UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES

JAYLIN'S HOT START

- Junior guard Jaylin Sellers is making quite an impression on Knight Nation to begin the season, scoring 23 points in the opener and then earning a 22-point, 11-rebound double-double at Miami.
- Sellers' 23-points on opening were just one shy of tying his career high, and he now boasts eight career 20+ point games.
- UCF has now had a player score 23 points in back-to-back season-openers, as Taylor Hendricks posted 23 through two overtimes on 11/7/22 against UNC-Asheville. Hendricks also tallied a double-double in his second career game, just as Sellers did in his second game as a Knight. Hendricks scored 16 points and pulled in 12 rebounds against FSU on 11/11/22.
- Last year, three Knights accomplished consecutive 20 point games. CJ Kelly scored three consecutive 20+ point games (21 vs. SMU, 28 vs. Memphis and 21 at Florida) in the postseason, while Ithiel Horton had back-to-back 21 (vs. SMU, 1/8/23) and 30 (vs. Memphis 1/11/23) point games and Taylor Hendricks had 21 (at Cincinnati, 2/7/23) and 23 (at Wichita State, 2/8/23).

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE TO BEGIN 2023-24

- UCF has forced 21 turnovers per game through its first two contests, a mark that is ranked eighth best in the nation. The Knights also rank in the top 50 in steals, checking in at 23 with 11.5 steals per game.
- The Black and Gold's defense impressed on opening night, generating 24 turnovers and 16 steals. The turnovers were the most since forcing 24 turnovers at Memphis on 2/16/23. The 16 steals marked the first time the Knights recorded 16 steals since a bout at Cincinnati on 2/19/20. The Knights added 18 forced turnovers and 11 steals at Miami on 11/10/23.
- UCF's defense held the Panthers to just four points during the final four minutes of the first half and the first four minutes of the second half in the opening night victory.

DJ, PLAY PASS IT AGAIN

- Junior guard Darius Johnson tallied his 200th career assist, passing the ball to Nils Machowski for a three-pointer at Miami to cut the deficit to nine at the time. Johnson recorded 106 of those 200 assists last season in 25 games played on the year.
- Johnson is 68 assists away from a tie of 10th place on UCF's career assists leaderboard, a spot currently held by Daiquan Walker (2012-16). The all-time assists leader at UCF is Sinua Phillips (1990-94) who tallied 531.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK MAKE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- 10 of the 13 Knights who saw minutes against FIU were making their debut for UCF. The newcomers combined for 61 points, 12 assists, and 31 rebounds. Of the 10 who made their Knight debut, eight were not on the roster last season while the other two redshirted with the Black and Gold last season.

BEATING FLORIDA FOES

- UCF has found success against in-state opponents under head coach Johnny Dawkins, going 23-9 since his arrival against teams from Florida. The Knights finished 3-3 against Florida foes last season with wins over Florida, Florida State and Stetson. UCF is 1-1 against Sunshine State opponents this year, beating FIU in the season opener and falling to Miami.
- In the first meeting since 2012, UCF triumphed 67-49 over Florida in Gainesville during the 2023 National Invitation Tournament, which was the first victory on the road against the Gators in program history.
- The Knights open the season with back-to-back in-state opponents, hosting FIU and traveling to No. 13 Miami. In total, UCF will face six teams from the state of Florida this season.
- The Black and Gold have already beat Florida, Florida State, Miami, Stetson, South Florida, Jacksonville and Bethune-Cookman under Johnny Dawkins' remarkable run through the state. FIU was added to that list this season.

UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES (CONT.)

- For the first time in program history, the Knights won't leave the state of Florida during their non-conference schedule.
- UCF will leave home just twice in the 2023-24 non-conference slate, visiting No. 13 Miami on Nov. 10 and taking part in the Jacksonville Classic in St. Augustine, Florida, where they'll face South Dakota State and either Charlotte or George Mason.
- The Knights have a total of nine home contests in the non-conference schedule, hosting five teams from in-state.

