Atwood finished the week leading the Big 12 in hits (II), RBIs (I2), total bases (22) and slugging percentage (1.467) while being tied for first in home runs (3) and runs scored (7).


Maxwell earned two wins against NFCA top-II opponents in her debut outings for the Crimson and Cream. Opposing batters hit just I-for-23 against Maxwell as she limited hitters to a . 043 average and a . 197 OPS in her two appearances.


Baylor's Rylee Crandall struck out four in 5.2 innings pitched while taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning against then No. 2/2 Tennessee.
BYU rallied from eight down to defeat Kansas City in the Cougars' season opener while scoring 17 unanswered runs.
Jada Cody's solo home run against Howard was the 33rd of her career, tied for the second-most in a career in UCF's history with Jania Shinhoster.
Houston's 37 runs are tied for the second-most in program history through five games.
lowa State's 12 runs against Utah Valley were the most by a Cyclone squad in a season-opener since the 2011 team scored 17 against Western Illinois.

Kansas' Katie Brooks was named to the NFCA Leadoff Classic All-Tournament team after posting a 0.82 ERA and II strikeouts. In II.O innings pitched, Brooks allowed just one run on seven hits.
Oklahoma now owns the longest winning streak in NCAA history ( 57 games after Week I), breaking the previous all-division record held by then-Division II program Western Kentucky (55 games).
Oklahoma State's 9-I win over then-No. 10/8 UCLA was the first run-rule victory in a true road game against an opponent ranked in the NFCA top 10 in OSU history.
Texas scored two or more runs in a single inning on II different occasions during the first week of the season. The Longhorns outscored their opponents 64-5 during the first week and led the country in batting average . 458 .


Texas Tech's Riley Love recorded the first threehit game and multi-home run game of her career as she went $3-3$ with two home runs and a single against then-No. 3/4 Florida State.
UT's Mac Morgan became the fourth Longhorn to throw a no-hitter in the first game of the season as she tossed 93 pitches, struck out five and issued only one walk in five innings of work against San Diego.
OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason AllAmericans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
