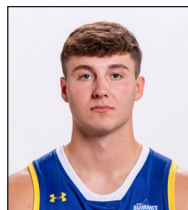

- South Dakota State continues its four-game stretch away from Brookings on Sunday when the Jackrabbits take part in the Jacksonville Classic on the campus of Flagler College in St. Augustine, Fla. The Jacks open the multi-team event at 7 p.m. CT when they take on UCF.
- The Jackrabbits take part in the Coast Bracket of the event. SDSU's second game on Monday will see the Jacks face either Charlotte or George Mason that evening depending on Sunday's results. SDSU is 21-12 overall in multi-team events during its Division I era.
- SDSU has faced UCF four times with each contest coming at the start of the Jackrabbits' transition to the DI level. The Golden Knights hold a 3-1 record over the Jacks with SDSU's win coming in Brookings in 2007. The two sides last met in November of 2008 at the Cancun Challenge with UCF earning a 66-64 victory.
- The Golden Knights are 2-1 this season under eighth-year coach Johnny Dawkins. Jaylin Sellers leads UCF in scoring (20.0 PPG) and rebounding (7.3). The squad's lone loss is an 88-72 defeat at No. 16 Miami on Nov. 10.
- SDSU has faced George Mason once with the matchup recently taking place at the Crossover Classic held at the Sanford Pentagon in November of 2021. The Jacks won that game by an 80-76 score. SDSU has never played Charlotte.
- The Jacks are coming off a 91-68 setback at Kansas State on Monday. The Wildcats ran away with the win by shooting over 65% from the floor, and making 8 of 11 3-pointers, during the second half in Bramlage Coliseum. Kansas State's total 57.4% shooting clip and 56% mark from long range would have been the second highest mark by an SDSU opponent a season ago.
- Charlie Easley led SDSU with 21 points in the defeat versus the Wildcats. His point total was the second highest of his career, while his six steals were a career best. Easley's steal total is tied for the second most by a Jackrabbit in a single game during SDSU's DI era.
- Easley's six steals paced a total of 12 SDSU recorded versus Kansas State. the double-digit steal output is the Jacks' first since 2021. Luke Appel made a career-high three 3-pointers.

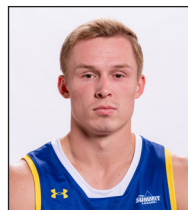
SOUTH DAKOTA STATE PROJECTED LINEUP

- His 2021-22 team became first in Summit League history to go undefeated (18-0), led NCAA in 3-point percentage (44.5%) and finished fourth in ColleagueInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll.
- Henderson's squads have won at least a share of the Summit League regular season title in three of four seasons at helm of the program.
- A Jackrabbit has earned All-League honors 10 times in four seasons under Henderson.
- Henderson has a 49-4 record inside Frost Arena in his first five seasons as head coach and the Jackrabbits are 89-7 at Frost Arena during his combined eight seasons with the program.

LAST TIME OUT

Kansas State shot over 50% from the field, including an over 65% clip in the second half, on its way to defeating South Dakota State 91-68 at Bramlage Coliseum on Monday.

The Wildcats jumped out to a double-digit lead seven minutes into the first half on a Cam Carter 3-pointer. SDSU cut the deficit to five on three occasions, however a nine-point scoring run near the end of the first half gave Kansas State a 14-point edge. SDSU's Zeke Mayo scored the last five points of the opening half to make it a 38-29 score at the halftime break.

A layup by Luke Appel and dunk by William Kyle III trimmed the Kansas State advantage to eight on two consecutive possessions, however a Will McNair Jr. dunk pushed the Wildcats back into a double-digit cushion that never dipped into single digits again.

Kansas State finished the game by shooting 57.4% from the floor and also was 14 of 25 from 3-point range. The Wildcats closed out the contest with a 65.6% clip in the second half while draining 8 of 11 3-pointers.

The Wildcats improved to 2-1 with the victory while the Jacks dropped to 1-2 overall.

South Dakota State had three double digit scorers. Charlie Easley scored a season-high 21 points and recorded a career-high six steals. Easley was 9 of 13 from the floor while making all but one of his eight attempts within the 3-point line.

