I KNIGHT NOTES

NO. 2 IN THE NATION

- After beginning the 2023 fall season unranked in the United Soccer Coaches' national top 25 poll, the UCF men's soccer team has risen to earn the No. 2 ranking in the country in the week 6, 7 and 8 releases of the poll following the team's 7-1-2 record through its 10 matches. The Knights' 7-1-2 record marks the best start to a season by the program through 10 matches since 2019, when UCF began the year with an identical 7-1-2 mark, including a 2-1 win on the road at the then-No. 6 North Carolina Tar Heels Sept. 1 and a 3-3 double-overtime draw with then-No. 4 SMU Oct. 6. The 2019 Knights would advance as far as the third round of the NCAA Tournament but would fall in overtime by a 2-1 final score against
- then-No. 5 SMU Nov. 30, concluding the season with a 15-3-2 final record.

 The No. 2 ranking surpasses the Knights' No. 3 mark achieved during the previous two weeks as the highest team national ranking in UCF athletics history. The UCF track & field team also achieved a No. 3 national ranking on March 27, 2023 when the squad was ranked No. 3 in the first NCAA Division I Women's Track and Field National Rating Index of the spring season.
- UCF's latest ranking also marks the highest in program history, surpassing its previous No. 3 mark achieved in the week 4 and 5 polls, and the No. 5 ranking achieved in the week 3 poll as well as on Nov. 12, 2019 when the Knights were slotted in as the No. 5 team in the nation in the midst of what would become a 16-match unbeaten streak from Sept. 1–Nov. 13 that season (14-0-2 during the streak, 15-3-2 final 2019 record).
- The Knights were also included in the week 8 editions of Top Drawer Soccer and College Soccer News' polls, at No. 2 and 4, respectively. • UCF's latest national ranking represents the latest in a meteoric rise through the polls for the team throughout the fall 2023 slate, as after the squad began the season unranked, the Knights earned the No. 14 spot in the poll's week one rankings, followed by No. 6 in week two, and then a share of No. 5 with Louisville in week three prior to UCF's most recent No. 3 ranking in weeks four and five.

- The Knights also remained within the top three in the nation in the official NCAA RPI rankings for the fourth consecutive week at No. 2 Oct. 16, after debuting at No. 2 in the country in the first and second rankings Sept. 25 and Oct. 2 and pulling in at No. 3 in last week's rankings (Oct. 9).
- Entering UCF's Wednesday matchup, the Knights had completed all four of their quadrant 1 contests, going 1-1-2 against then-No. 4/9 Clemson (Top Drawer/United Soccer Coaches), then-No. 4 West Virginia (United Soccer Coaches), No. 1 Marshall and then-No. II Florida International. Through the team's first 10 matches, their opponent strength of schedule ranks 57th in the nation. UCF has also earned at least one point in six of its seven matches against RPI top 100 teams, going 4-1-2 against the aforementioned Tigers (No. 10), Mountaineers (No. 9), Herd (No. 1), Panthers (No. 7), NC State Wolfpack (No. 96), Old Dominion Monarchs (No. 92) and Kentucky Wildcats (No. 100).
- The No. 2 RPI ranking also represents the highest such mark in program history.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

• The Knights most recently scored a single match season-high 5 goals in their last contest, a 5-0 home victory over the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers Wednesday, Oct. 18. After veteran forward Lucca Dourado scored each of the Knights' previous four goals in the team's last two games entering the midweek matchup, five different Knights found the back of the net, including two for the first time this season: Clarence Awoudor, Raphael Crivello, Emmanuel Bam, Saku Heiskanen and Yanis Belatrache.

- The contest marked the first five-goal match for the Knights since Nov. 10, 2021, when the Knights toppled then-No. 3 Memphis by a 6-0 score in the American Athletic Conference Tournament in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
- UCF netted four goals in a single half for the first time since the aforementioned victory over Memphis, when the team did the same in the first half, and the Knights on Wednesday potted four in the second half of a match for the first time since the team's 4-2 win at Stetson Sept. 15, 2018.
- The Knights saw five different players score at least one goal in a single match for the first time since their 2021 Memphis win, as well.

RAPHA AND YANIS ARE ON THE BOARD

• Fifth-year defender **Raphael Crivello** and freshman midfielder **Yanis Belatrache** both scored the first goals of their respective seasons against Coastal Carolina, with Yanis' representing the first of his collegiate career. Crivello found the back of the net for the first time in his two-year

career as a Knight, and the first time since the last of his two seasons with Pittsburgh in 2021, specifically Nov. 27, 2021 when he recorded his first career 2-goal match in his team's 4-0 win over Hofstra.

