Pronunciation Guide

Maine enters their matchup against UCF allowing the 24th fewest points per game in the NCAA at 63.2 per game, which also leads the America East.

Maine ranks in the Top-100 in a number of key categories, inlcuding: Steals per game (43rd), three-point defense (57th), turnover margin (60th), fewest turnovers per game (79th), free throw percentage (86th), field goal percentage (90th) and turnovers forced per game (91st).

Player Spotlights:

Kellen Tynes: Tynes has come out to begin the season averaging a team high in points (14.3 - 9th in AE) and steals (1.9 - 3rd in AE) per contest, which ranks him nationally at 86th in steals per game. His 23 total steals are good for the 29th most steals in the NCAA.

Tynes ranks fifth in the America East in assist-to-turnover ratio with a 1.95 ratio.

One season ago, Kellen Tynes (Jr. – Dartmouth, Nova Scotia) became the first Black Bear in program history to be named a Conference Defensive Player of the Year, a National Semifinalist for Defensive Player of the Year and his numbers were above anyone else in the entire NCAA. Tynes led the country with 98 steals (excluding the NCAA Tournament) and his average of 3.27 steals per game also led the country and were the most in the NCAA in three years.

Jaden Clayton: Clayton has emerged as one of the most reliable point guards in the America East in the early part of the season as he is fourth in the America East in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.82 and his 51 assists are good for the 49th most in the country in the early part of the season. His 20 steals on the season have him ranked 61st in the country and fourth in the America East. Clayton recent had a stretch in which he scored 15 points in back-to-back outings against Holy Cross and Brown, his most points scored in a two-game span in his collegiate career.

As a freshman in 2022-23, Clayton established himself as a reliable passer as the point guard for the new look Black Bears. Clayton ranked third in the America East with 3.9 assists per game, which was the third most in the conference and his 118 total assists were also the third most in the conference.

Clayton earned a spot on the All-Rookie Team in the America East as he also ranked second in the America East in total steals with 54, trailing only his teammate, Kellen Tynes. Clayton scored 6.9 points per contest last season on only 38.8% from the field, numbers he is looking to improve upon when he takes the floor as the starting point guard on opening night for the Black Bears.

Peter Filipovity: Filipovity continues to reward Coach Markwood and his staff on their decision to insert him into the starting lineup by averaging the second most points per contest on the team at 13.6 (11th in AE), all while shooting at a 57.8% (6th in AE) mark from the field. His 6.8 rebounds per game also leads the Black Bears and are the fourth-most rebounds per game in the America East. His three double-doubles on the season is good for the 43rd most in the NCAA on the season and the second-most in the America East.

Over his past eight games, he has set a new career-high of 23 points with an outburst against South Florida to lead the Black Bears to the victory. He also tied his career-high in rebounds with 12 rebounds, a mark he just hit again in the victory over Holy Cross. He has recorded three double-doubles during his current stretch of solid play, which has him averaging 16.7 points per game and 9.7 rebounds per game over the past six contests.

A finalist for the America East Sixth Man of the Year, Filipovity took a big leap forward is in his first under Coach Markwood and his staff. His average points nearly doubled as he went from averaging 4.8 points in 2021-22 to 9.2 points per game in 2022-23. His rebounding numbers also increased by more than double as he averaged 5.7 last season, compared to 2.7 the season before.

Program History against UCF: This will be the sixth meeting all-time between these two programs and the first since the 2002-03 season. UCF leads the all-time series, 4-1.

Head Coach Chris Markwood

UMaine '05 - Second Season - 21-21 Record

Chris Markwood ('05) was named the 23rd head men's basketball coach at the University of Maine on March 21, 2022.

In his first full season at the helm of the Maine men's basketball program, in led the team to its most wins in a single season season since 2010-11 with 13 wins and a playoff berth in the America East Championships. He coached the first ever America East Defensive Player of the Year in program's history in Kellen Tynes while having a pair of All-Conference selections in Tynes and Gedi Juozapaitis.

Markwood has served as an assistant coach for the past 16 seasons at schools throughout the northeast region, including a five-year stint at the University of Maine from 2006-11. During his assistant coaching career, Markwood has helped lead two different Division I programs to a combined total of six 21+



win seasons, four conference regular season championships, three conference tournament titles, and five postseason berths including three trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach at UMaine, Markwood served as an assistant coach at Boston College during the 2021-22 season where he helped guide the Eagles to a nine-win improvement from the season prior to his arrival.

Before his time at Boston College, Markwood spent seven seasons on staff at Northeastern. Markwood joined the Huskies staff in 2014 and spent the first four seasons as an assistant coach before being elevated to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for his final three seasons at Northeastern. In 2020, Markwood was named the top assistant coach in the Colonial Athletic Association by Jeff Goodman of Stadium. In his stint at

Northeastern, Markwood helped guide Northeastern to three 23-win seasons, three CAA regular season titles, two CAA tournament championships, and a pair of trips to the NCAA Tournament.