PROTECTING HOME COURT

- UCF has made a habit of protecting Addition Financial Arena under head coach Johnny Dawkins, going 83-27 at home.
- Dawkins has won seven of eight season-opening contests, stringing together six consecutive to begin his Knights career. UCF is now 7-1 in home openers under Dawkins after the FIU win this year.
- The Knights are 12-2 in home-openers played inside Addition Financial Arena and 25-12 in home-openers in the DI era.
- The 23-point victory over FIU was the second-highest margin of victory, just one point shy of the Knights' 80-56 win over Nicholls in 2016.

NEW KNIGHTS

- UCF has a total of 10 newcomers on this year's roster. Of the newcomers, four are fifth-year players, two are seniors, one is a junior and three are freshmen. UCF's newcomers for the 2023-24 season that played collegiately during 2022-23 combined for 56.5 points per game.
- Shemarri Allen, a transfer from UMKC, was named to the All-Summit League Second Team and All-Defensive Team last season, all while scoring 17 points per game. Jaylin Sellers was named All-MAC Third Team at Ball State last year, scoring 13.5 points per game and shooting 45% from three-point land.
- Freshmen Mintautas Mockus and Nils Machowski come to UCF after playing basketball in Lithuania and Germany, respectively, while rookie Comeh Emuobor was a consensus top 200 recruit entering the college scene.
- Other transfers rostered are Omar Payne (transferred in from Jacksonville), Ibrahima Diallo (San Jose State), DeMarr Langford Jr. (Boston College), Marchelus Avery (New Mexico State) and Antwann Jones, who was inactive last season.

KNIGHTS WORLDWIDE

- UCF is one of seven teams in NCAA Division I that have six or more countries represented on the 2023-24 roster.
- Outside of the 12 players on the roster from the United States, the Knights have a player each from Lithuania, Senegal, Thailand, Germany and Guinea. Overall, four continents are represented on this year's squad (North America, 12; Africa, 2; Europe, 2; Asia, 1)
- Arizona, Hawaii and Portland lead the nation with the most diverse rosters, having eight countries represented. UCLA and Sacramento State have seven while Campbell and UCF each have six.
- Of the seven teams with six or more countries represented, the country most represented on a single team outside the United States was Australia, which had four players represented on Sacramento State.

A SUMMER TO REMEMBER

- There were many memorable moments for UCF over the summer. The program had its first lottery pick at the NBA Draft, officially moved to the Big 12 Conference, took a 10-day trip to Italy and saw head coach Johnny Dawkins enshrined in the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame.
- **June 22** - Taylor Hendricks became UCF's first lottery pick and first rounder, going ninth overall to the Utah Jazz in the 2023 NBA Draft. He became the Knights' fifth former student-athlete to play in the NBA when he participated in Utah's seasons opener against Sacramento. Hendricks was also UCF's first one-and-done.
- **July 1** - UCF officially became a part of the Big 12 after spending 10 seasons in the American Athletic Conference. Before that, the Knights were a part of Conference USA (2005-13), Atlantic Sun (1993-05), Sun Belt (1991-92) and American South (1990-91) in their Division I era. UCF won all four of its conference titles in the Atlantic Sun. A full breakdown of UCF's conference affiliation can be found on page three.
- **Aug. 6-16** - UCF took a tour of Italy, playing four games over the course of the 10-day trip and winning all four, giving a squad with 10 newcomers and 17 total student-athletes time to gel on and off the court.
- **Aug. 30** - UCF head coach Johnny Dawkins is enshrined in the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame for his days as a player at Duke. He was inducted alongside his legendary coach, Mike Krzyzewski. Dawkins played for the Blue Devils from 1982-83 through 1985-86, earning consensus All-America honors twice and was named the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and was named All-American as a freshman in 1983. Dawkins later went on to coach with "Coach K" for 10 seasons, winning a national championship in the process.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

- UCF teams under Dawkins have been outstanding defensively, finishing ranked in the top 50 nationally in scoring defense in four of his seven seasons, including two top 10 finishes.
- Last season, UCF was ranked top 50 in multiple defensive categories, ranking 29th in opponent three-point percentage (30.7%), 38th in turnovers forced per game (14.82) and 47th in scoring defense (65.5).
- The Knights held opponents to 60 points or less in five straight contests at one point during the 2022-23 season. It was a historic streak, marking the first time in Dawkins' 15-year coaching career that any of his teams had accomplished the feat. Prior to the Black and Gold's historic streak, the last time UCF had accomplished the feat of holding teams to under 60 points in five straight games was during 2003-04, which was part of a 14-game winning streak that helped fuel an NCAA Tournament run.