Joining him with 10-plus points were Luke Appel and Zeke Mayo. Appel scored a season-high 16 points and had a team-high seven rebounds. Mayo registered 11 points and dished out a team- and season-high six assists. Nate Barnhart had a team-high two blocks and Kalen Garry had three steals.

Kansas State had two 20-point scorers in Carter (25) and Tylor Perry (22). David N'Guessan grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds.

The Wildcats are now 4-0 all-time against the Jackrabbits following the two sides' first meeting in 60 years.

DUO RECORD DOUBLE-DOUBLES

William Kyle III and Zeke Mayo each registered double-doubles in SDSU's first win of the season, an 83-55 victory over Dakota Wesleyan on Nov. 8.

Mayo had 28 points along with 10 rebounds for his fifth career double-double. Kyle III had 17 points and snagged a career-high 13 rebounds. The pair of Jackrabbits were the first set of SDSU teammates to achieve the feat in the same game in almost two years to the date. Douglas Wilson and Baylor Schierman had double-doubles in a Nov. 9, 2021 season-opening win over Bradley at Frost Arena.

PROGRAM SUCCESS CONTINUES

SDSU won 226 games over the past decade heading into the 2023-24 season. That total ranks 28th among all men's squads in the nation heading into the 2023-24 season. The Jacks' overall win percentage of 69.3% during that span ranks 23rd in the country while SDSU has the ninth best mark among 'mid-major' programs.

TRIO OF SENIORS DEPART

SDSU graduated three senior student-athletes from its 2022-23 team in Alex Arians, Matt Dentlinger and Aaron Fiegen. The three graduating student-athletes had over the past five years helped lead the program to 111 victories and was the winningest senior class in SDSU's men's team's history.

The duo of Arians and Dentlinger ended their careers among the best in several categories in program history and played more games in Yellow

and Blue than any other former Jackrabbit.

Arians saved his best basketball of the season for the conference tournament as he set his season high of 18 points in the quarterfinal win, then tied his career best of 20 points in the semifinal loss. The Madison, Wis., native ended his Jackrabbit tenure as SDSU's all-time starts leader with 137. He also finished as SDSU's all-time minutes played leader (4,427), is ninth in assists (326), 11th in 3-point percentage (40.7) and tied for 23rd in points with 1,272.

Dentlinger put together arguably his best season of his college career as a senior and was recognized for his efforts as a Second Team All-Summit League performer. He averaged 12.3 points and 5.3 rebounds in 32 games played. Dentlinger's conference marks were even better in 18 contests as he averaged 14.9 points and 5.8 rebounds. Dentlinger was a Three-time Academic All-American which included First Team honors this past year.

STILL AMONG TOP OF THE SUMMIT

South Dakota State remains one of the top contenders in The Summit League heading into the 2023-24 season. Over the last five years, SDSU ranks seventh in Division I men's basketball in conference record win percentage at 80.4% (74-18). The only teams the Jacks trail include Gonzaga, Vermont, Colgate, Houston, Liberty and Belmont.

ZEKE MAYO ADDS TO 1ST TEAM LEGACY

Zeke Mayo's First Team All-Summit League accolades for the 2022-23 season continued an impressive stretch for the Jackrabbit program. SDSU had had 13 straight seasons in which its had at least one player named to the conference's First Team.

The streak started in 2011 with Nate Wolters who was a three-time First Team selection. Mike Daum paced SDSU during that span with four First Team All-Summit League honors.

SDSU CLOSES OUT TOUGH NON-CON

The Jackrabbits have a history of playing competitive non-conference slates and this season, as well as the 2022-23 slate, are a noticeable sign.

SDSU finished the 2022-23 season with the 10th ranked non-conference strength of schedule. The Jackrabbits were just one of four teams among the top 10 that finished with a winning record. Five of SDSU's non-league opponents made the NCAA Tournament.

This year's schedule features an Elite Eight team a season ago in Kansas State, CBI champion Charlotte and conference champion favorites this year in Weber State and Akron.

