#### leading off

• After 268 days, UCF Baseball is finally back. This weekend will start the 47th season of a baseball team at UCF  
 • The Knights return after a 35-21 record in 2018 that saw them narrowly miss out on a berth in the NCAA Tournament as one of the "First Four Out" when the selection committee announced the field  
 • The Black and Gold will have to replace the six players that were picked in the 2018 MLB Draft. Friday night will be the first game for the 17 newest members of the UCF squad

#### series with siena

• For the 10th straight season, the Knights will face the Siena Saints, seven of those matchups have come on Opening Weekend.s  
 • UCF's rivalry with Siena dates back to 1977, and the 54-4 mark against the Saints is the best winning percentage in a series with at least 25 games  
 • Siena head coach Tony Rossi has been the skipper of the Saints for every one of those matchups, after starting his career in 1970

#### preseason all-conference nods

• Pitcher Chris Williams and outfielder Ray Alejo were named to The American Preseason All-Conference squad  
 • Williams was a lights-out starter for the Black and Gold in 2018, leading the conference in walks allowed per nine innings  
 • Alejo torched the base paths to finish atop The American in stolen bases and fifth nationally with 34

#### opening weekend warriors

• The Knights have rolled in Opening Weekends throughout program history with an 82-33-1 mark in the opening series of the year  
 • UCF is 4-2 on Opening Weekend in the Greg Lovelady era. During that stretch, the Knights have hit .289 and tossed 67 strikeouts  
 • Graduate transfer Grant Schuermann will become the 18th different pitcher to start Opening Knight since 2001

#### lovelady back for third season

• Head coach Greg Lovelady returns for his third season at UCF with a career record of 199-99  
 • Lovelady has changed the culture quickly in Orlando, setting the program record for most wins by a first-year head coach and becoming the fastest coach to 75 victories in UCF history  
 • Back in December, Lovelady was named the No. 1 in DI Baseball's Top-10 Coaches Under 40

#### power at the plate

• The Knights return the heart of the order, with the exception of All-Conference selection Rylan Thomas, who went in the 25th round of the MLB Draft to the Cincinnati Reds  
 • Tyler Osik and Dallas Beaver will have to step up as the power producers this season. Osik led The American with 56 RBI during his first campaign in Orlando, while Beaver hit .284 as a sophomore with 30 RBI  
 • The offense will also receive a major boost with the return of Anthony George after missing the 2018 campaign due to injury. He hit .294 over the course of 42 games as a sophomore in 2017  
 • Griffin Bernardo is poised for a sophomore jump following an impressive fall and a solid summer with the Cincinnati Steam of the Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League

**UCFFACTS**

**speed on the paths**

- One staple of a Greg Lovelady team is a constant threat to steal bases. The Knights ranked ninth in the nation with 109 stolen bases marking the first back-to-back 100-steal seasons since 2005
- Ray Alejo and Matthew Mika finished fifth and 23rd, respectively, with 61 combined steals. The duo tied for the most combined steals by a tandem last season
- Alejo was placed on The American Preseason All-Conference Team
- Of the 109 steals that UCF had last year, the Black and Gold return 84 swipes

**willy, willy**

- Redshirt senior Chris Williams will be the lone returner to the rotation in 2019. Last season, Williams was the only Knight to make a start in every weekend series
- Williams started 15 games with a 4-3 record, a 2.81 ERA and a 1.64 walks per nine inning tally, which led The American. He also posted a 4.65 strikeout-to-walk ratio, good for third in the league
- Williams was picked to the Preseason All-Conference Team by the coaches in The American
- Due to an NCAA compliance issue regarding his time as a member of the UCF club baseball team as a freshman 2015, Williams will miss the first nine games of the season

**rotation roles**

- While Williams is the only regular starter to return to the rotation, Lovelady will have no shortage of starting arms on the weekends and in the midweek
- Jordan Spicer is back and poised for a bounce back campaign. After transitioning to the bullpen midway through 2018, the senior made nine appearances and had 15 strikeouts over 13 innings of work
- Junior college transfer Trevor Holloway is set to be a regular feature in the weekend rotation. Holloway won a national championship with Chipola last season, where he went 8-4 over 13 starts
- Grant Schuermann is another arm that could find a spot on the weekend or in a midweek starting role. The graduate transfer from Furman has made 35 starts in his career and totaled more than 225 innings of work

**building up the bullpen**

- The Knights will have a mixed bullpen of experienced returners and newcomers
- Jeffrey Hakanson and Garrett Westberg will vie for a one-two punch in the back end. Hakanson struck out 26 batters in 14.6 innings of work last season, and Westberg posted a 1.12 ERA in 24 innings with 31 strikeouts
- A host of junior college transfers - Tom Cheshareck, Zack Helsel and Ryan Saltonstall - will look to make their mark out of the pen

**staying home**

- The Knights are slated to host 35 games this season at John Euliano Park, marking the third straight season with at least 35 games at home
- The Black and Gold will leave Orlando just once in the opening 20 games, a Feb. 27 trip to Florida

**adding to the park**

- Prior to the season, the Knights unveiled a renovated locker room, made possible by the generous contributions of several baseball alumni, including Matt Rhodes '05
- The \$140,000 project features new lockers, LED light fixtures, graphics on the baseboards and a UCF baseball light fixture in the middle of the room that houses LEDs synced for a light show
- The Premium Club is also completed for its first full season, including bar service, air conditioning and 240 seats

