UCFACTS

- After starting 2018 with 10 straight wins, the Knights enter their 11th game of the season still holding the nation's longest winning streak at 23 games, which is a UCF and American Athletic Conference record.
At the helm for UCF is head coach Josh Heupel. Heupel came to the Knights after leading Missouri's offense to new heights over the last two years as the Tigers' offensive coordinator.
The Knights have started 10-0 under Heupel following a 38-13 win over No. 19 Cincinnati.
The UCF defense has gotten it done with turnovers again in 2018. Last season, the Knights finished second in the nation with a +1.31 turnover margin and with 24 turnovers gained through 10 games this season.
In fact, the UCF defense has forced at least one turnover in all 10 games of the 2018 season and in each of the last 29 games, dating back to the 2016 campaign.
The Knights have scored 30 or more points in 23 consecutive games, which is tied for the 2nd-longest streak in the AP Poll Era (since 1936).
UCF moved up three spots in the AP Top 25 Poll and two spots in the Amway Coaches Poll this week.
McKenzie Milton is having another standout season for the Knights. In fact, among all FBS quarterbacks, Milton leads the way, averaging 40.7 points per game started.

A sellout crowd of 47,129 at Spectrum Stadium erupted in jubilation. With less than two minutes remaining in a tie game, Mike Hughes hit a seam and went 95 yards. The huge kickoff return gave UCF a 49-42 victory over USF in the War On I-4.

In a back-and-forth battle, UCF trailed in the fourth quarter for the first time last season. Down 34-28, quarterback McKenzie Milton found a wide open Dredrick Snelson on a 45-yard touchdown toss to give the Knights a one-point advantage.

LAST TIME OUT

Things did not start well for No. 11 UCF Saturday night at Spectrum Stadium.

On perhaps the biggest single day in the history of the UCF Football program, the Knights' first offensive play was a strip sack of McKenzie Milton for a Cincinnati touchdown. Trailing 6-0, the Knights' next possession ended in a punt that was downed at their own 35-yard line. But the defense stood tall and forced a field goal attempt that was missed.

From there, it was all Knights. UCF scored 35 unanswered points en route to a 38-13 victory over the No. 19 Bearcats.

The victory capped an incredible day on campus in the City Beautiful. Picture perfect weather, ESPN College GameDay in the morning, the ABC Saturday Night primetime game and an American Athletic Conference East Division trophy presented in the locker room all made for some massive memorable moments.



ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

AWESOME ACADEMICS

▶ As a department, UCF has gone **10+ years (21 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+**.
 8 This **past spring**, UCF Athletics posted a **department-record 3.33** grade-point average. Last spring, more than **73 percent** of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a **3.0 or better**, with 34% earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 41 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
 8 The **Knights' football team boasts a 984 NCAA Academic Progress Rate** score. That ranks UCF **No. 14 among all FBS institutions and No. 7 among public, non-military schools**.

UCFASTER

▶ The Knights have **scored on 67 of their 116 possessions** this season (not including end-of-half, running-out-the clock scenarios). That's a rate of **58 percent**.
 ▶ Of UCF's 67 scoring drives, **46 have taken less than 2:41** off the clock (**69 percent**).
 ▶ **11 of the Knights' scoring drives** this season have taken **less than 60 seconds**.

THESE GUYS ARE OFFENSIVE

▶ UCF boasted the **No. 1 scoring offense** in the nation, averaging **48.2 points per game** in 2017. **This season, UCF is No. 6**, averaging **43.6 points per game**.
 ▶ The Knights have now scored **30+ points in 23 consecutive games**.
 ▶ UCF has scored **40+ points in 14 of its last 23 games**, including **5 of 10 this year**. The Knights have reached **50+ 3 times** this season and have **half a hundred in 8 of the last 23**.
 ▶ The Knights rank **No. 6 in the nation in total offense**, averaging **528.9 yards per game**.
 ▶ UCF ranks **No. 9 in the nation in rushing offense**, averaging **257.7 yards per game**. The Knights are **No. 28 in passing offense (271.2 ypg)**.

DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!

▶ UCF has tallied **88 explosive plays (8.8 per game)** for the season. Explosive plays are defined as 20 yards or more.
 ▶ The **75-yard TD pass from McKenzie Milton to Gabriel Davis at Memphis** was the Knights' **longest play** from scrimmage **this season**.
 ▶ **Greg McCrae's 74-yard TD run at ECU** was the **longest run of the season** for UCF.
 ▶ Of the **88 explosive plays, 21 have gone for TDs** (11 passing, 8 rushing, 2 defense).

THOROUGH ON THIRD (AND FOURTH) DOWN

▶ UCF is **No. 6 in the nation in 3rd-down efficiency**, converting at **50 percent** (65-of-129).
 ▶ UCF has **converted 8 of its last 10 4th-down conversion attempts**.
 ▶ The Knights are **No. 14 in the nation in 4th-down conversions at 68.8 percent** (11-of-16).

