## CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 holds the top three spots in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma at No. 1, Texas staying at No. 2 and Oklahoma State climbing to No. 3. Baylor returned to the poll at No. 21. It is the first time in league history that the Conference has occupied the top three spots.
- In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Oklahoma is No. 1, Texas is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 6 and Baylor is No. 17. Texas Tech received votes.
- The Big 12 is the only league to have three teams in the top six in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.
- The Conference has the second-highest winning percentage (.757) of any league entering the fourth week of the season.
- The league is one of two nationally to have all of its teams with a winning percentage of .500 or greater after three weeks.
- Texas' Reese Atwood was named the Big 12 Softball Player of the Week for the second time in three weeks while Oklahoma State's Lexi Kilfoyl earned her first Pitcher of the Week nod of the season. Atwood was also named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA DI Player of the Week while Kilfoyl was selected as the Wilson/NFCA DI Pitcher of the Week.
- Atwood led the Conference in hits (11), home runs (5), RBIs (16), total bases (27) and slugging percentage (1.588) during the third week of the season. Her .647 batting average was the highest among Big 12 players with 13-or-more official plate appearances.
- Kilfoyl was the only pitcher nationally last week to throw three complete-game shutouts as she helped Oklahoma State go 3-0 in her starts, including victories over then-No. 16/19 Florida and then-No. 4/4 Washington. Over her 21 innings she gave up just six hits and two walks while totaling 18 strikeouts and limited hitters to a .090 batting average.
- OU's Tiare Jennings had nine RBIs during Week 3 which pushed her into second place in Big 12 history for career RBIs (262). Former Sooner Jocelyn Alo (2018-2022) ranks first in the league record books with 323.
- Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.
- This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
- The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-11. All 10 teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.
- ESPN and FOX Sports selected nine league games for national broadcasts this season, including the 2024 Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship Final with a 6:30 p.m. CT start time on ESPN2 on Saturday, May 11. -  Ailana Agbayani helped BYU to four wins at the Mary Nutter Classic while hitting .600. The shortstop finished the week as one of the tournament's leading run scorers, totaling 10 across the Cougars' five games.
-  UCF's Angelina DeVoe leads all league pitchers after three weeks with a .102 opponent batting average.
-  Houston graduate Kennedy Thomas has seven multi-hit games after three weeks. She needs one more to tie her mark for most multi-hit games in a season (eight in 2022). Thomas has 24 in her career.
-  Karlie Charles' 8.1 innings pitched in her outing against Virginia are the most by a Cyclone this season. Charles allowed just four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts.
-  Kansas' six-game winning streak is the Jayhawks' longest since Feb. 21-29, 2020. The streak includes a 1-0 victory over then-No. 18/17 Texas A&M.
-  Oklahoma is set to play its inaugural games at the brand new Love's Field this week. The Sooners will make their debut in their new home on an NCAA-record 67 game winning streak. OU returns home on a 19.1 scoreless inning streak after outscoring its opponents at the Mary Nutter Classic 43-5.

-  OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
-  Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
-  Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
-  The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason All-Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
