- Liberty continues its 11-game Florida trip to open the 2024 season, playing at UCF on Wednesday before competing in THE Spring Games against four Big Ten teams and Sun Belt program Coastal Carolina on the weekend in Leesburg, Fla.
- The Lady Flames bring a 1-4 record into the week after opening the season at the NFCA Division I Leadoff Classic. Liberty beat St. John's in the season opener on a two-out, two-run walk-off homer from Rachel Roupe before falling to No. 13 Oregon, No. 5 Clemson, Missouri and Notre Dame. UCF is Liberty's fifth straight opponent who competed in the 2023 NCAA Division I Softball Championship.
- Liberty's next opponent, UCF, went 4-1 at a home tournament to open the season, with its lone loss coming to UConn on Saturday. Liberty and UCF have both made NCAA Regional appearances each of the last three years. The Lady Flames have posted six straight 40-win seasons, while UCF has won 40 or more games three seasons in a row.
- Rachel Roupe was named CUSA Player of the Week on Monday after hitting 10-for-14 (.714) with a .733 on base percentage and 1.286 slugging percentage at the NFCA Division I Leadoff Classic. She also recorded two homers and four RBI and went a combined 5-for-5 with a walk and a homer on Saturday against No. 5 Clemson and Missouri.
- The Lady Flames were chosen as the favorite in the 2024 Conference USA Preseason Poll in their first year in the conference. Additionally, junior outfielder Rachel Roupe was voted CUSA Preseason Player of the Year, while junior Paige Bachman was voted CUSA Preseason Pitcher of the Year.
- Roupe and fellow outfielder KK Madrey were both named to the ASUN All-Conference first team last year. Roupe batted .317 with 15 homers and 50 RBI in 2023. Madrey hit .329 last year and finished second in the ASUN with 26 RBI last season. All-conference infielders Rachel Craine and Megan Fortner both batted .292 last year, with Craine hitting 12 doubles and Fortner launching 10 homers.
- North Alabama transfer Elena Escobar is 1-0 with a 0.78 ERA, tying her career high with eight strikeouts in the season opener against St. John's. Louisiana transfer Tyler Oubre boasts a 2.00 ERA, while freshman Kaylan Yoder pitched five scoreless innings against Notre Dame, Sunday. Liberty has had a different starting pitcher in all five games so far this season.



