CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 occupies the top two spots in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma continuing at No. 1 and Texas rising to No. 2. Oklahoma State is No. 7. Baylor received votes. Texas' ranking is its highest in the regular season since May 10, 2006.
- In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Oklahoma is No. 1, Texas is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 8 and Baylor is No. 22. Texas Tech and UCF received votes.
- The Big 12 is one of two leagues to have three teams in the top eight in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.
- Thirteen ranked matchups are featured during Week 3. UCF has the most ranked matchups as the Knights will take on four Top 25 teams at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.
- The Big 12 has the second-highest winning percentage (.758) of any league entering the third week of the season.
- Texas' Kayden Henry (Player) and Citlaly Gutierrez (Pitcher) collected weekly (Feb. 12-18) Big 12 softball honors following victories over then-No. 2 Tennessee and then-No. 9 Stanford at the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational. This is the first time since March 3 and March 10, 2020 that UT has won Player of the Week in consecutive weeks after Reese Atwood procured the accolade for the first week of the 2024 season. Henry was also named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA DI Player of the Week.
- Henry led the Big 12 in batting average (.833), on-base percentage (.833) and slugging percentage (1.833) for the week while ranking top-five nationally in all three.
- Gutierrez struck out six Tennessee batters while not allowing any extra base hits or walks in a complete game victory. The sophomore surrendered just one run and concluded the game retiring nine of 12 batters.
- Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.
- This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
- The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-11. All 10 teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.
- ESPN and FOX Sports selected nine league games for national broadcasts this season, including the 2024 Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship Final with a 6:30 p.m. CT start time on ESPN2 on Saturday, May 11. The full selection of games can be found on Big12Sports.com.

-  Baylor secured a road series victory over then-No. 23 Louisiana. Shaylon Govan went 6-for-7 at the plate with an intentional walk and two RBIs in the two wins.
-  Huntyr Ava's seven RBIs in BYU's game against Memphis is the most by a Big 12 player in a game this season after the first two weeks.
-  UCF's 21-9 win over Wisconsin is the third time in program history the Knights have eclipsed 20 runs, and the first time since 2003. UCF's 25 hits shattered the program's previous record of 22 while the Knights' 21 RBIs fell one shy of tying the program record of 22.
-  Houston's 94 runs this season have tied the program record for most through 11 games, originally set in 2014.
-  Iowa State left Las Vegas with the best record of any team at the UNLV Desert Classic, going 4-1 in tournament play. Iowa State used late-inning rallies (fifth inning or later) to win all four of its outings this weekend and Sunday marked the first time this season ISU went to extra innings.
-  Entering Week 2, Kansas' Katie Brooks has the lowest ERA of any Big 12 pitcher with at least 20 innings pitched at 1.11 in 25.1 innings of work.
-  Oklahoma tossed four shutouts during Week 2 and outscored its opponents 36-1 with three run-rule wins.
-  Oklahoma State's Lexi Kilfoyl spun a complete game shutout in a 3-0 win for the Cowgirls over then-No. 16/19 Florida on the road. Kilfoyl limited the Gators to three hits and struck out six while only allowing one UF runner to get to second base, with no runners reaching third.
-  Four of Texas' seven wins have come against top 10 teams. UT has outscored those teams 30-5 and has outscored all of its opponents 75-8 after two weeks.
-  Texas Tech's Maddie Kuehl struck out a career-high seven in a complete game performance to help the Red Raiders take down Texas State 4-1. Kuehl gave up just one run on five hits with no walks.
-  OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
-  Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
-  Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
-  The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason All-Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
