## UCFACTS

► Since the start of the 2017 season, the Knights have won 36 of their last 40 games overall, which included a school-record streak of 25 straight wins. Since Josh Heupel took over for the 2018 season, UCF is 23-4, and his 22-4 record in 2018 and 2019 was the best two-year record for any FBS program that had a new coach start in 2018.

► The expectations after back-to-back American Athletic Conference championships and two trips to New Year's Six Bowl games in 2017 and 2018 were at an all-time high, which is the only reason why a 10-3 record felt like a slight disappointment to some. A 10-win season is nothing to take for granted, but the Knights know they could have been better, losing all three games on the road by a combined seven points. Josh Heupel took his UCF squad back to a bowl in his second season at the helm, winning the 2019 Gasparilla Bowl over Marshall to give the Knights their third-straight 10-win campaign.

► The Knights have gone 13-0, 12-1 and 10-3 the last three seasons, totaling 35 wins during that span, which makes UCF one of just six FBS programs in the nation to do so. The Knights join Alabama, Clemson, Georgia, Ohio State and Oklahoma in the elite category since 2017.

► Despite the three losses, something UCF wasn't used to enduring, the program finished the 2019 season ranked in the top 25 yet again. The Knights ended the year 24th in both the Associated Press Top 25 poll and the Amway Coaches Poll, marking the third straight year finishing in the Top 25. The Knights improved to 21st in both polls by the time the 2020 preseason lists came out this summer and are now ranked 13th and 15th this week.

► Heading into the 2020 season, UCF has won 21 consecutive games at its home stadium, fondly named the Bounce House this year. That streak is currently the second longest in the nation, behind only Clemson, which has won 22 straight games at home.

UCF and ECU have squared off 18 times in the history of the two programs, with the Pirates holding a 10-8 advantage.

Lately, the Knights have held the advantage, winning each of the last four outings and six of the last seven meetings.

In Greenville, ECU holds a 6-4 advantage, but again it has been UCF dominating as of late, winning the last three matchups in Carolina.

Last season UCF won 41-28 in Orlando as Dillon Gabriel threw for 365 yards and two touchdowns, while Otis Anderson rushed for 80 yards.

ECU signal-caller Holton Ahlers also threw for over 300 yards in the last meeting between these two teams.

• Holton Ahlers returns at quarterback after passing for 3,387 yards and 20 touchdowns, while rushing for 359 yards and six scores a year ago.

• The Pirates' leading rusher from 2019 also returns this season. Demetrius Mauney finished last year with 446 yards on 125 carries.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The 13th-ranked UCF football team finished with 660 yards of total offense and five turnovers to open the 2020 season 1-0 after defeating Georgia Tech 49-21 on the road Saturday afternoon at Bobby Dodd Stadium.

Sophomore quarterback Dillon Gabriel threw for a career high 417 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Knights to their 36th win in the last 40 games. After allowing the Yellow Jackets to get within one score early in the fourth quarter, at 28-21, UCF scored three straight touchdowns to earn the 28-point victory.

The defense did their part as well, recovering three fumbles and picking off two passes. Senior Richie Grant, sophomore Dyllon Lester and true freshman Josh Celiscar each grabbed one ball off the ground on Saturday.

Celiscar, in his first collegiate game, also grabbed an interception after Randy Charlton batted the ball at the line. Charlton also had 1.5 tackles for loss and four quarterback hurries. Stephon Zayas also grabbed his first career interception for the Knights defense.

Junior Eriq Gilyard led UCF with 10 tackles and two tackles for loss while also forcing a fumble. The Knights, who led the nation with 9.0 tackles for loss last season, ended the day with 6.0 TFLs as a team.





ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

**AWESOME ACADEMICS**

- ▶ This past spring, UCF Athletics extended its streak to 25 straight semesters with a department average GPA of 3.0 or better and it marked the seventh straight semester of a 3.2 or better as a department.
- ▶ The UCF football team put 51 student-athletes on the American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team this past spring.

