UCFACTS

▶ After starting 2018 with six straight wins, the Knights enter their seventh game of the season still holding the nation's longest winning streak at 19 games. A victory over ECU would extend the streak to 20, which continues to be both a UCF and American Athletic Conference record.

▶ At the helm for UCF is new head coach Josh Heupel. Heupel came to the Knights after leading Missouri's offense to new heights over the last two years as the Tigers' offensive coordinator. The former Oklahoma All-American also spent time as the Sooners' offensive coordinator from 2011-14.

▶ The Knights have started 6-0 under Heupel following last weekend's 31-30 victory at Memphis. After leading the nation in scoring last season (48.2ppg), UCF is currently seventh in the nation in scoring offense (45.7ppg) and third in the nation in total offense (555.5ypg).

▶ The come-from-behind victory over Memphis was the third largest deficit overcome in program history for UCF. The Knights came back from down 16 points in the second quarter to beat the Tigers at the Liberty Bowl, trailing only a pair of 21-point comebacks in 2013 and 1988.

▶ The UCF defense has gotten it done with turnovers again in 2018. Last season, the Knights finished second in the nation with a +1.31 turnover margin and with 13 turnovers gained through six games this season, UCF currently ranks seventh in all of FBS with a margin of +1.33.

▶ Other than this past weekend, the Black and Gold offense has been stellar on crucial third downs. UCF ranks fifth in the nation in third down conversion percentage even after going 2-of-12 at Memphis, having connected on 41-of-78 (52.6 percent).

▶ Despite the win and a number of losses near the top of the polls, the Knights stayed put in the national polls, currently at ninth in the Amway Coaches Poll and 10th in the AP Top 25 Poll. It is still the highest that the program has ever been ranked other than 2017's final rankings (6th, 7th).

▶ With six straight wins to start the 2018 season, it marks just the second time in the program's FBS history that UCF has begun a season 6-0. The other time was last year's undefeated national championship campaign.

No. 21/22 UCF came into Oct. 14, 2017 leading the nation in scoring and proved why on that Saturday night against ECU. The Knights racked up exactly 600 yards of total offense in a 63-21 rout of the Pirates. The Knights (5-0, 3-0) found the end zone on offense, defense and special teams for the first time in 2017 and the first time since defeating ECU 47-29 in Greenville, N.C. in 2016.

Against the Pirates, UCF tallied 365 yards through the air and 235 on the ground. Seven different players scored an offensive touchdown. The Knights finished with seven plays of 20 yards or more.

LAST TIME OUT

Since head coach Josh Heupel arrived at UCF back in December, he's been talking to the Knights about overcoming adversity.

Heupel met with the ABC broadcasters calling the game Friday night at the team hotel. With defensive end Titus Davis and quarterback McKenzie Milton in the room, he joked about how they had heard the message ad nauseum. Saturday afternoon and evening at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium, his team had to show it had been listening.

The UCF defense pitched a shutout in the second half, the offense managed a pair of second-half touchdowns in a driving rain and the Knights held on for a 31-30 road victory to extend the nation's longest winning streak to 19 games.

The Knights gave up 30 points in the first half, scored just 17 and not much was going right. The offense was came into the game No. 2 in the nation in third-down conversions was just 1-of-5 on third down in the first half. The defense allowed 339 yards, including 222 rushing yards, in the first half.



ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- ▶ As a department, UCF has gone **10+ years (21 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+**.
- ▶ This **past spring**, UCF Athletics posted a **department-record 3.33** grade-point average. Last spring, more than **73 percent** of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a **3.0 or better**, with 34% earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 41 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
- ▶ The **Knights' football team boasts a 984 NCAA Academic Progress Rate** score. That ranks UCF **No. 14 among all FBS institutions and No. 7 among public, non-military schools**.

UCFASTER

- ▶ The Knights have **scored on 41 of their 70 possessions** this season (not including end-of-half, running-out-the clock scenarios). That's a rate of **59 percent**.
- ▶ Of UCF's 41 scoring drives, **30 have taken less than 2:41** off the clock (**73 percent**).
- ▶ **Four of the Knights' scoring drives vs. South Carolina State took less than 45 seconds**.