• The pair boosted the Knights' unique goal-scorer total to 10 through 11 matches, led by Lucca Dourado's 8 goals. Offensively, the Knights boast the third-best goal differential in the Sun Belt with a mark of +14, which ranks 20th-best in the nation, and their 2.09 goals per game rnak third in the conference and 23rd nationally.

LOCK DOWN DEFENSE

- The Knights' 5-0 win over Coastal Carolina Wednesday night represented the ninth time in the team's first 11 matches this season that saw the squad yield one or fewer goals, a contest that lowered the Knights' team goals-against average to .818, the second-best mark in the Sun Belt and 23rd in the nation.
- The shutout authored by the combination of Juanvi Muñoz and redshirt freshman Luciano Natoli marked the Knights' fourth of the season and third in their last four matches, and clinched the first season with at least four clean sheets for UCF since the spring 2021 slate (moved up from the fall due to the COVID-19 pandemic), when the Knights earned six shutout victories en route to advancing as far as the second round of the NCAA
- Prior to their rout of the Chanticleers Wednesday, the Knights also ran their scoreless goals-against streak to a season-long 314 minutes and 45 seconds between their 1-0 loss at No. 1 Marshall Sept. 23 and their 2-1 win at Old Dominion Oct. 14. Thanks to Muñoz, the Knights enter their Sunday evening matchup among conference leaders in save percentage (.795, 1st SBC, 18th NCAA), team goals-against average (.769, 2nd SBC, 23rd NCAA) and shutout percentage (.364, 3rd SBC, 50th NCAA).
- · Against the Monarchs, Muñoz also racked up seven total saves en route to clinching his 13th collegiate win. The effort represented his second contest with seven or more saves this season and the third such match of his UCF tenure.
- The Knights' 2-0 victory over the Georgia Southern Eagles Oct. 7 represented the second straight shutout win by the team following its 1-0 victory on the road at the Kentucky Wildcats Sept. 29. With the win over the Eagles, UCF clinched back-to-back shutout wins for the first time since the Knights earned three straight clean sheets against then-No. 9 SMU (2-0, March 13, 2021), Temple (4-0, March 20, 2021) and South Florida (1-0 (20T), March 27, 2021).
- Against the Eagles Oct. 7, the Knights also allowed four or fewer shot attempts with none on target for the first time since the Knights' 2-0 victory over Virginia Commonwealth Sept. 13, 2019, when the Black and Gold yielded only two total shot attempts to the Rams throughout the

DOURADO ON A HOT STREAK

- After he scored both the Knights' goals in the team's 2-0 victory over Georgia Southern Oct. 7, Senior forward Lucca Dourado continued his hot streak during UCF's 2-1 victory at Old Dominion Oct. 14, again scoring both Knights goals and recording his second consecutive multi-goal game.
- His latest standout offensive performance also represented the eighth multi-goal game of his career, and Lucca has now tallied three gamewinning goals this season and 12 in his Knights tenure. Dourado also produced back-to-back multi-goal games for the third time in his career, joining Sept. 11-18, 2021, vs. FGCU, at Memphis, and Sept. 9-17, 2022, at UC Irvine, at Temple.
- With his second straight four-point night, Dourado's then-career point total of 75 also rocketed the forward past Mark Lamb (1984-87) for sole possession of eighth place on the UCF all-time points list, and he now sits just three goals shy of tying **Rony Francois** (39, 1980-83) for fifth place on the all-time goals scored list with 36 in his career. After tallying his fourth career assist during the Knights' 5-0 win over Coastal Carolina, Dourado also needs just one more point to tie Nik Robson (77, 2009-11) for seventh place on the UCF all-time points list.
- With two years remaining of eligibility, forward Lucca Dourado had already clinched a share of 10th place on UCF's all-time points list (61) with his penalty kick goal during the Knights' 2-1 win over Stetson Aug. 27. With his second goal of the season against No. 11 FIU Sept. 9, Dourado became the seventh Knight in program history to eclipse the 30-goal mark, joining Heikki Ritvanen (88), Randy DeShield (56), Ari Nurmi (47), Cal Jennings (46), Rony Francois (39) and Matias Pyysalo (32).
- Dourado scored in seven consecutive matches during the 2022 season, which was the second longest in the nation behind LIU's Emil **Jaaskelainen**, who had his streak end at eight in a row.
- Jennings (2016-19) was the last Knight to hit the 30-goal mark and finished his career fourth all-time at UCF with 46. Pyysalo and Jennings are the only two Knights to hit the 30 goal mark under **Scott Calabrese**. Both went on to play professional soccer.
- Dourado finished the 2022 season fifth among active NCAA players in goals per game with a mark of 0.65 goals per game and was tied for 31st in total points with 59.