After leaving the staff at UMaine in 2011, Markwood served three seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Vermont. During his time on staff, the Catamounts boasted a 38-9 record in America East play while Markwood helped lead the program to three 21+ win seasons, an America East regular season and tournament championship, and three postseason berths, including a trip to the NCAA Tournament where the Catamounts advanced to the second round.

While coaching at UMaine from 2006-11, Markwood was part of a UMaine staff in 2009-10 which registered the third-most single-season victories (19) in program history.

In total under his tutelage as an assistant coach, Markwood has recruited and mentored 25 all-conference selections, a Player of the Year award winner, one Rookie of the Year, and three Defensive Players of the Year.

Markwood graduated from the University of Maine in 2005 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration and Sociology. While at UMaine, Markwood played two seasons for the Black Bears, serving as team captain as a senior in 2004-05. Before transferring to UMaine, Markwood played two seasons at Notre Dame where he helped lead the Fighting Irish to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths and a Big East regular season title. Markwood was a standout for South Portland High School where he was named the 2000 Maine Gatorade Player of the Year.

Markwood and his wife, Ashley (Underwood) Markwood, are the proud parents of two daughters, London and Malia. Markwood's wife was an all-conference player for the University of Maine women's basketball team from 2003-07, ending her career with 1,195 points scored for the Black Bears.



Coaching Staff

Rob O'Driscoll - Assistant Coach

Villanova '94 - Second Season

O'Driscoll, a graduate of Villanova University (BA '94, Master's '97), began his career in basketball at Villanova in 1994. During his tenure, O'Driscoll previously served on staffs at Villanova, Manhattan, Iona, Marist, James Madison, and Drexel.

O'Driscoll began his career as the Administrative Assistant for Men's Basketball at Villanova in 1994. During his two seasons there, the Wildcats finished both seasons ranked No. 9 in the country in the Associated Press final poll. The Wildcats won the Big East Championship in the 1994-95 season.

In 1996, O'Driscoll moved on to be an assistant coach at Manhattan College, where he served from 1996-1998. He recruited and coached two MAAC All-Conference Team selections during his time with the Jaspers.

Following the 1998 season, he joined the Iona coaching staff as an assistant coach, from which he served from '98-'04. While

at Iona, he was part of two MAAC Tournament championship teams (1999-2000 & 2000-01). He recruited and coached 14 MAAC All-Conference players and three All-Rookie Team selections with the Gaels as well as mentoring the 1999-2000 MAAC Player of the Year.

In 2004, O'Driscoll joined the Marist College staff, where he served as head assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. He assisted in a 2006-07 MAAC regular season championship, in which the program won a record 25 games. The team went on to register its first and only postseason win in program history at the NIT after defeating Oklahoma State. He recruited and coached seven MAAC All-Conference players and two All-Rookie selections (Rookie of the Year 2007-08), including the 2006-07 MAAC Player of the Year and NBA draft selection (45th overall), Jared Jordan.

Following his success at Marist, O'Driscoll joined the James Madison University coaching staff as the Associate Head Coach, a role he served from 2008-2016. He assisted in 139 wins for the program, including four 21-win seasons. Under his guidance, James Madison captured the 2012-13 CAA tournament championship, the 2014-15 regular season title, and won their 2012-13 NCAA Tournament First Round matchup. He recruited and coached nine CAA All-Conference players and four CAA All-Rookie Team players, including the 2008-09 Rookie of the Year.

In 2016, O'Driscoll joined the Drexel University staff, spending six seasons with the Dragons. He spent 2016-20 as an assistant coach before being promoted to Chief of Staff from 2020-2022. During his time at Drexel, he was a part of the largest comeback in NCAA history when the team was down by 34 points to Delaware before rallying back for the victory. He recruited and coached six CAA All-Conference players and two All-Rookie players, including the 2018-19 Rookie of the Year.

While serving as Chief of Staff, Drexel won the CAA championship for the 2020-21 season and earned a bid into the NCAA Tournament.



Pete Gash - Assistant Coach

Lynn University '06 - Second Season

Gash joined the Black Bears with 15 years of Division I experience at six institutions including stops at Florida Atlantic (2009-14), the University of Florida (2014-15), the University of Tennessee Chattanooga (2015-17), UMass (2017-19), LaSalle University (2019-2021), and Wagner (2021-22).