THESE GUYS ARE OFFENSIVE

- ▶ UCF boasted the **No. 1 scoring offense** in the nation, averaging **48.2 points per game** in 2017. **This season, UCF is No. 7**, averaging **45.7 points per game**.
- ▶ The Knights have now scored **30+ points in 19 consecutive** games.
- ▶ UCF scored **50+ points in 5 games and 60+ 4 times** in 2017. Both were **school records**. UCF has scored **40+ points in 13 of its last 19 games**.
- ▶ The Knights rank **No. 3 in the nation in total offense**, averaging **555.5 yards per game**.
- ▶ UCF ranks **No. 11 in the nation in rushing offense**, averaging **252.2 yards per game**. The Knights are **No. 17 in passing offense (303.5 ypg)**.
- ▶ Only **two teams** in the nation rank among the **Top 20 in rushing offense, passing offense, total offense and scoring offense -- UCF and Houston**.

DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!

- ▶ UCF averaged **more than 10 explosive plays** per game (plays of **20 yards or more**) in 2017. The Knights are on the **same pace this season**, tallying **60 explosive plays (10.0 per game)**.
- ▶ The **75-yard touchdown pass from McKenzie Milton to Gabriel Davis at Memphis** last week was the Knights' **longest play** from scrimmage **this season**.
- ▶ **Taj McGowan's 71-yard TD run at Memphis** was the **longest run of the season** for UCF.
- ▶ Of **this season's 60 explosive plays, 14 have gone for TDs** (7 passing, 6 rushing, 1 INT).

THOROUGH ON THIRD DOWN

- ▶ UCF is **No. 5 in the nation in 3rd-down efficiency**, despite going 2-of-12 last week.
- ▶ The Knights have converted **41-of-78 opportunities** on third down (**53 percent**).

BAKING TURNOVERS

- ▶ UCF has **created at least one turnover in each of its first 6 contests**.
- ▶ The Knights rank **No. 21 in the nation in turnovers gained**.
- ▶ **Interceptions** have accounted for **8 of the Knights' 13 takeaways**.
- ▶ The Knights are **No. 7 in the nation in turnover margin (+1.33/game)** this season.
- ▶ UCF **has not lost the turnover battle** in a game this season.
- ▶ The Knights are **No. 5 in the nation in turnovers lost**. In **3 of 6 games**, UCF has **not committed a turnover**.

NO FLY ZONE

- ▶ UCF ranks **No. 16 in the nation in interceptions** (NCAA ranks overall number, not per game).
- ▶ The Knights are **No. 16 in Pass Efficiency Defense** (106.19).
- ▶ UCF is **No. 18 in the nation in passing yards allowed**, giving up just **180.3 yards per game**.

LOSS LEADERS

- ▶ UCF ranks **No. 4 in the nation in tackles for loss**, averaging **9.0 per game**.
- ▶ The Knights prevent losses well, also. UCF is **No. 3 in tackles for loss allowed (3.33 pg)**.

PERFECTION

- ▶ With its Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl victory over Auburn last season, UCF completed its **first undefeated season in school history**.
- ▶ **Six victories this season** have pushed the **nation's longest win streak to 19** straight.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