OWNING OCTOBER

• October is a month that has historically been kind to the UCF men's soccer team, as the squad has compiled a 23-7-3 all-time record in the month of October since head coach Scott Calabrese took the reins prior to the 2017 campaign, with all seven losses coming in the last two seasons. Prior to the fall 2021 slate, the Knights were unbeaten in the month of October under Calabrese, recording a 15-0-3 record in that span, and the team remains perfect in three matches in October 2023.

ROBBIE JOINS ZANE & JUANVI AS SBC DPOTW

- As announced by the Sun Belt Conference Oct. 10, midfielder Robbie Soronellas was tabbed as the conference's week seven Defensive Player of the Week for his contributions during the Knights' 2-0 win over the Georgia Southern Eagles Oct. 7. He became the third Knight to garner a weekly award by the Sun Belt this fall and the second in as many weeks, joining defender Zane Bubb (Sept. 5) and goalkeeper Juanvi Muñoz (Oct. 3). All three took home the conference's defensive honors.
- The award also represents the first conference weekly recognition won by Soronellas in his career, and the second overall conference recognition he has earned, joining his unanimous selection to the ASUN All-Freshman team following his freshman campaign at North Florida in 2019.
- Soronellas contributed on both ends of the field in helping lead the Knights to their second straight clean sheet Oct. 7, recording the primary assist on forward **Lucca Dourado**'s first goal of the evening.
- He also helped limit the Eagles to only four total shot attempts throughout the match, none of which found Muñoz's net. Soronellas completed 90 of 98 total passes on the night, including 16 defensive recoveries, seven of which occurred on Georgia Southern's defensive end.

- UCF netminder Juanvi Muñoz made a pair of saves in the Knights' 2-0 victory over Brown Sept. 9, clinching his first clean sheet of the season and the third of his two-year collegiate career. The sophomore also notched shutout wins against UC Riverside and Temple last year.
- The clean sheet came on the heels of a career performance for the Valencia, Spain, native Sept. 5 against then-No. 11 FIU Sept. 5, when he made a single-match career-high 9 saves on 11 total shots on goal and 16 total shots faced in the Knights' 2-2 draw. The evening surpassed his previous career high of 7 saves in the Knights' 2-1 win over North Florida Aug. 29, 2022.
- Not only did his 9 saves mark a Sun Belt single-match season high, but the total also represented the most in a single match by a Knights goalie since Yannik Oettl's 9 saves in the Knights' triple overtime 1-1 tie (UCF 4-3 win on penalty kicks) April 15, 2021 during the American Athletic Conference Championship Semifinals (season moved from the fall of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic).

DEFENDING THE KINGDOM

• Since head coach Scott Calabrese took over at the beginning of the 2017 season, the Knights have posted a record of 38-12-8 at home. • UCF has lost just 10 regular-season home matches during Calabrese's tenure. Prior to the 2020-21 season, UCF only had one regular season home loss through the first three campaigns.

DECLAWING THE CATS

The Knights made a statement in their season-opener, downing the then-No. 4/9 Clemson Tigers (Top Drawer Soccer/United Soccer Coaches) by a 2-1 final score at Historic Riggs Field Aug. 24. The contest marked the Knights' first win against a ranked opponent since downing then-No. 13 Charlotte, also by a 2-1 decision, Oct. 21, 2022, and their first against a nationally-ranked top-10 foe since UCF topped then-No. 6 Tulsa Oct. 10, 2021.

UCF DIVISION I CONFERENCE AFFILIATION HISTORY



Atlantic Sun Conference 1993-2004 (12 seasons)

After making the D-I jump in 1984, the Black and Gold didn't join their first Division I conference until 1993. Despite going 4-10-1 in their first year in a conference, the Knights made the A-Sun Semifinals in just their second year as part of the A-Sun. The Knights found success guickly and carried that momentum with them throughout their time in the A-Sun, tallying eight appearances in the conference tournament in 12

The Knights finished their time in the A-Sun on a high note, winning the tournament championship in three consecutive seasons from 2002-04. The championship runs led to UCF's first three NCAA Tournament appearances. The Black and Gold were turned away from their first NCAA Touranment victory in their first two tries by FIU, but were able to beat the Panthers in 2004 for the program's first tournament win.