**otte box**

- When pitching coach Justin Parker departed for Indiana in July, Lovelady turned to a familiar foe that he had met during his time at Wright State in Xavier associate head coach Nick Otte
- After a record setting career at Indiana from 1998 to 2002, Otte spent time on staff at IPFW, Georgetown College, and Miami (Ohio), before moving to Xavier in 2010
- During nine seasons in Cincinnati, Otte guided the Musketeers to a trio of Big East titles and three NCAA Regional appearances
- Otte brings a distinct coaching style that helps the pitching staff prepare and perform with a strong mentality. In addition to mentoring the hurlers to shake off any bad pitches, Otte utilizes footage and advanced analytics to help the pitching staff improve

Greg Lovelady was named the head baseball coach at UCF on July 11, 2016. He will enter his third season in charge at UCF for the 2019 season.

Prior to the 2019 season and just shy of his 40th birthday, Lovelady was named the top coach in the nation under 40 years of age by DI Baseball.

The 2018 campaign saw the Knights post some historic storylines. On March 6, the Knights downed the top-ranked team in the nation for the first time in program history with a 9-7 victory over Florida. UCF turned around and completed its first sweep of a No. 1 ranked opponent with a 4-2 win in Gainesville the next night.

Lovelady guided UCF to its fifth-longest winning streak in program history at 13 games during the 2018 season. The Knights also recorded the second most shutouts in a single campaign with nine.

Pitching was the bedrock of the Knights' success in 2018. The pitching staff led the nation with nine shutouts and finished third in the country in hits allowed per nine innings, a school record 7.2. UCF's 3.32 ERA was among the top-15 nationally, while 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh and a 1.22 WHIP was ninth. The Black and Gold notched its second most punchouts in a single season with 556.

Continuing to improve the culture and talent level at UCF, Lovelady brought in the 16th ranked recruiting class, per Collegiate Baseball, prior to the 2018 campaign. After replacing 20 graduating seniors, the Knights went 35-21 with a 13-10 mark in The American to finish in fifth place, but the season came to a close when the Black and Gold found itself in the first four out of the NCAA Tournament.

In his first campaign with the Knights, Lovelady guided UCF to the American Athletic Conference regular-season title with an overall record of 40-22 and a 15-9 mark in league action, earning The American Coach of the Year honors in the process.

The Knights saw drastic improvements offensively and pitching in Lovelady's first year. UCF jumped up to 66th in the nation in scoring from 222nd in 2016, eighth in stolen bases up from 77th and 44th in runs from 189th.

The pitching staff posted the fifth best ERA in the nation with a 3.0, compared to the 4.23 mark during the previous year. Pitchers took the team to 28th in strikeouts per nine innings, 24th in strikeouts-to-walks ratio and 10th in WHIP.

In his career, Lovelady has coached 38 MLB Draft picks between his three coaching stops, including 14 Top-10 round selections and nine tabbed in the first five rounds. Three players under Lovelady's tutelage have gone in the first round, including the fifth overall pick in 2005 and Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun.

Lovelady came to Orlando after spending three years as the head coach at Wright State, where he led the Raiders to consecutive runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals in 2015 and 2016. As the Raiders' head coach, he has compiled a 124-56 record in three campaigns and was with the Raiders for a total of 12 years. Wright State has won the Horizon League Regular Season or Tournament Championship (or both) in each of Lovelady's three seasons at the helm. He was named the 2014 and 2016 Horizon League Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ABCA/Diamond Mideast Regional Coach of the Year.

Lovelady went to WSU after a successful playing career and three-year stint with one of the nation's elite teams in Miami (FL). The Hurricanes won two national championships, in 1999 and 2001, with Lovelady as the catcher. A four-year letterman for the 'Canes, Lovelady captained the 2001 squad that won its second national championship in three years.

Lovelady hit a career best .314 with a 14-game hitting streak during his 1999 campaign. Lovelady was also a fan favorite in Coral Gables, receiving the Arnold Novins Award in 2001, an honor bestowed on the "Most Popular Player" as voted by the fans of Miami. The 'Canes made a postseason appearance during each of Lovelady's years as a player and coach in Coral Gables. UM Reached the College World Series five times and advanced to the NCAA super regional seven times while Lovelady was on campus.

Lovelady graduated from Miami in 2001 with a degree in Finance and a minor in Sports Management as a member of the university's deans list. Professionally, Lovelady played with the Utica Blue Sox, an affiliate of the Florida Marlins, and helped develop two UM catchers and numerous pitchers into major league draft choices.

Lovelady and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Noah Preston, who was born on December 16, 2008, and Gavin Philip, born on June 10, 2012

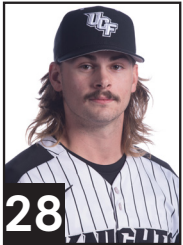

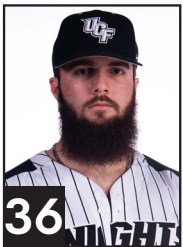

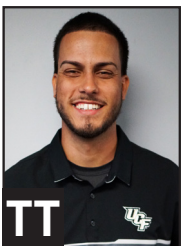