RANKED MATCHUPS ARE COMING

- UCF had 20% of the AP Poll's Preseason Top 25 on the schedule in 2023-24 as the Knights will match up with five preseason ranked teams and an additional two who are receiving votes.
- UCF's opposition begin the year in the AP poll as follows: No. 1 Kansas, No. 7 Houston, No. 13 Miami, No. 18 Texas and No. 20 Baylor. TCU and Kansas State begin the year receiving votes. Additionally, Iowa State is receiving votes in the Coaches Poll.
- Of the ranked opponents, UCF will have to face Houston twice, while all other matchups will occur just once.
- As it stands prior to opening night, UCF is set to play six games against ranked opponents, which would be the most since the 2017-18 season when the Knights played against a ranked foe in seven games. The following year, 2018-19, saw UCF make its first NCAA Tournament under Johnny Dawkins while playing a total of five nationally ranked opponents.
- UCF is in search of its first ranked win since 12/19/20 when the Knights visited No. 15 Florida State and came away with a 86-74 victory. The Black and Gold have been edged in seven straight meetings with ranked foes.

BRACKETOLOGY

- The Knights will face nine teams that made the 2022-23 NCAA Tournament with seven of the nine winning at least one tournament game. They are Miami (Final Four), Kansas State (Elite Eight), Texas (Elite Eight), Houston (Sweet 16), Kansas (Second Round), Baylor (Second Round), TCU (Second Round), West Virginia (First Round) and Iowa State (First Round).
- According to ESPN's Joe Lunardi's offseason 2024 NCAA Tournament Bracketology (published on Oct. 10), 10 teams on UCF's schedule are projected to make The Big Dance. They are Kansas (top overall seed), Houston (2-seed), Texas (3-seed), Baylor (5-seed), TCU (7-seed), Miami (8-seed), Iowa State (9-seed), West Virginia (9-seed), Kansas State (11-seed, last four bye), Texas Tech (11-seed, last team in) and South Dakota State (16-seed).

UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES (CONT.)

LEAGUED HIM!

• Taylor Hendricks became UCF's first lottery pick and first round selection, getting drafted by the Utah Jazz with the ninth pick in the 2023 NBA Draft.

• Hendricks became the third Knight selected in the NBA Draft and second in the modern era, joining Jermaine Taylor (2009, Round 2, Pick 32) and Bennie Shaw (1976, Round 9, Pick 146). Hendricks became the fifth Knight to ever play in the NBA, joining Taylor (Houston, Sacramento), Tacko Fall (Boston, Cleveland), Mark Jones (Orlando) and Matt Williams (Miami).

• The Big 12 Conference has 57 players on NBA rosters as of the beginning of the 2023-24 season. UCF is one of 12 teams in the conference to have at least one player represented on an NBA roster. Hendricks is joined on the Jazz by four other alumni from Big 12 institutions; Keyonte George (Baylor), Talen Horton-Tucker (Iowa State), Ochai Agbaji (Kansas) and Udoka Azubuike (Kansas).

• While at UCF, Hendricks shattered the American Athletic Conference record for most rookie of the week honors won, tallying nine with the previous record being six. He was unanimously named to the league's all-freshman team and received a nod to the all-conference second team.

• Hendricks led the team in scoring, averaging 15.1 points per game (515 total points) and also in rebounding, averaging 7.0 boards per contest (237 total rebounds, 80 offensive). He started all 34 of UCF's games, one of two Knights to do so on the 2022-23 roster and played 1,179 minutes, the second most in a single season in program history.

• Hendricks was the only in the country to finish the season with 60+ three pointers, 55+ blocks and 35+ dunks.