Prior to joining the University of Maine, Gash spent a season on the bench at Wagner where he played a role in guiding the Seahawks, who earned votes in the Associated Press Top-25 poll, to a 21-6 overall mark and a 15-3 record in conference play. Along the way, the Seahawks put together the nation's longest win streak (17) on their way to an appearance in the Northeast Conference title game. Individually, Gash assisted in the development of three All-NEC selections including one All-NEC first team player.

Gash spent two seasons as the director of player development at LaSalle University where he played a part in the development of Atlantic 10 Sixth Man of the Year honoree, Sherif Kenny.

Gash was the lead assistant during his stint at UMass where he was charged with leading all facets of player development. Through his impressive attention to detail and ability to grow players, Gash was able to evolve Luwane Pipkins into the Atlantic 10's Most Improved average from 10.2 points per game to 21.1

Player after Pipkins elevated his scoring average from 10.2 points per game to 21.1.

From 2015-17, Gash served as an assistant coach at the University of Tennessee Chattanooga, leading the program to an NCAA Tournament appearance, the Southern Conference regular season and tournament title, and the most wins in school history (29) in 2016. In total, the Mocs registered 49 total wins in his two seasons on staff. Under his guidance, Gash mentored the league's Defensive Player of the Year and a pair of All-SoCon honorees.

In 2009, Gash joined Florida Atlantic as the program's director of operations before being elevated to an assistant coach prior to the 2011-12 season, a role he held until 2014. In 2011, the Owl's earned their first National Invitational Tournament (NIT) appearance in school history, tied the program record for wins in a season with 21, and earned the Sun Belt Conference regular season title. Individually, Gash mentored three All-Sun Belt selections and the Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Year. After his stop at Florida Atlantic, Gash moved on to the University of Florida where he served as the team's video coordinator for one season under Chicago Bulls head coach and NCAA National Championship winning head coach, Billy Donovan.

Gash spent the 2007 season as the video coordinator at LaSalle for former University of Maine head coach, Dr. John Giannini, before joining Tom Crean's staff as a graduate assistant in 2008.

Gash, a native of Long Island, N.Y., earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in hospitality administration with a specialization in sports management from Lynn University in 2006. Gash, who played with NBA Champion Andrew Bynum at The Solebury School, is married to Alexa. The two are the proud parents of two daughters, Valentina and Luciana.

Jordon Bronner - Assistant Coach

New Hampshire '14 - Second Season

Bronner joins the Black Bears after having served as the assistant coach/recruiter for the University of New Hampshire from 2018-22. Along with recruiting, Bronner assisted in scouting of opposing teams, extensive film work within his own team, working with academic support to help monitor the student athletes and served as a coordinator for the Elite and Day Camps at New Hampshire.

Prior to being named as the assistant coach at New Hampshire, Bronner spent the 2017-18 season as the director of operations for the Wildcats, where he ran the day-to-day operations of the program. He assisted in practice/game preparation and planning, organizing of recruit reports and coordinated film exchange with opposing programs.

Bronner served as the graduate student manager during the 2016-17 season, where he worked closely with the coaching staff at New Hampshire in all aspects of recruiting, player development and individual workouts.

Bronner enjoyed a successful collegiate basketball career as a member of the New Hampshire Wildcats from 2011-14. He was named to the America East All-Rookie team in 2011, the America East Honor Roll in 2013-14 and served as the team captain in his senior season of 2013-14 before graduating in May of 2014 with his bachelors in communications.



Tommy Freeman - Director of Operations

Ohio University '11 - Second Season

Freeman, who graduated from Ohio University with a Bachelor's in Business Marketing in 2011 and a Masters in Coaching Education in 2018, has spent the last four years as the assistant coach for Hargrave Military Academy, where he assisted in all aspects of recruiting, scouting, player development and program management. Freeman previously served as the head and assistant coach for Team Teague from 2018-2021, where he monitored the academic progress of his student athletes, complied video highlights, and assisted in recruiting.

Freeman served as the graduate assistant for Ohio University from 2016-2018, where he assisted with recruiting visits, scouting reports, organized summer camps and assisted in the team's travel coordination.

Freeman enjoyed a successful playing career at Ohio University where he tallied 1,071 points and is the all-time leader in 3-point field goals made (259) and 3-point percentage (44.3%). While at Ohio University, Freeman helped lead the program to an upset over No. 3 Georgetown in the 2010 NCAA tournament. Following his collegiate career, Freeman went on to play professional basketball in Europe. He was a part of the Worcester Wolves (2011-12), the SAM Massagno (2012-13), the Windsor Express (2013-14), and the Glasgow Rocks (2014-15), before returning to Ohio University to pursue his Master's Degree.

While playing professional basketball, Freeman served as a shooting coach from 2013-2016 for Pro Shot, where they conducted 30 shooting camps in 12-15 states, where he instructed athletes from eight to 25 years old, including current Minnesota Timberwolves star, Karl Anthony-Towns.