Team Notes

- Last Friday against St. John's, Liberty posted its first season-opening walk-off win since 2003. That year, Amanda Goc hit a walk-off RBI single in the eighth ininng to beat Charlotte, 2-1. This season, Rachel Roupe became the first Lady Flame to hit a walk-off homer in a season opener.
- Liberty has used five different starting pitchers this season. In each of the last three games (Katie Love vs. No. 5 Clemson, Kaylan Yoder vs. Missouri, Tyler Oubre vs. Notre Dame), the Lady Flames' starting pitcher has made her first career collegiate start in the circle.
- The Lady Flames have also seen the first collegiate starts from redshirt sophomore Hailey Deter (DP vs. No. 3 Clemson), freshman JaMaya Byrum (2B vs. Missouri) and first Division I start from junior college transfer Brooke Roberts (2B vs. St. John's).
- UCF is 6-0 all-time against Liberty in softball, winning all five meetings at UCF Softball Complex, including the last meeting to date, 3-0, on Feb. 15, 2022.
- The Lady Flames return to THE Spring Games for the first time since 2022, when they went a perfect 5-0 with wins over Maryland, FAU, Hofstra, Ohio State and South Alabama.
- Including this week's games, nine out of Liberty's first 11 opponents finished 2023 with an RPI of 75 or better, including eight in the top 55.
- lowa, who Liberty will face on Friday, won the NISC in 2023. The Lady Flames won the inaugural NISC title during the 2017 season.
- Liberty is 4-2 in its last six games against Big Ten teams, with its only two losses in the span coming to Illinois on March 12-13, 2022 at Clemson.
- Liberty will renew its series with Coastal Carolina for the first time since Coastal left the Big South following the 2016 season. Although Liberty went 2-1 in the regular season against Coastal in 2015 and 2016, the Chanticleers eliminated the Lady Flames from the Big South Tournament both years.
- This is the sixth year in a row in which Liberty has been picked as the preseason favorite in its conference's coaches poll. The Lady Flames were voted No. 1 all five years in which they played in the Atlantic Sun, and is No. 1 in this year's Conference USA preseason coaches poll.
- Liberty has competed in NCAA Regionals in four out of the last five full seasons, including Regional finals appearances in 2018 (Columbia, SC), 2021 (Knoxville) and 2023 (Los Angeles).
- Liberty's 2024 schedule features 12 teams which competed in the 2023 NCAA Division I Softball Championship, including three-time defending national champion Oklahoma, 2023 Super Regional participants Clemson, Duke, Louisiana and Oregon, 2023 Regional finalists Charlotte, LSU, Middle Tennessee and Virginia Tech and Regional teams Missouri, Notre Dame and UCF.
- Liberty received its first at-large berth in 2023, competing in Regionals for the third year in a row. The Lady Flames eliminated No. 2 UCLA and Grand Canyon before falling to San Diego State in the Los Angeles Regional final.
- Liberty went 40-22 last season, its sixth straight full season with 40 or more wins. The Lady Flames set a program record with four wins over nationally-ranked opponents, defeating Top 25 teams Alabama, Central Arkansas and Clemson. Liberty, Florida State, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Tennessee and UCLA are the only NCAA Division I softball teams with 40 or more wins every full season since 2017.
- Liberty will face the former teams of current Lady Flames Tyler Oubre (Louisiana, March 2-3), Megan Fortner (Jax State, March 15-17), Madi Bachman (UTEP, April 26-28) and KK Madrey (LSU, May 3-5). The Lady Flames will also face former teammate Karlie Keeney (Oklahoma, March 1-2).
- Liberty posted an 8-8 record in one-run games last year, including 4-5 in one-run contests against teams who competed in the 2023 NCAA Division I Softball Championship.
- Caroline Hudson (15 homers), Rachel Roupe (15) and Megan Fortner (10) gave Liberty three players with 10 or more home runs last year. The only other time that Liberty had three 10-homer hitters was in 2007 (Liberty Athletics Hall of Famer Jessica Moore, Dawn Jeffs, Ashley Williams).
- Hudson (51 RBI) and Roupe (50) were the the first pair of Liberty players to record 50 RBI or more in the same season last year.
- KK Madrey's run-saving catch on April 29 against Austin Peay made SC Top 10 that night. Madrey is the seventh Lady Flame all-time to have a play featured on SC Top 10. Rachel Roupe has had two home run saving catches (versus Ole Miss, at Charlotte) featured on SC Top 10 last season.
- In 2023, Liberty posted its 17th 30-win season in a row and seventh straight full season with 30 wins or more. The previous program record for consecutive 30-win years was five, from 1996-2000.
- Liberty went 4-5 in extra-inning games last season. The Lady Flames' nine extra-inning games were their most since having nine (6-3) in 2006.
- Liberty went over a month (Feb. 19 to March 21, 2023) between losses, as its 15-game winning streak was the third-longest winning streak to date in program history. Each of the five longest winning streaks in program history have come under current Head Coach Dot Richardson.
- Savannah Woodard (2/25/2023 vs. Princeton), Rachel Roupe (2/26/2023 vs. Marshall, 2/29/2024 vs. St. John's), Megan Fortner (4/15/2023 vs. Stetson) and Rachel Craine (4/26/2023 vs. Clemson) are current Lady Flames with a game-winning walk-off hit at the NCAA Division I level.