• When all was said and done, Hendricks had shattered UCF rookie records. He finished with the most single-season points (515), scoring average (15.1), rebounds (237), offensive rebounds (80), rebound average (7.0) field goal makes and attempts (184-for-385), free throw makes and attempts (86-for-110) and minutes (1,179), all tops of UCF's freshman leaderboards. He was second in blocks (59), fourth in steals (31) and three-point field-goals (61). He also finished 10th on UCF's all-time three-point percentage list.

DAWKINS ERA AT UCF

• Johnny Dawkins picked up career win No. 100 in the Knights' win over N.C. A&T on Dec. 11, 2022, becoming just the third coach in UCF history to reach the milestone. Dawkins is 132-88 since starting with the Knights in 2016, a win percentage of .600, the second best of any UCF coach (Torchy Clark, .754 from 1969-83).

• He has the third-most wins of any UCF coach, trailing only Clark's 274 and Kirk Speraw's 247 from 1993-2010.

• Dawkins is the fastest coach to earn 100 wins in program history in the Division I era, needing only 162 games to do so.

• Dawkins had his squad off to a 4-0 start to begin the 2021-22 season, tying 2017-18 for his best start to a season at UCF.

• Dawkins led UCF to its first NIT Final Four (2017), first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament (2019) and first NCAA Tournament win (2019).

• Prior to Dawkins' arrival at UCF, the program had won three games against ranked opponents from 1984-2016. Since Dawkins has taken over, the Knights have won five contests against ranked foes, bringing the program total to eight.

• UCF had never won two games against ranked teams in a single season until the Knights did it in a span of five days, taking down No. 6 Houston and No. 19 Cincinnati late in 2018-19.

POSTSEASON PUSHES

• The Knights have made the postseason in three of Johnny Dawkins' seven years at the helm of the UCF program. It's an unprecedented stretch, the first of its kind in Knights history.

• UCF experienced immediate postseason success by making the NIT in the first year under Dawkins' new leadership, reaching the NIT Semifinal in Madison Square Garden in 2016-17.

• The Black and Gold returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005 when they earned an at-large bid into the 2019 bracket as a No. 9 seed. Dawkins led the Knights to their first NCAA Tournament victory in program history, beating VCU 73-58 in the first round. The Black and Gold were narrowly defeated in the next round, falling to top-seeded Duke 77-76.

• UCF returned to the postseason by making the NIT in 2022-23 and earning a first round victory over in-state foe Florida. The Knights were the only team to hold Florida below 50 points during 2022-23 while the 49 Gator points were the least they've scored at home since Jan. 13, 1962 when they beat Auburn 43-40. Taylor Hendricks led the way with 17 points and eight rebounds in the victory.

• The Knights have been to five total NCAA DI Tournaments and three NITs, totaling eight postseason appearances.

CHECK OUT THE CHECK!

• UCF Athletics has renewed its contract with Nike. A new five-year deal keeps Nike as the official apparel and footwear provider of the Knights through the 2028-29 academic year.

• UCF will continue to work directly with Nike as the official supplier of uniforms, equipment and apparel for UCF Athletics.

• "As a Nike school since 2010, UCF has experienced tremendous growth with this partnership, and we will continue to elevate in the Big 12 Conference," says UCF vice president and director of athletics Terry Mohajir. "Nike has allowed us to innovate and enhance our brand among some of the best in the country. ADDITION FINANCIAL ARENA



The UCF men's and women's basketball programs have called the beautiful 10,000-seat Addition Financial Arena its home since the start of the 2007-08 season. Located in the heart of Knights Plaza on the expansive north side of campus, the state-of-the-art facility opened in the fall of 2007 to packed crowds at multiple events.

Addition Financial Arena's unique design provides an intimate atmosphere for all students, alumni, fans and supporters, while creating an intimidating environment for opponents. With a raucous student section, dubbed the "Knightmare," Addition Financial Arena has quickly become one of the more formidable basketball facilities in the entire southeast. The design offers perfect sight lines for all fans, giving every fan a spectacular view.

Approximately 7,000 seats make up the lower bowl, with an additional 3,000 seats situated in the upper level. Club level seating is on the east side of the arena, with exclusive access to the regal Black and Gold Club before, during and after each game.