JACKRABBITS COMPLETE MTE SHOWING

SDSU is slated to participate in two multiple team events this season. The Jackrabbits will take part in the Jacksonville Classic in November and the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational in December.

South Dakota State went 1-1 in its appearance at the Hostilo Community Classic in Savannah, Ga., in its lone MTE of the 2022-23 season. The multi-team regular season event was the 11th for SDSU in the previous 10 seasons. SDSU is 21-12 overall in MTEs during that span. The Jackrabbits went undefeated in MTEs in 2012-13, 2014-15 and 2015-16.

FROST ARENA DOMINANCE

South Dakota State has one of the best home court advantages in Division I men's basketball. Since the beginning of the 2015-16 season, the Jacks are 101-7 in Frost Arena, a .935 winning percentage which ranks third in the nation. Despite home win streaks being snapped twice last season, SDSU has won 83 of their last 88 games in Frost. Dating back to the 2011-12 campaign, SDSU has won over 93% of its games at home, with only Gonzaga and Kansas with a similar percentage.

SDSU has been perfect at home in seven of the last 11 seasons. In that span, no other program has had more than five unbeaten seasons at home.

HOLDING SERVE IN SHOWDOWN SERIES

SDSU completed a season sweep over South Dakota during the 2022-23 season. The victory extended the Jackrabbits' streak of wins against the Yotes to six, the longest in the head-to-head series since the early 2000s. The margin in the 82-64 win on the road for the Jacks in the two sides' first meeting matched the largest victory by SDSU in a win in Vermillion since 1974.

The Jackrabbits have won 20 of the last 26 matchups against their rival and are 16-1 in Brookings during the 21st century.

SDSU'S RUN OF SUCCESS

South Dakota State has played in eight of the last ten postseasons, excluding the 2019-20 season when the COVID-19 pandemic caused the cancellation of all postseason tournaments. The Jacks have been to six NCAA tournaments, a pair of National Invitation Tournaments and one trip to the College Basketball Invitational.

SDSU has won six Summit League Tournament since 2011-12 and at least a share of eight of the last 10 regular season crowns. The Jackrabbits have won 20 or more games in four of the last six seasons and eight of the last 12 campaigns.

TOUGH END TO 2022-23 SLATE

South Dakota State's 2022-23 schedule came to a close with a Summit League Tournament, 89-79, semifinal defeat to North Dakota State on March 6 in Sioux Falls. The Jackrabbits' campaign ended with SDSU finishing with a 19-13 overall record.

The Jackrabbits dropped to 25-9 all-time in The Summit League conference tournament which includes a 7-5 mark in the semifinals. SDSU's quarterfinal win against Omaha improved its record to 4-0 versus the Mavs in the league's postseason tourney, while it fell to 4-2 against the Bison.

JACKRABBITS REEL IN HONORS IN 2023

Four Jackrabbits were recognized at the end of the 2022-23 conference schedule by The Summit League.

Zeke Mayo headlined SDSU's recognition as he was named First Team All-Summit League. Matt Dentlinger was voted Second Team All-Summit League. Matt Mims was picked as an All-Defensive Team selection and William Kyle III made The Summit League All-Newcomer Team.

Mayo led the Jackrabbits in scoring (18.3), rebounding (6.2) and assists (3.4) becoming the

first player to lead the SDSU program in all three since Nate Wolters in 2012. He produced double digit points in all but three contests. Mayo was a three-time Summit League Performer of the Week.

Mims moved into SDSU's starting lineup at the start of conference play. He shined on the defensive end for South Dakota State as he drew the Jackrabbits' toughest assignment against opponents in the backcourt.

Kyle III was one of two freshmen picked to the All-Newcomer Team. He was a consistent performer for the Jacks as he recorded double digit points in 13 games. He appeared in all 30 contests for the Jackrabbits on the season and started in 23.

FIRST BANK & TRUST ARENA RENOVATION

Construction has begun on the complete renovation of Frost Arena which will turn SDSU's home facility into First Bank & Trust Arena.

Opened with a \$20 million lead gift, the project is estimated at \$50 million. New and improved locker rooms and offices are also a part of the design. The arena is expected to be completed in the fall of 2024.
