a record of 14-1, compared to a 16-17 mark on weekends.  
 • The Knights have six players hitting above .300 in midweek contests (at least 20 Abs), while weekend hitters only have a pair above .300.  
 • The pitching staff has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.36 on the weekend, compared to a 1.62 mark in midweeks.

- UCF notched its third straight 40-home run season with three bombs against Memphis.
- The Knights have launched 17 homers to start an inning, while four have started games.
- Ray Alejo leads the team with five leadoff pumps, including the first pitch of the game against USF and Tulane.

### starting pitching

- The starting pitching staff for the Knights has a 16-11 mark on the year with a 4.36 ERA and a .264 opponent batting average.
- Grant Schuermann has been the only pitcher to feature in a starting lineup every week and is second on the team with 3.94 ERA, behind Jordan Spicer's 3.38 mark.
- In contrast, opponents' starters are 7-18 on the year with a 5.39 ERA.

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012