**WINNINGEST FOUR-YEAR RUN**

- ▶ Prior to the start of the 2016 season, the UCF football program's best four-season run was from 2010 to 2013, when the Knights went 38-15, won two conference championships and earned a trio of bowl victories.
- ▶ During UCF's most recent four-year run starting with the 2016 season, the Knights went 41-11 to mark the winningest four-season stretch in program history.
- ▶ UCF has won two conference championships and appeared in four bowls during that span, the first time the Knights have played in four consecutive bowl games.
- ▶ All UCF will need to do is win seven games in 2020 to mark an even better four-year stretch, and the Knights have opened up the year 1-0.

**KNIGHTS IN THE TOP 25**

- ▶ The Knights finished the 2019 season ranked 21st in both the AP Top 25 Poll and the Amway Coaches Poll, marking the fifth time in program history ending the season ranked in the top 25 (2010, 2013, 2017, 2018, 2019).
- ▶ UCF entered the 2020 season ranked 21st in both polls, earning a preseason ranking for the third consecutive season.
- ▶ Before playing a game in 2020, the Knights moved up to 13th in the Coaches Poll and 14th in the AP Poll and now rank 13th in the AP Poll and 15th in the Coaches Poll.
- ▶ As it stands, UCF has been ranked in the Top 25 for 50 total weeks, and holds a record of 36-4 when ranked. The first times the Knights were ranked was Week 11 of the 2010 season. UCF's highest ranking was sixth, the final ranking of the 2017 season.

**NATIONAL EXPOSURE**

- ▶ UCF ranks among the national leaders in national television appearances by its football squad over the last two seasons.
- ▶ In 2018 and 2019 combined, the Knights appeared 18 times on either ABC, ESPN or ESPN2, ranking tied for 11th nationally in that category.
- ▶ Saturday marks UCF's first appearance on ESPN+.

**BOWL HISTORY**

- ▶ The Knights appeared in their fourth consecutive bowl game in 2019, a first for the program. UCF played in the Cure Bowl in 2016, the Peach Bowl in 2017, the Fiesta Bowl in 2018 and now the Gasparilla Bowl following the 2019 season.
- ▶ The 2019 Gasparilla Bowl marked UCF's seventh bowl appearance in the last eight seasons and the Knights' 11th in the past 15 years.

**UCF SUCCESS IN ALL SPORTS**

- ▶ For the last three full seasons, every sport that plays a head-to-head schedule at UCF has finished with a winning record.
- ▶ The Knights were the only FBS athletics program in the nation to do so in both 2017-18 and 2018-19, and then did it again in 2019-20.
- ▶ CBS Sports ranked UCF as the 17th best athletics department in the nation in 2019.

**MCMNAMARA COVE (THE LAZY RIVER) IS A GO!**

- ▶ McNamara Cove—and "Covegating"—officially are coming to UCF. Covegating in McNamara Cove will generate new operating revenues for UCF Athletics while also delivering college football's most unique gameday tailgating experience for both individuals and corporate clients.
- ▶ UCF will offer a capacity of 250 all-inclusive "Covegating" membership packages for all regular-season home football games that includes food, beverage and parking among other amenities. The groundbreaking for McNamara Cove has already been held and expected opening is for 2021.

**#UCFAST OFFENSE NOTES**

**PRETTY DARN OFFENSIVE**

- ▶▶ UCF has been one of the best offensive teams in the country the last three seasons and has put up the points to prove it. In fact, the Knights scored 30 or more points in 31 straight games from Aug. 31, 2017 to Sept. 28, 2019, which is the longest streak in AP Poll era (since 1936).
- ▶▶ After failing to score 30 at Cincinnati last season, the Knights have scored 30 or more in each of the last seven games, making it 38 of the last 39 games.
- ▶▶ UCF has also scored 40 or more points in 24 of their last 39 games, have reached the 50-point plateau 12 times in the last 39 outings and have scored at least 24 points in 40 straight contests.

**KEEP IT ROLLING**

- ▶▶ UCF’s offensive production wasn’t just good in 2019, it was great. In fact, the Knights’ 540.5 yards of total offense per game set a program single-season record and ranked second in the nation, behind only LSU.
- ▶▶ In UCF’s first game of 2020, the Knights picked right up where they left off, putting up 49 points and 660 yards of total offense on Georgia Tech on the road.