The facility features 16 luxury boxes and suites, a club lounge, open concourse areas and numerous concession options. Fans benefit from a state-of-the-art audio and video system. The scoreboard located at center court features four video screens that show replays and player information with an LED ribbon board stretching around the bottom.

Patrons enter the building through a spacious lobby that has conveniently located concession and apparel stands.

Addition Financial Arena sits on the northern side of campus and is nestled in with UCF's other athletics facilities, including FBC Mortgage Stadium, The Venue, John Euliano Park and the UCF Soccer/Track Complex. FBC Mortgage Stadium also opened up during the same September week in 2007.

The arena is the centerpiece of an area that includes apartment-style dormitories with 2,000 total beds and about 100,000-square feet of retail space. Before and after games, fans can dine and shop at establishments like Barnes & Noble Bookstore, Burger U, Gringos Locos, Domino's, The Pop Parlour, Dunkin', Jimmy John's, Subway and Knightro's.

The neighboring retail area has room for 24 shops.

Addition Financial Arena also hosts premiere concerts along with UCF commencement ceremonies. The Central Florida Crusaders, expansion members of the National Indoor Soccer League, began fielding men's and women's teams in the venue for the 2022-23 season.

The arena is located directly in front of UCF's old home, The Venue, which re-opened following a year of massive renovations to create a new home for the women's volleyball program as well as dedicated practice facilities for both the men's and women's basketball programs. The Knights played in the former 5,100-seat building from 1991-2007.

Construction on the new facility began in November of 2005. The arena was designed by HOK Sports and constructed by KUD International.

The arena officially opened on Sept. 8, 2007, with a Reba McEntire concert. The first UCF event at the new arena occurred on Sept. 28, 2007, when the UCF volleyball team hosted East Carolina.

Johnny Dawkins

Head Coach | Eighth Season

UCF head men's coach Johnny Dawkins has built a particularly glossy college basketball playing and coaching catalogue—most recently including 2023 induction into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame and selection of a UCF player in the first round of the 2023 NBA Draft—as he joins the Knights in heading into Big 12 Conference play in 2023-24.

Dawkins' resume showcases:

- 15 seasons as a major-college head coach (the last seven at UCF), including eight postseason berths and a pair of National Invitation Tournament titles
- Extensive player development, highlighted by Taylor Hendricks' selection in the first round of the 2023 NBA Draft after only a single season at UCF

- 10 additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Duke, including NCAA Championship appearances every year, an NCAA title in 2001 and seven Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament crowns
 - A nine-year NBA career that included a career double-figure scoring average
 - A collegiate playing career at Duke that featured national player-of-the-year recognition as a senior as the school's all-time top career scorer, later culminating with his 2023 National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame selection
- In seven seasons at UCF, Dawkins has led the program to unprecedented heights, in the only seven-year stretch with three or more postseason appearances. He led the Knights to their first NCAA Championship victory in 2019. He's also responsible for producing UCF's first lottery pick after Taylor Hendricks was selected by the Utah Jazz with the ninth overall pick in the 2023 NBA Draft. Now, Dawkins will look to bring the Knights to even greater achievements as UCF beginning in 2023-24 begins participation in one of the deepest, most challenging conferences in college basketball, the Big 12.

Dawkins boasts five wins over ranked opponents in his time at the helm of the Knights, accounting for the majority of UCF's wins over Associated Press top-25 teams in the program's history. Most recently, the Knights topped in-state rival and 15th-ranked Florida State in Tallahassee in 2020, the program's first victory over the Seminoles. The Knights ripped off consecutive victories over No. 6 Houston and No. 19 Cincinnati during the 2018-19 regular-season run to the NCAA Championship, solidifying themselves in the field of 64. UCF defeated No. 24 Alabama in December 2017, after earning the first ranked win under Dawkins on Feb. 26, 2017, beating No. 15 Cincinnati 53-49. UCF cracked the AP poll on Mar. 4, 2019, for the first time since 2011, earning a ranking of 25th late in the regular season. It was the latest into a season that the Knights had been ranked. The home finale against Cincinnati in 2019 marked the first matchup of ranked teams at Addition Financial Arena.

Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016.

