

## imes team notes

- UCF is now 3-3 on the season.
- UCF is now 291-229-1 all-time and 195-142 at the FBS level.
- Gus Malzahn is now 98-50 all-time and 21-12 at UCF.
- UCF is now 0-1 against Kansas all-time following its first meeting.
- UCF is now 3-3 as a member of the Big 12 and 0-3 in conference play.

## imes offensive notes

- RJ Harvey's fourth-quarter four-yard rushing touchdown was his sixth rushing of the season and seventh overall and the 12th of his career.

- Harvey's 133 rushing yards mark a season high, besting his previous high of 95 yards set versus Baylor on Sept. 30. The performance was the second time Harvey has surpassed 100 yards on the ground in his career (151 at Memphis on 11/5/22).

- Harvey's 54-yard third-quarter rush was a season long, besting his 48-yard rush versus Kent State on Aug. 31 in the season opener.

- Alec Holler's third-quarter 13-yard touchdown reception was the sixth of his career. The score marked his second receiving touchdown of the season (first vs. Kent State on 8/31/23).

- Randy Pittman Jr.'s fourth-quarter 23-yard touchdown reception marked the first of the freshman's career.

## $\times \, \mathrm{DEFENSIVE}$ Notes

- Freshman John Walker made his first career start in the game at defensive tackle and linebacker Rian Davis earned his first start in a UCF uniform.

- Jireh Wilson's six tackles mark a new season and career high with the Knights. His previous best came in his UCF's debut versus Kent State on Aug. 31, where he secured four tackles.

- Jason Johnson surpassed 25 career tackles for loss in the contest.

- Josh Celiscar matched his career high in tackles (seven) and tackles for loss (two). His seven tackles mark the second game this season he's matched his high (first at Boise State on 9/9/23), while his two TFLs set a season-high.

- Colton Boomer converted on both of his PAT attempts, extending his streak to 59 consecutive PATs made.

- Demari Henderson recovered and returned a muffed PAT attempt in the third quarter for a two-point score.