BAKING TURNOVERS

▶ The Knights have created at **least one turnover** in each of their **last 29 games**, the **longest active streak** in the nation.
 ▶ The Knights rank **No. 9 in the nation in turnovers gained with 24** (NCAA only ranks total).
 ▶ The Knights are **No. 2 in the nation in turnover margin (+1.60/game)** this season.
 ▶ UCF **has not lost the turnover battle** in a game this season.
 ▶ The Knights are **No. 4 in the nation in turnovers lost (8 total)**. In **4 of 10 games**, UCF has **not committed a turnover**.

READY IN RED ZONE

▶ UCF ranks **No. 16 in the nation in Red Zone Defense**, allowing scores at a **75 percent clip**.
 ▶ The Knights are **No. 22 in Red Zone Offense**, scoring on **89.4 percent** of their trips inside the 20-yard line (42-of-47).

LOSS LEADERS

▶ UCF ranks **No. 4 in the nation in tackles for loss**, averaging **8.3 per game**.
 ▶ The Knights prevent losses well, also. UCF is **No. 9 in tackles for loss allowed (4.1 pg)**.

AMAZING ADJUSTMENTS

▶ **Halftime adjustments** have been **key** for the Knights this season. UCF is **outscoreing its opponents 101-23 (10.1-2.3 average)** in the **third quarter**.
 ▶ UCF has held **opponents scoreless** in the **third quarter in 6 of 10 games** this season, including last week vs. Cincinnati.

#HISMAN CANDIDATE

► Take your pick of alliterative nicknames, but magical, money, masterful all fit the bill. Junior quarterback **McKenzie Milton** finished **eighth in voting for the Heisman Trophy** in 2017 and was awarded the **Archie Griffin Award** as the **nation's best player** by the Touchdown Club of Columbus. See [Page 7](#) for **more details**.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- **Milton** ranks **No. 3 in the nation in points responsible** for per game. With **33 TDs** responsible for this season, he has accounted for **198 points (22.0/game)**.
- **Milton** was named the Walter Camp **National Offensive Player of the Week** after his Game 4 performance **vs. Pitt**, accounting for **6 TDs and 379 yards**.
- **Milton** accounted for **6 TDs (3 rushing, 3 passing) vs. FAU** as well.
- **Milton** has a **23-game streak of consecutive games with a TD pass**.
- He is **No. 10 in the nation in total offense (318.7 ypg)**, **No. 3 in yards per completion (15.5)**.
- Redshirt freshman **Darriel Mack Jr.** won the **first start** of his career at **ECU**.
- **Mack** busted off a **70-yard TD** run at UConn. That run was the **2nd-longest TD run by a UCF QB** ever (**Daunte Culpepper**, 75 yds at Kent State in 1997).

PLENTY OF OPTIONS

► The Knights have a deep wide receiver corps. Sophomore **Gabriel Davis** leads the group in **receptions (39)** and **average per catch (15.0)**. Junior **Dredrick Snelson** is **tied with Davis** for the lead in **touchdowns (5)**. Sophomore **Tre Nixon** may be the **fastest of the bunch** and has **4 TD receptions**. In addition to the starters, sophomore **Marlon Williams** and junior **Otis Anderson** are also both in double digits for receptions.

RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- **Davis** is **averaging 4.3 catches** a game, which ranks **No. 7 in the AAC**.
- **Six** different Knights receivers are **averaging 12.5 yards** per reception or more.
- **Six** different Knights receivers have caught **TD passes** this season -- **Davis (5), Snelson (5), Tre Nixon (4), TE Michael Colubiale (3), Anderson (2) and Williams (1)**.
- Ole Miss transfer **Nixon** had a **stellar debut** with **5 catches for 101 yds and 2 TDs at UConn**. He added **6 receptions for a team-high 97 yards** and a **TD vs. SMU**.
- **Unexpected additions** -- In May, **Nixon** was granted **immediate eligibility** by the NCAA. Nixon saw action in 10 games at Mississippi last season. He was the Florida Dairy Farmers **Class 7A Player of the Year** in 2015. In June, more good news came as tight end **Colubiale** was granted a **sixth year** for a medical hardship after missing much of 2015.