The 2019 NCAA Championship Run

The 2018-19 season was Dawkins' best to date with the Knights as he guided UCF to a number-nine seed in the NCAA Championship bracket, its highest seed in five all-time NCAA Championship appearances, and defeated eighth-seeded VCU 73-58 in first-round action.

UCF then came inches away from upsetting top overall seed Duke in the second round, ultimately falling 77-76 to Mike Krzyzewski, Zion Williamson and RJ Barrett as BJ Taylor's floater rimmed out and Aubrey Dawkins' tip-in barely missed at the buzzer.

The Knights were stellar down the stretch to secure their at-large NCAA Championship berth, winning on the road at No. 6/8 Houston to snap the Cougars' 33-game home win streak and topping No. 19/20 Cincinnati in Orlando. It marked the first time UCF had earned multiple victories over ranked opponents in the same season, and the Knights did it in back-to-back games.

Dawkins led UCF back to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2005, and the first time as an at-large selection (with the previous four NCAA Championships as champions of the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament in 1994, 1996, 2004 and 2005). He helped three individuals earn all-conference accolades from the American Athletic Conference in 2018-19, as UCF led the league with three honorees. BJ Taylor became the first Knight to earn first-team AAC honors, while Aubrey Dawkins was named second team and Tacko Fall added third-team honors. It marked just the second time that the Knights put multiple student-athletes on the AAC all-conference teams and the ninth time in the program's Division I history that multiple Knights earned all-conference honors in the same season (dating back to the 1993-94 season). With two players on the three all-conference teams, only Houston had more players earn all-conference honors.

Following the end of the 2018-19 regular season, Dawkins was named a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

UCF finished the year 24-9, tied for the fourth most wins in a season in program history. The Knights' 23 regular-season wins marked a record in UCF's Division I era. The team went 13-5 in AAC play, the team's most league wins since joining that conference, and earned the number-four seed in the conference tournament for the second time in three seasons.

Dominant Defense

Known for their defense under Dawkins, the Knights ranked 11th in the nation in field-goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 39.4 percent shooting in the 2018-19 NCAA Championship run. UCF was also 27th in scoring defense, allowing 64.5 points per game that season.

Defense always has been a priority with UCF teams, as four of Dawkins' seven seasons with the Knights have seen the team finish inside the top 50 nationally in scoring defense, including two top-10 finishes. UCF ranked third in the nation in scoring defense in 2017-18, holding teams to 61.7 points per game and 40.1% shooting, slotting the team at the No. 10 spot in the country. Dawkins' first season with UCF in 2016-17 saw the team finish No. 1 in field-goal percentage defense, limiting foes to 36.5% from the field, and No. 6 in scoring defense, with opponents averaging 61.2 points per contest.

Highly-Touted Hendricks

Taylor Hendricks qualifies as UCF's top recruit in program history. He came into college as a top-100 player in two of

the three major recruit rankings as ESPN pinned him No. 54 and Rivals had him at No. 87. Hendricks lived up to the hype on opening night, dropping a team-best 23 points in his collegiate debut and finishing with averages of 15.3 points and 6.9 rebounds.

Through plenty of work and coaching throughout the season, Hendricks quietly began to creep into mock drafts across the country. At season's end, Hendricks had achieved two career-high marks of 25 points and recorded five double-doubles. He was the nation's only player to make 60 or more three-pointers, tally 55 or more blocks and record 35 or more dunks. He was honored with a unanimous selection to the American Athletic Conference All-Rookie Team and was named second-team All-AAC.

Hendricks announced his intent to enter the NBA Draft on Mar. 22, 2023, making him UCF's first one-and-done player. The freshman phenom later went on to become the Knights' first lottery pick as well as a first-round selection, going ninth to the Utah Jazz in the 2023 NBA Draft.

Enshrined in the College Basketball Hall of Fame, Dawkins was honored Aug. 30, 2023, as an inductee in the 18th class of the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. He was joined by former Duke coach Mike Krzyzewski, who was officially honored in the class of 2023 after initially being among the Hall of Fame's Founding Class in 2006.

