UCFACTS

SETTING THE SCENE

- The Knights got back to winning ways on Saturday, taking down visiting Grambling, 70-45.
- UCF is now 7-2 on the season and looks to start 8-2 for the first time since 2011-12 with a win
 against Georgia Southern Tuesday night.
- The game between the Knights and the Eagles is the second of four straight home contests for UCF to conclude the non-conference slate.
- The Knights own a 3-1 advantage in the all-time series against Georgia Southern, with the only
 contest in the program's D1 era coming as a 61-59 UCF victory back in 2014.

DOMINATING DEFENSE

- The Knights have been dominant on defense the last two seasons under Johnny Dawkins, holding opponents to a combined 38.10 percent from the floor, which led the nation during that period.
- Only two teams in the nation were ranked in the top six in scoring defense in both 2016-17 and 2017-18, UCF and Virginia.
- The Knights led the nation in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to 36.5 percent, and in 2017-18 they ranked ranked third in the nation in scoring defense at 61.7.
- Since Nov. 11, the Knights have not given up more than 64 points in a game and now rank 11th in the nation in defensive field goal percentage (36.7) and 20th in scoring defense (60.8).

BIG SHOT BARRY

- BJ Taylor has led UCF in scoring each of his three seasons on the court, including his 15.9 points per game during an injury-riddled 2017-18 campaign.
- Taylor missed 16 games and played 16 games as a junior, suffering a broken foot.
- The Orlando native was named the Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason First Team All-Conference in The American.
- With a knack of getting to the line, Taylor ranks seventh all-time at UCF with 329 free throws.
- Taylor leads UCF again in 2018-19, currently averaging 16.7 points per game, ranking seventh in The American.

FASTEST TO FIFTY

- With Saturday's win over Grambling State, Johnny Dawkins has now won 50 games at UCF
- He is the fastest head coach in UCF's Division I era to earn 50 victories on the sidelines
- Dawkins has won 206 games in his career overall

UCF and Georgia Southern have met four times in the history of the two programs, with the Knights holding a 3-1 advantage.

The Knights have won the last three matchups, the only one since 2000 being in 2014 when UCF won 61-59 at CFE Arena.

KNIGHT NOTES

DAWKINS DOUBLE

- This season there is double the Dawkins for UCF, as Coach Dawkins' son Aubrey is healthy and available to play for the 2018-19 campaign.
- A transfer from Michigan, where he started 22 games over two years, averaging 6.7 points per game, Dawkins sat out 2016-17 and then missed all of 2017-18 due to injury.
- Dawkins has been named among the best players in the American Athletic Conference heading into this season and one of the best transfer players in the nation.

AWESOME AUBREY

- Aubrey has already been named the MVP of the Myrtle Beach Invitational and the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week once this season.
- He is currently second on the team with 15.6 points per game and leads The American with a 90.0 percent mark from the free throw line.
- Dawkins has scored in double figures in each of his first nine games as a Knight, the first player to do so in UCF's Division I era.

TAYLOR ALREADY IN THE CLUB

- Taylor became the 19th player in UCF history to join the 1,000-Point Club when he achieved the feat Feb. 21, 2018 at Tulsa.
- Taylor scored 1,000 points in just 66 games, believed to be the third fastest in UCF's Division I history behind Ken Leeks (1988-92) and Darryl Davis (1991-95).
- He now has 1,242 in his career, passing former teammate Matt Williams, Marcus Jordan and most recently Bennie Shaw for 13th place in program history.

TERRELL TERRIFIC

- Terrell Allen has had a stellar start to the 2018-19 campaign, averaging 8.6 points and ranking fifth in The American with 4.8 assists per game.
- With 43 assists and just eight turnovers, Allen also ranks fourth in the nation with a 5.4 assistto-turnover ratio.
- He has had at least four assists in every game this season.
- The point guard had a career day in the win over Saint Joseph's in the semifinal of the Myrtle Beach Invitational, scoring a career-high 22 points on a career-best four three-pointers.

TACKO TIME

- Tacko Fall leads The American and ranks fifth in the nation with 3.3 blocked shots per game
- The 7-foot-6 center was named to the Myrtle Beach Invitational's All-Tournament Team
- He also leads the league with a 77.0 field goal percentage and would lead the nation if he took enough field goal attempts to qualify.
- Fall has had 15 blocks in the last three games, accumulating 225 in his career to rank second all-time at UCF. He needs just three more to become the program's all-time leader (Keith Clanton, 227).
- Named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Preseason Watch List for the nation's best center.

CENTER OF ATTENTION

- Fall averaged a career-best 11.3 points per game, while grabbing 7.3 boards per contest as a
 junior.
- He owns the program record for career field goal percentage at 74.0, recording the three best single season marks ever at UCF, 76.7 (2017-18), 75.0 (2015-6), and 71.5 (2016-17).
- His 697 career rebounds are the sixth most in program history.