DUAL THREAT

► Junior **Adrian Killins** is the Knights' **starting running back**. But he's only **tied for fourth** on the team in **rushing touchdowns (4)**. But he's not having any trouble finding paydirt. He has equaled his rushing TD total with **receiving TDs (4)**, giving him **8 total (No. 2 on the team)**. Killins averages **121.2 all-purpose yards per game** (combining rushing, receiving and returning), which ranks **No. 32 in the nation**.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- **Killins** has **4 career 100-yard games** including a **career-best 146 at SMU** in 2017. He went for **113 vs. SMU this season**.
- Former walk-on **McCrae** was **awarded a scholarship** early in 2018 preseason camp. He has **2 100-yard rushing performances** and **leads the team** in rushing, despite being a **backup**.
- **Taj McGowan** scored **2 TDs vs. Temple**, marking his **4th career multi-TD** performance.
- **Otis Anderson** is listed as **Utility** on the depth chart, playing **both WR and RB**. He was **UCF's leading rusher vs. UConn, Temple and Memphis in the AAC Championship** in 2017.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- UCF ranks **No. 9 in the nation in tackles for loss allowed (4.1 per game)**.
- The Knights are **No. 19 in sacks allowed (1.2/gm)** and have allowed **0 sacks 5 times**.
- Senior tackle **Wyatt Miller** has now **started 44 games** in his UCF career.
- Junior center **Jordan Johnson** has **started 35 straight** games.
- **Johnson** has been a **vegetarian** since this past summer.
- Senior guard **Tyler Hudanick** has **started 25 games** dating back to his freshman season.
- **Miller (LT), Johnson (C) and Jake Brown (RT)** -- have **started each game** this season.



DEFENSIVE NOTES

SAVAGE PAT

▶▶ Linebacker **Pat Jasinski** has been nicknamed **Savage Pat**. While he has been slowed a bit by a nagging injury a bit this season, Savage Pat was in full effect Saturday night vs. Cincinnati. On Senior Knight, Jasinski racked up **10 tackles (7 solo stops)**, a **tackle-for-loss** and a **highlight reel forced fumble** vs. the Bearcats.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- ▶▶ **Jasinski** is **No. 2** on the Knights' **linebacking corps** and ranks **No. 4** on the team with **55 total tackles**.
- ▶▶ **Jasinski** has also contributed **5.0 tackles-for-loss**, an **interception** and **3 pass breakups**.
- ▶▶ **Jasinski** has played in all **58 games with 29 starts** during his UCF career.
- ▶▶ Sophomore **Nate Evans** ranks **No. 2** on the team with **72 tackles**.
- ▶▶ **Evans** leads the team with **2 fumble recoveries**, including one he returned **94 yds at ECU**.
- ▶▶ **Three** different Knight **linebackers** have recorded **interceptions** -- **Jasinski, Shawn Burgess-Becker** and **Eric Mitchell**. All **3** of those picks came in the win vs. **FAU**.

▶▶ **First-year starter Richie Grant** has emerged as a leader on the defense. The red-shirt sophomore leads the team in **tackles (93)** and **interceptions (4)**, while being tied for the lead in **forced fumbles (3)**. **Grant** is the definition of a **ball-hawk**. He has had his **hands on the ball 11 times** this season. **Grant** saw action in all **13 games last season** as a backup and special teams standout, but **took over the starting role** this season and has been on the field for the first snap in all 10 games.

- ▶▶ **Grant** has **4 interceptions** this season to rank **No. 11** in the nation (**INT/gm**).
- ▶▶ **Grant** ranks **No. 19** in the nation in **solo tackles**, averaging **5.6/game**.
- ▶▶ Senior **Kyle Gibson** was a **First-Team All-Conference** selection in **2017**. He tallied a **career-best 14 stops vs. Temple**. **Gibson** ranks **No. 3** on the team with **70 total tackles**.
- ▶▶ Sophomore cornerback **Brandon (Bam) Moore** started **7 games** and played in all **13** in **2017**. This season, he has started all **10 games** and has racked up **36 tackles** and **9 PBUs**.
- ▶▶ **Moore** got his **hands on the football** last week vs. Cincinnati and made the most of it. He caught a field goal attempt that was blocked and **returned it 60 yards** inside the Bearcats' 25-yard line to **set up a Knights' touchdown**.
- ▶▶ Junior cornerback **Nevelle Clarke** and **Moore** lead UCF with **9 PBUs** each.
- ▶▶ **Rashard Causey** started the **4 of last 5** at Nickel. He's tied for lead with **3 forced fumbles**.
- ▶▶ The Knights have **broken up 51 passes, 33 by DBs**.
- ▶▶ **7 different DBs** have recorded **tackles for loss**. **Gibson** has **4.5** to rank **No. 5** on the team.