Three Knights earned four major honors during the program's tenure in the A-Sun. Heikki Ritvanen scored 88 career goals from 1996-99. UCF's most in program history, and was honored as the A-Sun's Player of the Year in 1999. Aleiandro Gessen was named Freshman of the Year while Rvan McIntosh was a two-time Defensive Player of the Year. In all. 54 nods were recieved to the A-Sun First, Second, Third and Freshmen Teams in UCF's 12 years in the league.



Conference USA 2005-2012 (8 seasons)

UCF had a new conference and a new head coach for the 2005 season. Brent Erwin and the Knights went 13-17-3 over their first two seasons as members of Conference USA. Fast forward to UCF's sixth season in the league, fourth year head coach Bryan Cunningham led UCF to its first NCAA Tournament apperance as members of C-USA, winning 12 matches with a 12-5-3 record. The team followed suit the next year, winning a dozen games again and making the NCAA Tournament second round for the second straight year.

The Knights won 32 matches in their final three seasons as part of C-USA, more than first five seasons in the league combined. The Black and Gold won no major honors as C-USA members, but saw nine nods to the All-Conference First Team and a total of 30 nods across the First. Second. Third and Freshman Teams.



American Athletic Conference 2013-2022 (10 seasons)

The Knights enjoyed massive success as part of The American, reaching the conference final in five of their final six seasons in the league. The Black and Gold earned three regular seasons titles and one tournamennt championship as members of The American, In total, UCF qualified for the conference's postseason tournament in nine straight seasons, only missing the 2022 postseason by two points.

Three of UCF's NCAA Tournament appearances came while in The American, qualifying in 2018, 2019 and 2020. The Knights punched their first ticket into the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 in 2019, and then did the same for the 2020 tournament, which was held in the spring of 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Plenty of Knights stood out in UCF's time in The American. A member of the Black and Gold was named Offesnive Player of the Year six times out of the team's 10 years in the league. Matias Pyysalo and Cal Jennings won the honor twice while Romario Williams and Hadji Barry were honored once each. UCF collected three Midfielder of the Year honors and three Goalkeeper of the Year awards; Oettl collected all three goalkeeping honors while Yoni Sorokin took two of the three midfielder awards along with Louis Perez who won the other. Gino Vivi was honored as UCF's lone Freshman of the Year award, earning the nod in 2019.

The Black and Gold had 11 First Team All-Conference honorees, including nine that were named on the top squad multiple times. In total, UCF earned 36 nods to the All-Conference First or Second Teams while 16 rookies graced the All-Freshman Team while in The American



Sun Belt Conference 2023-present

UCF men's soccer's move to the Sun Belt Conference was made in tandem with the rest of UCF's sports moving to the Big 12 Conference in 2023-24, a league which does not sponsor men's soccer. The Sun Belt recently re-emerged as a conference, resuming play in 2022 after previously sponsoring men's soccer from 1976-1995 and 2014-20. The Knights will join Kentucky, South Carolina and West Virginia as men's soccer members only. Those four teams will join James Madison, Marshall, Old Dominion, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern and Georgia State.

"I'm very excited to be partnering with Commissioner Keith Gil and Deputy Commissioner Kathy Keene. They are great people and I'm excited to work with them again." said UCF Vice President and athletics director Terry Mohajir. "We believe the move to the Sun Belt positions our men's soccer program for great success in the coming years. Coach Calabrese has shown his teams can compete with the best of the best in The American, and we can't wait to see the program continue to grow and compete in the very strong Sun Belt Conference."

"We are very excited to accept the invitation to join what will clearly be an incredible conference for men's soccer," said head coach Scott Calabrese, "I love that the Sun Belt will be the home of both the Big 12 and the SEC for men's soccer along with 2020 National Champions Marshall and so many top soccer programs as well. It's an exciting new challenge for our program and we can't wait to be a part of it in 2023."

- Going with Top Drawer Soccer's rankings, UCF also earned its first victory against an opponent nationally-ranked in the top five since Oct. 2, 2010, when the Knights edged then-No. 5 SMU by a 2-1 margin.
 The victory also marked the first win in program history against the Tigers in the third all-time meeting between the two schools. UCF and Clemson hadn't met since Sept. 6, 1995, a 3-0 defeat. The Tigers topped the Knights in the first meeting as well, by a 9-2 decision Sept. 11, 1977.
- The victory also assured the Knights at least one ranked win for the fifth consecutive season, after UCF toppled No. 13 Charlotte 2-1 Oct. 21, 2022, No. 6 Tulsa 3-2 Oct. 10, 2021, No. 17 James Madison May 2, 2021 (season moved from 2020 to spring as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic). No. 12 Missouri State 2-1 in overtime November 24, 2019, and No. 6 North Carolina 2-1 Sept. 1, 2019.

