× TEAM NOTES

- UCF is now 3-4 on the season.
- UCF is now 291-230-1 all-time and 195-143 at the FBS level.
- Gus Malzahn is now 98-51 all-time and 21-13 at UCF.
- UCF is now 0-1 against Oklahoma all-time following its first meeting.
- UCF is now 3-4 as a member of the Big 12 and 0-4 in conference play.

× OFFENSIVE NOTES

- After going three-and-out on all four first quarter drives and totaling just 15 yards, UCF scored on each of its three second quarter drives, scoring a touchdown, field goal, and touchdown respectively, tallying 217 total yards on 24 plays.
- UCF's consecutive drives with a score continued into the third quarter, scoring on five consecutive drives, turning a 7-0 deficit into a 23-17 lead.
- UCF's 17 second quarter points are the most scored in any quarter against Oklahoma this season.
- John Rhys Plumlee's 86-yard play action touchdown pass to Javon Baker stands as the longest play of the season for UCF and is the longest play in the Big 12 this year, topping the previous best which was also held by UCF, a 79-yard touchdown run by Johnny Richardson against Baylor on Sept. 30.
- Plumlee's two passing touchdowns give him five on the season, 19 as a Knight and 24 in his career. His one rushing touchdown gives him two on the campaign, 13 as a Knight and 25 in his career. He now has 49 all-purpose touchdowns in his career.
- The 86-yard touchdown reception by Javon Baker was his third of the season, eighth in his two seasons as a Knight, and ninth of his career. It was the longest reception of his career.
- R.J. Harvey's 23 rushing attempts were a season and career high. His 101 rushing yards gives him three-straight 100+ yard rushing games, now boasting four 100+ yard rushing games in his career.
- Javon Baker's 134 receiving yards marked the second time this season he eclipsed the century mark and he was just four yards away from tying his career-high 138 yard clip hauled in against SMU on Oct. 5, 22. With the performance against Oklahoma, he now totals four 100+ yard receiving games. Baker is now 37 yards away from collecting 1,500 career receiving yards. The contest against Oklahoma was the first multi-TD reception game of his career as he now has four receiving touchdowns this year, nine as a Knight and 10 in his career.

× DEFENSIVE NOTES

- UCF held Oklahoma to 17 points in the first half, the third time this season the Sooners have scored 17 or less at the break. It's the fifth time this season that the Knights have held a team to 17 or fewer points in the first half.
- The Knights didn't allow Oklahoma to score in the third quarter, which is just the second time this season that the Sooners have gone scoreless in a quarter this season.
- Quadric Bullard's third quarter interception was the first of his career and was returned for 27 yards.
- Walter Yates III's 10 tackles against Oklahoma led the team, a season-high for him.
- Lee Hunter's 2.5 tackles for loss led the team and was a season and career high.

× SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- UCF forced two missed field goals in the first quarter, the first from 38 yards with 9:40 left and the other from 43 yards with 0:53 to go. The last time UCF forced two missed field goals in a game was at Memphis on Nov. 5, 2022, in a 35-28 win.
- UCF has forced at least one field goal miss in four straight games and five total this season.
- Kicker Colton Boomer converted on both of his PAT attempts, extending his streak to 68 for consecutive PATs made. He made three field goals on the day, converting from 21, 48 and 46 yards. He was one field goal away from tying his season-high four made at Boise State (9/9/23).
- It marked the third time in Boomer's career that he has made at least three field goals in a game, achieved earlier this season at Boise State (four) and Georgia Tech last season (four).
