CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Highlighted by unanimous No. 1 Oklahoma, four league teams are featured in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll.
In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Preseason Top 25 Poll, Oklahoma is No. 1, Texas is No. 3, Oklahoma State is No. 8 and Baylor is No. 22.
The Big 12 is the only league to have three teams in the top eight in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.
Fourteen ranked matchups are featured during Week 2, including three coming against USA Today/NFCA top 10 teams.
UCF will be featured on ESPN when the Knights take on No. 19/20 UCLA while Texas' top 10 showdown against No. 9/9 Stanford will air on ESPN2 along with its game against No. 22/RV Northwestern set for ESPNU.
The Big 12 has the second-highest winning percentage (.750) of any league entering the second week of the season.
Texas' Reese Atwood (Player) and Oklahoma's Kelly Maxwell (Pitcher) secured weekly awards following the first week of the 2024 softball season.
Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll.
This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball.
The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field.

-  Atwood finished the week leading the Big 12 in hits (11), RBIs (12), total bases (22) and slugging percentage (1.467) while being tied for first in home runs (3) and runs scored (7).
-  Maxwell earned two wins against NFCA top-II opponents in her debut outings for the Crimson and Cream. Opposing batters hit just 1-for-23 against Maxwell as she limited hitters to a .043 average and a .197 OPS in her two appearances.
-  Baylor's Rylee Crandall struck out four in 5.2 innings pitched while taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning against then No. 2/2 Tennessee.
-  BYU rallied from eight down to defeat Kansas City in the Cougars' season opener while scoring 17 unanswered runs.
-  Jada Cody's solo home run against Howard was the 33rd of her career, tied for the second-most in a career in UCF's history with Jania Shinhoster.
-  Houston's 37 runs are tied for the second-most in program history through five games.
-  Iowa State's 12 runs against Utah Valley were the most by a Cyclone squad in a season-opener since the 2011 team scored 17 against Western Illinois.
-  Kansas' Katie Brooks was named to the NFCA Leadoff Classic All-Tournament team after posting a 0.82 ERA and 11 strikeouts. In 11.0 innings pitched, Brooks allowed just one run on seven hits.
-  Oklahoma now owns the longest winning streak in NCAA history (57 games after Week 1), breaking the previous all-division record held by then-Division II program Western Kentucky (55 games).

-  UT's Mac Morgan became the fourth Longhorn to throw a no-hitter in the first game of the season as she tossed 93 pitches, struck out five and issued only one walk in five innings of work against San Diego.
-  OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
-  Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
-  Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
-  The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason All-Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