FALL FACTS

- Among the 40 tallest living human beings in the world.
- At 7-foot-6, he is the tallest player in NCAA Division I basketball and taller than any NBA player.
- Hand Length: 10.5 inches | Wingspan: 8 feet, 4 inches | Shoe Size: 22

BEATING BAMA

- Last year's win over Alabama was the Knights' first ever true road victory over a ranked opponent and just the fifth ever win over a ranked team in program history.
- On Nov. 29, UCF won the back half of the home-and-home series against the Crimson Tide, earning a 70-64 victory in Orlando.
- It was Terrell Allen leading the way for UCF in the win back on Dec. 3, 2017, scoring 16 points and dishing out six assists in the victory.
- This year it was Taylor, scoring 24 points to lead the way.

KNIGHT NOTES

SEASON NUMBER THREE

- The UCF men's basketball team is in year three under head coach Johnny Dawkins.
- The Knights went 43-25 in their first two seasons with Dawkins, the most wins in consecutive seasons for the program since winning back-to-back ASUN Championships in 2003-04 and 2004-05.
- Before Dawkins got to UCF, the Knights endured three straight losing seasons.

TALKIN' DAWKINS

- After the win on opening night, Johnny Dawkins now has over 200 wins in his career, having spent eight seasons at the helm of the Stanford Cardinal before arriving in Orlando.
- The former Naismith Player of the Year at Duke also coached under his former Coach, Mike Krzyzewski, from 1998 to 2008.
- After his first season at UCF, Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Ben Jobe and Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year awards.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS

- With B.J. Taylor and Tacko Fall sidelined for half the season each (playing one total game together), and Aubrey Dawkins missing the entire season in 2017-18, the Knights fought their way to a 19-13 record in 2017-18.
- With those three back and healthy, and every integral piece aside from A.J. Davis returning, the
 expectations for UCF were extremely high in the preseason.
- The Knights were picked to win The American by the league's coaches, a first for the program in its Division I history. Even after four ASUN Championships, UCF had never before been picked to win the league by the coaches.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- For the first time in program history, UCF was receiving votes in both national polls heading into the season, garnering 15 votes in the AP Top 25 Poll and five votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll
- Last season was the first time the Knights had been receiving votes in any national poll during the preseason, collecting one vote in the AP Poll.
- NCAA.com ranked UCF 23rd in its preseason power rankings, while CBS Sports has ranked the Knights 31st overall heading into the 2018-19 season.

DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Both Dawkins and Collin Smith recorded double-doubles in their first game as Knights.
- It was the first time a UCF player had a double-double in his first game as a Knight since Nick Banyard did it to start the 2016-17 season.
- It marked the first time ever that a pair of new Knights both recorded double-doubles in their first game as a member of the UCF men's basketball team.

KNIGHTS SAY NO

- In the season opener, UCF recorded 10 blocked shots against Rider.
- It marked the first time the Knights have recorded 10 or more blocks in a game since having 13 on Dec. 5, 2015 against Illinois-Chicago.
- Fall had five himself, while Dawkins, Collin Smith and Chad Brown each had two.

MR. SMITH GOES TO THE HOLE

- A transfer from George Washington, Collin Smith recorded a double-double in his first game as a Knight, scoring 14 points and grabbing a career high 13 rebounds against Rider.
- Smith was 4-of-10 from the floor and just 6-of-15 from the line, marking the first time a Knight
 has taken 15 free throws since B.J. Taylor did so on Jan. 17, 2015 at Memphis.
- Smith added a blocked shot and three assists in his debut.





Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016 and has had immediate success in his first two seasons with the Knights.

Dawkins took over a 12-18 squad that hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13 and led the Knights to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever - in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion

SMU in the semifinals.

A season full of firsts, UCF hosted its first NIT game in 2016-17, defeating Colorado for the program's first ever win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first ever sell-out crowd at CFE Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final Four.

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all of NCAA Division I in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year.

Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards his first season at UCF, but he also guided a number of his players to accomplishments along the way.

2016-17 Individual Honors

- Tacko Fall was named The American Defensive Player of the Year, Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America, and finalist for Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award
- B.J. Taylor earned Second Team All-Conference honors from The American after leading UCF with 17.4 points per game
- Matt Williams set new UCF records for three-pointers in a career, in a season and in a game, before signing a professional contract with the Miami Heat

In year two at the helm, Dawkins had to deal with significant injuries to his three best players. His son, Aubrey Dawkins, missed the entire season with a shoulder injury, B.J. Taylor missed the first half of the season, and Tacko Fall missed the second half of the year. Taylor and Fall only played one game together.

Through the injuries, Dawkins led the Knights to a 19-13 record, second only to his first season record in the last five years of UCF Basketball.

The team also had a number of firsts in year two under Dawkins.

And the defense was as good as ever in Dawkins' second year coaching the Black and Gold.

In two years, Johnny Dawkins has led UCF to new heights on the basketball court, but he has done an even better job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team GPA over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history. They then did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 this spring.

STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.





DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. He also currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, an independent committee of current and former coaches, charged with promoting ethical conduct through leadership, education and mentoring opportunities, while identifying key issues challenging the coaching community.