- Rachel Roupe entered this season with four career three-hit games. She went 3-for-4 with a triple, homer and three RBI against St. John's on Friday and then went 3-for-3 with a walk versus No. 3 Clemson. Roupe has reached base in the first inning in each of the last four games.
- Roupe reached base safely in seven straight plate appearances last weekend, spanning three games, including 6-for-6 at the plate with a walk.
- Roupe is now tied for 10th in program history with 25 homers and needs one more RBI to become the 14th player all-time at Liberty with 100 or more career RBI as a Lady Flame.
- Roupe hit a game-tying solo homer and later scored the winning run from second base in a 2-1 win over No. 2 UCLA to eliminate the Bruins from the 2023 NCAA Los Angeles Regional.
- Rachel Craine had no multiple-hit contests as a freshman in 2022, but recorded her 14th multi-hit game of the season on April 29. She also posted three three-hit contests in 2023.
- Craine provided a game-winning, two-run single in the seventh inning, clinching a 5-4 come-frombehind win over No. 6 Clemson and All-American pitcher Valerie Cagle on April 26, 2023.
- Megan Fortner had an ASUN-leading 17 doubles for Jacksonville State in 2022.
- Fortner has hit seven doubles and 10 homers for the Lady Flames, giving her 40 collegiate doubles, 28 career homers and 105 RBI spanning her time at Jacksonville State and Liberty.
- Fortner posted her fifth career four-RBI game, and first as a Lady Flame, March 28 at Virginia Tech, including a three-run homer, and followed with four RBI in a 6-0 win over Kennesaw on April 1.
- Batting leadoff for the first time in her career, senior Mary Claire Wilson singled to lead off the game against both No. 13 Oregon on Friday night and No. 5 Clemson, Saturday.
- Wilson homered in back-to-back games against North Florida, April 6-7, the first time in her career that she has hit homers in consecutive games.
- On March 9 against Sacred Heart, Wilson became the first Lady Flame all-time to record four hits and three stolen bases in the same game against a Division I opponent.
- Savannah Woodard hit a team-best .429 (3-for-7) with three walks at the 2023 ASUN Softball Championship.
- Woodard started in all four of Alabama's Women's College World Series games at second base in 2021, earning NFCA All-South Region third team.
- Sierra Kersten has started at catcher for the first time in her career, this season.
- Kersten hit .351 in 37 at bats during the month of April, adding a double, two homers and nine RBI. Her solo home run got Liberty on the board in their 5-3 win over No. 13 Alabama, April 18.
- Kersten added a homer in Liberty's victory over Jacksonville State in the 2023 ASUN quarterfinals.
- KK Madrey joined the Lady Flames from LSU, where she scored 14 runs as a freshman in 2022.
- Madrey batted a team-best .449 (22-for-49) with 17 runs scored in 19 games played in April, 2023.
- Madrey's 26 steals were the most by a Lady Flame since Tori Zavodny's 29 steals in 2016.
- Madrey hit a go-ahead three-run homer against Jacksonville State in the ASUN quarterfinals.
- Raigan Barrett returns for her second full season as a Lady Flame after missing a majority of the 2023 season due to injury. Barrett was named to the 2022 ASUN All-Freshman Team, excelling at shortstop in her first year at Liberty after redshirting at Washington in 2021.
- Barrett batted a team-best .375 (3-for-8) at the 2022 NCAA Durham Regional, including 2-for-3 against Duke (May 21).
- Savannah Jessee returns as a catching option after missing a majority of the 2023 season ude to injury. She recorded her first career hit on Feb. 16, 2023, a go-ahead RBI double in the eighth inning against Ole Miss.
- Brynn McManus was named to the 2023 ASUN All-Freshman Team. She was Liberty's top pinch hitter, batting .313 (for-16) as a pinch hitter, including 4-for-9 during ASUN play.
- Brooke Roberts joins Liberty from College of Central Florida, the same junior college which produced former Lady Flame Devyn Howard (2021-23). Roberts recorded 23 homers and 87 RBI as a sophomore and holds College of Central Florida's career records for homers (33), RBI (154) and slugging percentage (.780).
- Paige Bachman went 6-2 with a 1.65 ERA in ASUN play last season, fourth in ASUN-only ERA.
- Bachman tossed a two-hit shutout in her first career pitching start, Feb. 10, 2023 versus San Jose State. She is the first Lady Flame since Ali Thompson (2001 vs. YSU) to pitch a shutout in her first
- Bachman drew the start for Liberty's opening game at the 2023 NCAA Los Angeles Regional.
- Elena Escobar's eight strikeouts against St. John's on Friday were the most strikeouts by a Liberty pitcher in a season opener since Julia DiMartino's 10 against Fairleigh Dickinson in 2018
- Escobar was named to the 2023 ASUN All-Tournament Team, helping North Alabama make a run to the title game. That included a win over Liberty.
- Escobar went 11-5 with three shutouts in 2023, her final season at North Alabama.
- Freshman Kaylan Yoder struck out three batters in her first inning pitched, Friday against Oregon. Yoder is the first Lady Flame in their division I era with three strikeouts in her first collegiate inning.

Two-time Olympic Gold medalist, Dr. Dot Richardson has led the Liberty softball program to new heights.

Liberty has made four NCAA Regional appearances under Coach Richardson, earning the program's first-ever NCAA postseason wins in 2018 to advance to the Columbia Regional final. The Lady Flames then won twice in the 2021 Knoxville Regional, advancing to their second Regional final with a 6-4 win over Tennessee on May 22.

Liberty eliminated No. 2 national seed UCLA from the 2023 Los Angeles Regional with a dramatic 2-1 win before beating Grad Canyon to advance to its third Regional final.

She has led the Lady Flames to 40 or more wins in each of the last six seasons, something only seven NCAA Division I teams have done duing that span.

During the 2018 season, Richardson's Lady Flames won a program-record 49 games (49-14), taking a 19-game winning streak into the NCAA Columbia Regional Final. She led the team to its first-ever NCAA Regional Final appearance, being named Big South and VaSID State Coach of the Year.

In 2017, she led Liberty to its first-ever postseason championship, as the Lady Flames captured the National Invitational Softball Championship title with a 3-1 win over Lamar. The Lady Flames returned to the NISC in 2019, winning the Lynchburg Regional and finishing with a season record of 40-22.

- Coach Richardson has guided Liberty to 15 wins over nationally-ranked opponents, including wins No. 6 Michigan (2/23/20), No. 6 Clemson (4/26/23) and No 2 UCLA (5/20/23).
- Five out of the top seven winningest seasons in program history, including each of the top four, have come under Coach Richardson.
- Liberty finished the 2021 season with a program-record RPI of 19 and earned its first ever end-of-season national ranking, appearing 25th in three major polls.
- Richardson and her staff were named the 2018 NFCA Mid-Atlantic Regional Coaching Staff of the Year.
- Richardson was instrumental in the planning for the state-of-the-art Liberty Softball Stadium, a 1,000-seat structure, wihich opened March 19, 2015.
- Liberty's 2-0, 10-inning win over No. 24/24 Hofstra in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Columbia Regional on May 18, 2018, was Liberty's first win over a ranked opponent since the 2007 season.