**DANGER! EXPLOSIVES!**

- ▶▶ The Knights were dangerous on big plays in 2019, recording 112 total plays of 20 or more yards in 13 games and they are at it again in 2020, totaling 10 plays of 20 or more yards in the first game of the season.
- ▶▶ Marlon Williams was especially impressive as four of his career-high 10 catches were of 20 or more yards on Saturday.
- ▶▶ Williams is the third top returner in the category for UCF; Otis Anderson (18 explosive plays, 6 touchdowns), Tre Nixon (15 explosive plays, 6 touchdowns), and Williams (12 explosive plays, 5 touchdowns).

**DILLON DAZZLES**

- ▶▶ Quarterback Dillon Gabriel was one of the best freshmen in the nation in 2019, throwing for 3,653 yards, a UCF freshman record and the fourth most in school history.
- ▶▶ He looked even better in the first game of his sophomore season, earning the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week Award after throwing for a career-high 417 yards and four touchdowns.
- ▶▶ He has thrown at least one touchdown in every game of his career, with his streak of 14 consecutive games ranking as the fourth longest in program history.
- ▶▶ Gabriel was the first Knight to throw for 400 yards since McKenzie Milton in 2017 and just the fifth Knight in history to throw for 400 yards and four touchdowns (Milton, Culpepper, Schneider, Bortles).

**TIME IS A FLAT CIRCLE**

- ▶▶ The Knights ranked 123rd in the nation out of 130 teams ranked for time of possession in 2019, but in the 2020 opener, UCF led Georgia Tech in time of possession.
- ▶▶ UCF held the ball for 31 minutes and 52 seconds against the Yellow Jackets after averaging just 26 minutes and 28 seconds per game a year ago.
- ▶▶ The Knights get it done with quick scoring drives, completing 68 of their 85 offensive scoring drives last season in under three minutes (80 percent).
- ▶▶ In the 2020 opener, six of UCF’s seven scoring drives were under three minutes.

**WILLIAMS AND OTHER WEAPONS**

- ▶▶ Marlon Williams impressed in the first game of his senior season, catching a career-high 10 balls for a career-best 154 receiving yards with two touchdowns.
- ▶▶ The 10 catches were tied for the most in an FBS game this season and his yardage total was the third most so far this season.
- ▶▶ He earned Pro Football Focus National Team of the Week honors for his performance.
- ▶▶ Gabriel and this offense had plenty of weapons to work with in game one though, as Jaylon Robinson caught six passes for 105 yards in his UCF debut, Tre Nixon grabbed four passes for 94 yards and two touchdowns in the first half before going down with an injury, and three running backs found the end zone.





#UCFIERCE DEFENSE NOTES

**DOMINATING DEFENSE**

- ▶▶ For all of the accolades UCF’s offense deservedly receives, the defense continues to show out as well, and that continued in the first game of 2020.
- ▶▶ The Knights forced five turnovers and blocked a field goal in the win over Georgia Tech
- ▶▶ Freshman Josh Celiscar was impressive in his collegiate debut, forcing a fumble, recovering it, and snagging a pick against the Yellow Jackets. He earned 247 Sports National True Freshman of the Week honors for his performance.
- ▶▶ Stephon Zayas (INT), Richie Grant (FR), Dyllon Lester (FR), and Noah Hancock (BLK) also came up big on Saturday.

**TERRORIZING TFL NUMBERS**

- ▶▶ The UCF defense made it difficult on offenses in 2019 with their ability to get pressure in the backfield, leading the nation with 9.0 tackles for loss per game.
- ▶▶ It was definitely a team effort, as not a single UCF player had enough tackles for loss to be ranked nationally.
- ▶▶ Defensive tackle Kenny Turnier led the way with 13.5 tackles for loss, while linebacker Eric Mitchell brings back 11.0 TFLs and defensive end Tre’mon Morris-Brash returns with 9.0 tackles for loss from his freshman season.
- ▶▶ In the win over Georgia Tech, UCF totaled 6.0 tackles for loss, led by Eriq Gilyard’s 2.0.

**GETTING DOWN ON THIRD DOWN**

- ▶▶ The Knights’ defense also got it done when it needed to, leading the conference and ranking fifth in the nation by holding opponents to converting just 29.3 percent of the time on third down in 2019.
- ▶▶ UCF stopped Georgia Tech on eight of 15 third-down conversions this past Saturday.