TITUS = TFL

▶▶ Senior defensive end **Titus Davis** leads the team with **15.5 tackles for-loss**. His average of **1.6 TFLs per game** ranks him **No. 12** in the nation. **Davis** moved to **defensive end** this year with UCF's switch to a **4-3 alignment**. He had been playing **outside linebacker** in the **3-4 scheme** used the last two seasons. As a team, the **Knights are No. 4** in the nation in **TFLs**, averaging **8.3 per game**.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- ▶▶ **Davis** tallied **3 sacks** last week vs. Cincinnati, the **first time** a Knight accomplished the **sack hat trick** since **2016 (Errol Clarke)**.
- ▶▶ Senior **Joey Connors** had himself a Senior Knight. He tallied his **first sack** of the season, **blocked a field goal** and **recovered a fumble**.
- ▶▶ Junior **Brendon Hayes** has started the **last 9 games**. He has recorded **3.0 sacks** to share **No. 2** on the team (1 vs. SCSU, 1 vs. Pitt, 1 at Memphis). He is **No. 2** in **TFLs** with **8.0**.
- ▶▶ Junior **Trysten Hill** tallied a **pair of sacks vs. Temple** and is **tied with Hayes at 3.0**.

- ▶▶ True freshman **Randy Charlton** started in his **first-ever collegiate game** at UConn. He tallied the **first sack of his career** in Game 4 vs. **Pitt**.
- ▶▶ **Wooten** has started **9 of 10** games this season at defensive tackle.
- ▶▶ The Knights have **plenty of depth** up front. **8 defensive linemen** have recorded at least **12 tackles** this season. **13 DL** have recorded **stops** this year.

MATTY ICE

Senior kicker **Matthew Wright** is in his **fourth season** as the Knights' placekicker, handling **field goals and point-after touchdowns**. He is **No. 1 on the career field-goal accuracy chart at 53-of-69 (.768)**. For his career, he is **194-of-197 on PATs (.985)**, which ranks **No. 2 on the UCF career charts**. With his **44-yard field goal** to end the first half at Memphis, **Wright** became the Knights' **all-time leading scorer**. He now has **345 career points**.

SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

Wright is one of **only eight UCF kickers ever to record 200 points or more**. He **broke the career kick scoring record of 314 by Shawn Moffitt (2011-14)** and is **just the second kicker in UCF history to score more than 300 points**.

Wright also handles **kickoff duties**. He is averaging **58.0 yards per kickoff** with **26 touchbacks on 76 kickoffs**.

Mac **Loudermilk** might be the most interesting punter in the nation, with his **long hair and mountain man beard**. Last season, he hit a **career-best 69-yard punt** vs. UConn and added a **62-yarder** at Temple. He celebrated by hitting **imaginary home runs**, complete with **bat-flip**. He **added a golf wedge shot** to his repertoire after **putting one at the 3-yard line vs. Temple**.

Loudermilk has **punted 34 times** this season with **7 efforts of 50+** and **11 inside the 20**. Loudermilk is also the Knights' **holder for PATs and FGs**. Loudermilk can do a **bit of everything**. In the season-opening victory over FIU in 2017, Loudermilk's **three punts** vs. FIU were **downed inside the 20-yard line**. He also served as the **holder on PAT/field goal attempts**. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he **successfully converted a pass** to tight end **Jordan Franks** for a **2-point conversion**. In the **2016 Spring Game**, Loudermilk was playing tight end and **hailed in a long TD reception**.

Caleb Perez returns as the Knights' starting **long snapper**, completing the triumvirate of returning specialists. He **has not had a bad snap in 23 straight games**.

On Senior Knight, **Perez** recorded his **second tackle of the season**, making a **solo stop** on a punt return for Cincinnati.

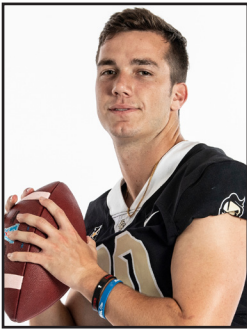

Josh Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF Football. UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Daniel J. White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017.

Quotable

UCF Head Coach Josh Heupel: "I'm extremely excited about the opportunity to represent UCF. What makes this opportunity so unique is the vision of the leadership from President John Hitt, Provost Dale Whittaker and Director of Athletics Danny White. Their vision for this becoming one of the premier programs in the country makes this an exciting opportunity. That vision, the amazing campus, along with the recruiting base not only allows you to have immediate success but sustained success. I'm very excited to get a staff together and get to work with our wonderful student-athletes."

UCF VP/AD Danny White: "I'm thrilled to welcome Josh and his family to UCF. I believe we've identified one of the brightest offensive minds in college football. His offensive system is very similar to what we've been running. I know he's going to utilize all the great talent on our roster and continue to add to it. He's no stranger to success, winning a national championship as a quarterback and leading a number of extremely high-powered offensive teams. Coach Heupel is in coaching for the right reasons. He cares about his student-athletes and that's one of the most important attributes I look for in a coach."

Tiger Turnaround

Heupel comes to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for the past two seasons.

In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou was ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also No. 14 in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 touchdowns. He followed that up with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record and nation-leading 44 touchdown tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of their starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Sooner Success

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to OU as a full-time assistant.

He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.



National Championship Playing Career

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