TWO FIRSTS IN THE OPENER

- The Knights' historic 2-1 victory over No. 4/9 Clemson Thursday evening came on the strength of the first goals in the respective careers of both sophomore forward **Emmanuel Bam** and freshman midfielder **Saku Heiskanen**. The occasion marked the first contest that saw two Knights score their first career goals since the fall 2021 season, when fifth-year midfielder **Rainer De Jesus** and senior defender **Yanis Leerman** both notched their first career scores in the American Athletic Conference Tournament Semifinals against
- Tulsa Nov. 10, a match UCF won 6-0.

 Sophomore forward/midfielder **Lucas Mauro** and redshirt-sophomore midfielder **Josiah Ramirez** both recorded their first career goals in the same match earlier that season as well, during the Knights' 5-0 victory over North Florida Aug. 29.
- Barn's goal also made the sophomore the first Knight since sophomore forward **Kevin Andrews** to have his first career goal also represent a game-winner, as Andrews' tally in the 45th minute proved the difference in the Knights' 3-1 victory over Florida International Oct. 9, 2022.
- Heiskanen also became the first Knight since the 2019 campaign to score a goal in the first match of his collegiate career, when redshirt-freshman midfielder Gianluca Arcangeli scored UCF's lone goal in a 2-1 defeat at No. 4 Wake Forest in his collegiate debut Aug. 30.

- UCF men's soccer makes the jump to the Sun Belt Conference for the 2023 season, as the athletics department transitions from the American Athletic Conference to the Big 12 Conference, a conference that doesn't sponsor men's soccer
- The Sun Belt is the fourth conference the UCF men's soccer program has been a part of in their Division I history, playing in the Atlantic Sun from 1993-2004, Conference USA from 2005-2012 and The American from 2013 through the 2022 season (more in depth info on page 3).
- The Sun Belt recently re-emerged as a conference, resuming play in 2022 after previously sponsoring men's soccer from 1976-1995 and 2014-20. The Knights will join Kentucky, South Carolina and West Virginia as men's soccer members only. Those four teams will James Madison, Marshall, Old Dominion, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern and Georgia State.
- The members of the revamped Sun Belt have enjoyed great success lately. Marshall won the national championship during the 2020 season, played in the spring of 2021. Kentucky was the top overall seed in the 2022 NCAA Tournament and reached the Sweet 16 along with conference-mate Marshall. Coastal Carolina is one of the winningest programs in the NCAA and has made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances since 2010.
 Overall, six of UCFs nine new conference mates finished in the top 60 of the 2022 NCAA RPI with three finishing in the top 50.

- KNIGHTS PICKED TO FINISH FOURTH IN FIRST SUN BELT SEASON, DOURADO AND ROSA NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

 UCF was voted to finish fourth in this year's Sun Belt preseason poll with 68 points and one first place vote.

 Kentucky led the way with 93 points and six first place votes, followed closely by Marshall with 91 points and two first place votes. West Virginia sits third with 77 points and a first place vote. Behind UCF were South Carolina (49 points), Georgia State and Coastal
- Carolina (45), James Madison (40), Old Dominion (26) and Georgia Southern (16).

 Lucca Dourado and Anderson Rosa were named to the Sun Belt Preseason All-Conference Team ahead of the squad's inaugural run in their new league. Dourado earned two All-Conference First Team nods (2021, 2022) and an All-Rookie Team honor (2020-21) in the team's time in the American Athletic Conference. Rosa earned All-Conference First Team and All-Rookie Team honors in his first season of collegiate soccer (2020-21) before being named to the Second Team in 2021 ahead of his return to the First Team in 2022. • UCF has two members on the Preseason All-Conference Team, tied for second with Marshall and Georgia State, and behind Kentucky who has four.

- Scott Calabrese and staff's roster for the 2023 season has at least one student-athlete from each of the six habitable continents with 13 different countries represented.
 Eleven Knights hail from North America, with nine from three different states in the United States and two from Asia and one is
- from Australia.
 The UCF roster is traditionally diverse, but the 2023 season will be the first time that there is at least one player from each habitable continent in Calabrese's seven year tenure.