#HISMAN CANDIDATE

► Take your pick of alliterative nicknames, but magical, money, masterful all fit the bill. Junior quarterback **McKenzie Milton** finished **eighth in voting for the Heisman Trophy** and was awarded the **Archie Griffin Award** as the **nation's best player** by the Touchdown Club of Columbus. See **Page 7** for **more details**.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- **Milton** was named the Walter Camp **National Offensive Player of the Week** after his Game 4 performance **vs. Pitt**, accounting for **6 TDs** and **379 yards**.
- **Milton** ranks **No. 5 in the nation in points responsible for** per game. With **22 TDs** responsible for this season, he has accounted for **132 points (22.0/game)**.
- **Milton** accounted for **6 TDs (3 rushing, 3 passing) vs. FAU** as well.
- He has extended his streak of **consecutive games with a TD pass to 20**.
- **Milton** is **No. 7 in the nation in total offense (333.5 ypg)** and **No. 11 in passing yards (299.5)**.
- **Milton** is the **only QB** on the Knights' roster **who has started a game**.
- Redshirt freshman **Darriel Mack Jr.** busted off a **70-yard TD run** at UConn. That run was the **2nd-longest TD run by a UCF QB** ever (**Daunte Culpepper**, 75 yds at Kent State in 1997).

GABE'S GRABS

- Sophomore **Gabriel Davis** ranks **No. 4 in the American Athletic Conference** and **No. 48 in the nation in receptions per game** with **5.5 catches** per contest. Davis has caught **one touchdown pass in 5 of the first 6 games** this season. **Davis** tallied a **career-best 128 receiving yards** last week at **Memphis**, marking his **second 100-yard game** of the season.

RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- Junior **Dredrick Snelson** is **averaging 4.6 catches** per game, which ranks **No. 8 in the AAC**.
- **Six** different Knights receivers have caught **TD passes** this season -- **Davis (5), Tre Nixon (3), Otis Anderson (2), Snelson (2), Marlon Williams (1) and Michael Colubiale (1)**.
- Ole Miss transfer **Nixon** had a **stellar debut. 5 catches** for **101 yds** and **2 TDs at UConn**. He added **6 receptions** for a **team-high 97 yards** and a **TD vs. SMU**.
- **Unexpected additions** -- In May, **Nixon** was granted **immediate eligibility** by the NCAA. **Nixon** saw action in 10 games at Mississippi last season. He was the Florida Dairy Farmers Class 7A Player of the Year in 2015. In June, more good news came as tight end **Colubiale** was granted a **sixth year** for a medical hardship after missing much of 2015.
- **Colubiale** is the **only current Knights TE** who has ever caught a pass in a collegiate game.

TAJ TO THE HOUSE

- **Taj McGowan** is the **lone senior** in the **running back** corps. His role has largely been as a **short-yardage specialist** and he has **willingly accepted** his role in a room that features numerous playmakers. But last week at **Memphis**, in a short-yardage situation, he **showed he can hit a home run**, as well. With UCF trailing 30-17 late in the third quarter, the Knights lined up on **4th-and-1 from their own 29**. With defensive lineman **Trysten Hill** as the **lead blocker**, **McGowan** slammed into the hole and found nothing but turf in front of him. **71 yards** later, he had a **career-long run** and changed the **momentum** of the contest. He finished with **81 yards on 4 carries. Two of his 4 carries** were on **4th-and-1** and the Knights **converted both**.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- **McGowan** scored **2 TDs vs. Memphis**, marking his **3rd career multi-TD** performance.
- **Adrian Killins** has **4 career 100-yard games** including a **career-best 146 at SMU** in 2017.
- **Otis Anderson** is listed as **Utility** on the depth chart, playing both WR and RB. He was **UCF's leading rusher vs. UConn, Temple and Memphis in the AAC Championship** in 2017.

- UCF ranks **No. 3 in the nation in tackles for loss allowed (3.33 per game)**.
- The Knights are **No. 14 in sacks allowed (1/gm)** and have allowed **0 sacks 3 times** in '18.
- Senior tackle **Wyatt Miller** has now **started 40 games** in his UCF career.
- Junior center **Jordan Johnson** has **started 31 straight** games.
- Senior guard **Tyler Hudanick** has **started 23 games** dating back to his freshman season.
- UCF's **starting offensive line** -- **Miller, Hudanick, Johnson, Cole Schneider and Jake Brown** -- have **started each game** this season.



