LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

FELTON FINDING HER GROOVE

- Junior right-hander Kaitlyn Felton has enjoyed a resurgent beginning to her 2024 campaign on the heels of a '23 season that saw her post a season-high 3.80 ERA in 77.1 innings of work. In two starts during UCF's Knights Classic Tournament March 1-3 against Princeton and Kennesaw State, Felton tossed four innings of three-hit ball in UCF's 10-2 five-inning win over Princeton March 1 before throwing her third career seveninning complete game against Kennesaw State March 3.
- In stifling the Owls, Felton recorded her second career start with at least 7 innings and 2 or fewer hits allowed, and the junior compiled a 1.91 ERA and a .193 batting average-against in 11 innings of work throughout the weekend, all three marks representing staff-bests in the tournament.
- Entering the Knights' matchup against Stetson, Felton's five wins rank tied for 78th-most in the nation, as well as tied for sixth in the Big 12. • Through her first 7 appearances (6 starts) spanning 31.2 IP (second-most on the team) this spring, Felton has compiled a 2.65 ERA (12 ER)
- accompanied by 21 strikeouts, a .264 batting average-against, one complete game and five wins.
- Her 2.65 ERA and .264 batting average-against both represent single-season career-bests thus far, and with her next win will tie her seasonhigh of six she achieved during her freshman 2022 campaign.
- The Valrico, Florida, native notched at least four punchouts in three of her first four outings this season, and limited the then-No. 5 Tennessee Lady Vols to two runs in 2.1 innings in California Feb. 24. She also whiffed a season-high five batters in her first appearance in the Mary Nutter against then-No. 18 Mississippi State Feb. 22, yielding just two runs in four innings of work.
- Felton's strong California showing comes on the heels of her 6.1-inning season debut against Seattle Feb. 9. combining with junior left-hander **Ava Justman** to produce UCF's first shutout win of the new season by a 5-0 final score.

FRESHMAN FIREWORKS

- Freshman infielder Sierra Humphreys has wasted no time taking advantage of early opportunities in head coach Cindy Ball-Malone's lineup, most recently putting together the most productive two-game span in her young collegiate career during the weekend Knights Classic. In her two starts against Princeton and Kennesaw State, Humphreys was a perfect 5-for-5 at the plate, adding 3 runs scored, 13B, 1 HR, 6 RBI, 10 total bases, 1 BB and 4 stolen bases in 4 attempts.
- Against Princeton March 2, Humphreys hit her first collegiate home run, a two-run shot on an 0-2 count in the bottom of the first inning before swatting her first career triple to clear the bases an inning later, giving the infielder 5 RBI through two innings and aiding the Knights in erasing an early 3-0 first-inning deficit. The contest gave Humphreys her first career multi-extra-base hit game.
- With her perfect 4-for-4 showing in stolen bases over the weekend, Humphreys also pushed her season total to six bags in six tries, tied for the fifth-most steals in the Big 12 Conference and two behind teammate **Johneisha Rowe**'s season total of eight.
- Entering the team's Wednesday matchup against Stetson, Humphreys is hitting .433/.469/.667 (13-for-30) with 9 runs scored, 2 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 20 total bases. 1 BB. 11 RBI and 6 stolen bases.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS (PITCHING STAFF)

- The Knights' 11-7 record through their first 18 games has been bolstered by a handful of other dominant pitching performances in addition to Felton. Returning senior Sarah Willis also enjoyed an effective start to her 2024 campaign, highlighted by weekend in her return to her native California Feb. 22-24, recording a 2.56 ERA in a team-high 13.2 innings pitched, yielding only five earned runs and striking out a team-best 14 in her three appearances (one start) against three top-20 opponents in then-No. 18 Mississippi State, then-No. 8 Missouri and then-No. 5 Tennessee.
- · Against the eighth-ranked Tigers, Willis threw a season-high-tying six innings and struck out a season-best eight hitters, one shy of tying her career high of nine she achieved a season ago against Fresno State during the 2023 Judi Garman Classic hosted by Cal State Fullerton. Her season total of 40 strikeouts entering the Knights' matchup against Stetson also represents a share of fifth-most of any pitcher in the Big 12 thus far, and almost doubles her strikeout total of 21 through her first nine pitching appearances last season.
- Fellow senior hurler **Angelina DeVo**e has enjoyed a dominant beginning to her 2024 season as well, turning in three stingy appearances throughout the Knights' weekend action at the 2024 Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic hosted in her home state of California, yielding just one run on one hit and one walk accompanied by one strikeout in 3.2 innings of work, including nailing down her first collegiate save in UCF's 4-3 win over San Diego Feb. 24. She limited her opposition to a batting average-against of just .083 while seeing action against the Torreros, Oregon State Beavers and the then-No. 23 Oregon Ducks.
- The Carson, California, native is off to the best start of her now-four-year collegiate career, beginning her season with nine perfect innings accompanied by six strikeouts in her first two-plus appearances against Howard, UConn and Liberty. Her back-to-back appearances of 4 IP both represented the second-longest of her career, after she threw five innings against then-No. 16 Duke during the Clearwater Invitational Feb. 18. 2023, and the southpaw also threw at least four innings in back-to-back appearances for the first time in her collegiate career. DeVoe was also one of just 38 pitchers in NCAA Division I softball with an ERA of 0.00 in at least 8 innings pitched through her first two appearances.