Dawkins was inducted for his playing days as a Blue Devil and is one of the most decorated players in Duke history. He is regarded as a key early figure in the program's ascent to becoming a national power. From 1982-86, Dawkins piled up 2,556 points – a mark that stood as the school's scoring record until 2006 and remains second all-time. He was a two-time consensus All-American, a four-time All-ACC selection—and was recipient of the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year award.

As a senior, Dawkins led Duke to the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and an appearance in the NCAA national championship game. The 10th overall pick by the Spurs in the 1986 NBA Draft, Dawkins saw action in nine professional seasons with the Spurs, 76ers and Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists through 541 career NBA games.

UCF Player Honors

Multiple players have earned conference and national honors under Dawkins' tenure. Tacko Fall earned a spot on the Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America team in 2016-17 and was named the American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year. B.J. Taylor earned first-team All-AAC and NABC first-team All-District honors in 2018-19.

Seven nods to the All-AAC Team were awarded while the Knights were members of that league. An additional three All-Rookie Team honors were earned, all over the last three seasons. Taylor Hendricks earned second-team All-Conference honors as well as a unanimous nod to the All-Rookie Team in 2022-23, as well as tallying a record nine conference rookie-of-the-week accolades. Darius Johnson and Isaiah Adams preceded Hendricks in earning All-Rookie Team nods in 2021-22 and 2020-21, respectively. Aubrey Dawkins (2018-19) and Taylor (2016-17) are the other Knights who received All-AAC second-team honors, while Darin Green Jr. (2021-22), Brandon Mahan (2020-21), Darius Perry (2020-21) and Fall (2018-19) all were members of an AAC third team.

Postseason Pushes

On top of the NCAA Championship run in 2018-19, the Knights have punched two tickets to the NIT under Dawkins' direction. In the most recent trip in 2023, the Knights travelled to Gainesville, Florida, and handily beat Florida 67-49, UCF's first road victory against the Gators in program history. The Knights were the only team to hold Florida under 50 points all season. It was the sixth time that season UCF limited an opponent to 50 points or fewer. The Knights' run came to an end in their inaugural meeting with top-seeded Oregon in Eugene.

The 2016-17 season took UCF to New York's Madison Square Garden in Dawkins' first year at the helm of the Knights. UCF hosted its first NIT game, defeating Colorado for the program's first postseason win in an NIT or NCAA game. The Knights went on to defeat top-seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first sell-out crowd at Addition Financial Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT semifinals. Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all NCAA Division I teams in defensive field-goal percentage, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or fewer points in four games over the course of the year. Dawkins was a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards in his first season at UCF. Matt Williams set UCF records for three-pointers in a career, season and game, before signing a professional contract with the Miami Heat.

Notable Notes

In UCF's Dec. 11, 2021, win over North Carolina A&T, Dawkins picked up his 100th victory with the Knights, becoming the fastest coach in program history and just the third one to do so. Following the end of the 2022-23 season, Dawkins stands 131-87 all-time as head coach of the Knights, a winning percentage of .600, currently the second-highest in program history, trailing only Torchy Clark's .755 mark.





In seven years, Dawkins has done a similarly successful job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team grade-point average over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history in 2018. Then the Knights did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 in spring 2019. Under Dawkins' watch, more than 45 nods have been earned by Knights on the AAC All-Academic team.

When Dawkins took over at UCF, the Knights had gone 12-18 the season before and hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13. He led UCF to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth-best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever – in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion SMU in the semifinals.

Stanford Stint

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country—with a nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games against RPI top-50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of his final four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award in 2016.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's initial first-team Academic All-America selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores of 1,000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers—including 2014 first-round pick Josh Huestis.

Learning from a Legend

The Washington, D.C., native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular-season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 (.846) record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the player personnel director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.

Decorated at Duke

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic High School in Washington, D.C. (McDonald's All-American and third-team Parade All-American), Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to set foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1982-83 through 1985-86, earning consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Championship berths, including an NCAA title-game appearance in 1986. He was an All-ACC honoree all four seasons as a Blue Devil. Dawkins helped Duke win the 1986 ACC Tournament title in his senior season, claiming the MVP award in the process.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129 of 133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also setting the school's single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.