DEFENSIVE NOTES

EVANS ELEVATES GAME

▶▶ Linebacker **Nate Evans** has been in the **starting lineup** each of the **last four games**. He has responded to an expanded role in the defense. Evans tallied a **career-best** and **team-high 11 stops vs. Pitt** in Game 4 and was tied for the **team lead** in tackles in **Game 5 vs. SMU with 8 total tackles**. Evans was **No. 2** on the team with **9 stops at Memphis**, adding a **forced fumble**.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

▶▶ Senior **Pat Jasinski** is **No. 2** on the Knights' **linebacking corps** and ranks **No. 3** on the team with **31 total tackles**.

▶▶ **Jasinski** has also contributed **3.5 tackles-for-loss**, an **interception** and **2 pass breakups**.

▶▶ **Jasinski** has played in all **44 games with 25 starts** during his career.

▶▶ True freshman **Eric Gilyard** **stepped up at Memphis** last week. With **Jasinski** limited by injury, **Gilyard took over** at middle linebacker, tallying **8 stops** including a **TFL**.

▶▶ **Three** different Knight **linebackers** have **recorded interceptions** -- **Jasinski, Shawn Burgess-Becker** and **Eric Mitchell**. All **3** of those picks came in the win vs. **FAU**.

▶▶ As a **redshirt freshman**, **Mitchell** recorded **14 tackles last season**. He has **already eclipsed** that mark with **22 total tackles**, despite missing the Pitt game with an injury.

PICK 'EM

▶▶ The Knights racked up **20 interceptions last season**, which ranked **No. 2 in the nation**. Of those 20 interceptions, 13 were tallied by the secondary. While UCF lost shutdown cornerback **Mike Hughes** in the first round of the **NFL Draft**, plenty of experience -- and interceptions -- return. Safety **Kyle Gibson** tied for the team lead with **four INTs** last year, while cornerback **Brandon Moore**, cornerback **Nevelle Clarke** and safety **Antwan Collier** also **picked off opposing quarterbacks** last season. The Knights have **8 INTs already this season** with **5 coming from defensive backs**.

SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

▶▶ **Grant** has **3 interceptions this season** to rank **No. 9 in the nation (INT/gm)**. He saw action in all **13 games** as a backup last season, but **has started the first 6 games** in 2018.

▶▶ **Grant** ranks **No. 12** in the nation in **solo tackles**, averaging **6.2/game**. Each of **Grant's 12 tackles at Memphis** last week was a **solo stop**.

▶▶ **Grant** is also the **team's leading tackler** with **54 stops**.

▶▶ **Gibson** was a **First-Team All-Conference** selection in 2017. He tallied his **first INT of the year against SC State**.

▶▶ Cornerback **Brandon (Bam) Moore** **started 7 games** and **played in all 13** in 2017. **This season**, he has **started all 6 games** and has racked up **27 tackles** and **6 PBUs (No. 2 on team)**.

▶▶ **Clarke** is **pacing the team** with **7 pass breakups**. He has **24 tackles**.

▶▶ **Collier** had his **first career start** at UConn, filling in for **Gibson** who was out for the first half after a **targeting penalty in the Peach Bowl**. **Collier** tallied his **second career INT** vs. SC State.

▶▶ The Knights have **broken up 30 passes, 21 by DBs**.

▶▶ **7 different DBs** have recorded **tackles for loss**. **Clarke** has **4.0** to rank **No. 3 on the team**.

TITUS = TFL

▶▶ Senior defensive end **Titus Davis** leads the team with **8.0 tackles for-loss**. Davis moved to **defensive end** this year with UCF's switch to a **4-3 alignment**. He had been playing **outside linebacker** in the **3-4 scheme** used the last two seasons. As a **team**, the **Knights are No. 4** in the nation in **TFLs**, averaging **9.0 per game**.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

▶▶ Junior **Brendon Hayes** has **started the last 5 games**. He has recorded **3.0 sacks to lead the team** this season (1 vs. SCSU, 1 vs. Pitt, 1 at Memphis). He is **No. 2** in TFLs with 6.0.

▶▶ Of the Knights' **10 sacks**, **defensive linemen** account for **more than half (6)**.