**RIDING WITH RICHIE**

- ▶▶ Senior safety Richie Grant has been a leader on the defense for two years now and enters 2020 on the watch lists for the Bednarik, Nagurski and Thorpe awards.
- ▶▶ Grant has been named first-team all-conference in The American in two consecutive seasons and has picked off seven passes in the last two years.
- ▶▶ His partner at safety is fellow senior Antwan Collier, who was named first-team all-conference by Pro Football Focus in 2019 after leading the Knights with four interceptions to go with 3.5 tackles for loss, six pass break-ups and two fumble recoveries.
- ▶▶ Grant had nine tackles and recovered a fumble in Saturday’s victory.

SPECIAL NOTES

**KICKIN’ IT**

- ▶▶ Matthew Wright left UCF as the program’s all-time leader in field goals made, field-goal percentage, extra points made and consecutive extra points made following the 2018 season.
- ▶▶ Dylan Barnas was the next man up in 2019 and went 15-for-17 on field goal attempts, ranking 11th in the nation and marking the second-best percentage in program history.
- ▶▶ UCF now has a new kicker again in 2020 with sophomore Daniel Obarski taking over in game one. He was a perfect 7-for-7 on extra points against Georgia Tech and did not attempt a field goal.

**OTHER SPECIALTIES**

- ▶▶ Andrew Osteen returns for punting duties in 2020 after punting 57 times for 2,408 yards in his first season of competition in 2019.
- ▶▶ He averaged 42.2 yards per punt and recorded a 71-yard punt at Pittsburgh, which was the third longest in UCF history.
- ▶▶ Alex Ward also returns for his second season as the team’s long snapper.

**ANDERSON’S ACCOLADES**

- ▶▶ In addition to running back and wide receiver duties, Otis Anderson has also played the role of punt returner exceptionally well for the Knights.
- ▶▶ Anderson has been named preseason All-America after ranking sixth in the nation with 13.2 yards per return last season.

Heupel's two seasons at UCF both have produced perfect homefield records—and the Knights head into the 2020 season with 21 consecutive home victories (tying Clemson for the longest streak in the country in that category).

The Knights in 2018 put a league record 17 student-athletes on All-American Athletic Conference teams—then added a dozen in 2019. Milton in 2018 became the first player in conference history to repeat as the Offensive Player of the Year. Offensive lineman Jake Brown and safety Richie Grant earned first-team honors in both seasons. Additional first-team selections for UCF were wide receiver Gabriel Davis (2019), center Jordan Johnson (2018), offensive lineman Cole Schneider (2018), linebacker Nate Evans (2018) and cornerback Nevelle Clarke (2018). Milton finished sixth in 2018 Heisman Trophy voting.

UCF went 11-0 in the 2018 regular season, earning the American Athletic Conference East Division crown and a spot in the league title game. The Knights came back from a 17-point deficit to defeat Memphis 56-41 in the AAC Championship Game. The Knights earned a berth to the 2019 Fiesta Bowl, where they ultimately fell to LSU 40-32, snapping the team's 25-game win streak. Including three victories to open the 2019 campaign, the Knights extended their regular-season win streak to 28 games (including two AAC Championship Games).

Heupel was named the First Year Coach of the Year by the Football Writers Association of America and was a finalist for the AP National Coach of the Year Award, the Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award and the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award. He led UCF to as high as seventh in both the Associated Press top 25 and Amway poll of coaches, the highest regular-season rankings in program history. The Knights finished the year ranked 11th in the AP and 12th in the coaches' poll.

The Knights had 43 players selected to the 2018-19 AAC All-Academic Team. UCF also won a 2019 NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award as its four-year 984 APR figure for football ranked it among the top 10 percent of schools in that sport.

Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF football. UCF vice president and director of athletics Danny White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017. Heupel received an initial five-year contract and then signed a one-year extension in December 2018 to keep him as the Knights' head coach through the 2023 season.

Heupel came to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for two seasons in 2016 and 2017. In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou ranked eighth in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also 14th in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 TDs. He followed that with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record 44 TD tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of its starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Oklahoma, his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to Oklahoma as a full-time assistant.



He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.

Heupel was a national championship-winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for the Sooners. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 TDs. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and TD passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.

An Aberdeen, South Dakota, native, Heupel earned his bachelor's degree in business marketing from Oklahoma in 2001. He and his wife Dawn have two children--daughter Hannah and son Jace.