▶▶ True freshman **Randy Charlton** **started** in his **first-ever collegiate game at UConn**. He tallied the **first sack of his career** in Game 4 vs. **Pitt**.

▶▶ **Joey Connors** recorded his **first start since the 2015 season in Week 1** at UConn and started the **first 5 games**.

▶▶ **Wooten** has **started all 5 games** this season at defensive tackle.

▶▶ The Knights have **plenty of depth** up front. **13 defensive linemen** have recorded **at least 2 tackles** this season.

AUTO-MATT-IC

Senior kicker **Matthew Wright** is in his **fourth season** as the Knights' placekicker, handling **field goals and point-after touchdowns**. For his career, he is **173-of-176 on PATs (.983)**, which ranks **No. 2 on the UCF career charts**. He is also **No. 3 on the career field-goal accuracy chart at 48-of-62 (.774)**. With his **44-yard field goal** to end the first half at Memphis, **Wright** became the Knights' **all-time leading scorer**. He now has **317 career points**.

SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

- Wright is one of **only eight UCF kickers ever to record 200 points or more**. He **broke the career kick scoring record of 314 by Shawn Moffitt (2011-14)** last week and is **just the second kicker** in UCF history to score more than **300 points**.
- Wright also handles **kickoff duties**. He is averaging **58.3 yards per kickoff** with **13 touchbacks on 46 kickoffs**.
- Mac Loudermilk might be the most interesting punter in the nation, with his **long hair and mountain man beard**. Last season, he hit a **career-best 69-yard punt** vs. UConn and added a **62-yarder** at Temple. He celebrated by hitting **imaginary home runs**, complete with **bat-flip**.
- Loudermilk has **punted 20 times** this season with **5 efforts of 50+** and **5 inside the 20**.
- Loudermilk is also the Knights' **holder for PATs and FGs**.
- Loudermilk can do a **bit of everything**. In the season-opening victory over FIU in 2017, Loudermilk's **three punts** vs. FIU were downed **inside the 20-yard line**. He also served as the **holder on PAT/field goal attempts**. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he successfully **converted a pass** to tight end **Jordan Franks** for a **2-point conversion**. In the **2016 Spring Game**, Loudermilk was playing tight end and hauled in a **long TD reception**.
- Caleb Perez** returns as the Knights' starting **long snapper**, completing the triumvirate of returning specialists. He **has not had a bad snap** on punts, in **19 straight games**.

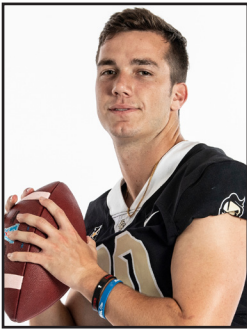

Josh Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF Football. UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Daniel J. White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017.

Quotable

UCF Head Coach Josh Heupel: "I'm extremely excited about the opportunity to represent UCF. What makes this opportunity so unique is the vision of the leadership from President John Hitt, Provost Dale Whittaker and Director of Athletics Danny White. Their vision for this becoming one of the premier programs in the country makes this an exciting opportunity. That vision, the amazing campus, along with the recruiting base not only allows you to have immediate success but sustained success. I'm very excited to get a staff together and get to work with our wonderful student-athletes."

UCF VP/AD Danny White: "I'm thrilled to welcome Josh and his family to UCF. I believe we've identified one of the brightest offensive minds in college football. His offensive system is very similar to what we've been running. I know he's going to utilize all the great talent on our roster and continue to add to it. He's no stranger to success, winning a national championship as a quarterback and leading a number of extremely high-powered offensive teams. Coach Heupel is in coaching for the right reasons. He cares about his student-athletes and that's one of the most important attributes I look for in a coach."

Tiger Turnaround

Heupel comes to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for the past two seasons.

In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Missouri was ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also No. 14 in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 touchdowns. He followed that up with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record and nation-leading 44 touchdown tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of their starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Sooner Success

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to OU as a full-time assistant.

He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.



National Championship Playing Career

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