CHLOE KEEPS CRUSHING

 Senior right fielder Chloe Evans enjoyed a strong offensive weekend against the Knights' gauntlet of ranked opponents in California, highlighted by her 2-for-3 showing against the then-No. 8 Missouri Tigers. The Seymour, Wisconsin, native recorded her first multi-XBH game of the season in hitting her third home run and her second double, as well as the ninth multi-XBH game of her three-plus-year career. Her six total bases against

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC. Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

the Tigers also tied her season-high she achieved in UCF's 21-9 rout of the Wisconsin Badgers in Clearwater Feb. 16.

• Evans notched her second three-hit game of the young campaign as well, also coming against a top-25 opponent in the then-No. 23 Oregon Ducks Feb. 22. She came through with a trio of singles, including one in the fifth inning that paved way for her to score UCF's third run of the game and help pull the Knights to within a one-run deficit at 4-3.

• With three home runs, Evans has positioned herself among the Big 12 leaders, sharing 11th place within the conference.

HOME RUN HISTORY

 First baseman Shannon Doherty and utility player Jada Cody both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer Stephanie Best's career total of 71 from 2002-05.

MILESTONE WATCH

- As UCF prepares for its midweek tilt, a handful of Knights have already reached and are approaching significant career milestones. UTL Jada **Cody** claimed sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time doubles list with her 44th in the Knights' 7-2 win over Oregon State Feb. 23, and broke a tie for fifth on the triples list with **Denali Schappacher** (now 10) during the Knights' 11-3 win over Princeton March 2.
- Cody also remains just five doubles shy of tying Jania Shinhoster's (2002-05) career total of 50 for the most in a career in program history.
- Against Princeton March 2, first baseman **Shannon Doherty**'s fourthinning RBI single pushed the veteran infielder past Shinhoster's 140 and into sole possession of third place on the UCF all-time list (now 142).
- Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone can also reach a pair of milestones in her head coaching career this season. The Knights' sixth-year coach will reach 200 wins with UCF with four more victories, as she enters the midweek boasting a 196-87-2 (.690) record in her first five-plus seasons with the Black and Gold. With five more wins. Coach Bear will eclipse the 300 victories mark in her nine-plus-year career (295-203-2, .591)

BROKE OUT THE BATS

- The Knights outscored their competition by an aggregate 62-24 throughout their first eight games, led by eight home runs from Jada Cody (2), Chloe Evans (2), Kennedy Searcy, Stormy Kotzelnick, Shannoi **Doherty** and **Aubrey Evans**. Kotzelnick hit the first home run of her Knights career and the 17th of her collegiate career in the Knights' 3-2 loss to UConn Feb. 10, a solo shot that cleared the center field batter's eye, while Aubrey slugged her first of the season in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin in Clearwater Feb. 16.
- UCF has also kept consistent pressure on its foes on the basepaths as well, as the team's 41 stolen bases lead the Big 12 Conference and rank 16th in the nation. The Knights stole seven bases in their season-opener against Howard Feb. 8 and Princeton March 1, both marking the team's highest single-game stolen base total since the 2019 Knights stole seven bases in a 6-1 road win at the Stetson Hatters March 16.

AWARDS SEASON CAME EARLY

- In the weeks leading up to the commencement of the regular season, a pair of Knights have been recognized with preseason awards and rankings, headlined by UTL Jada Cody's addition to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Preseason Top 50 Watchlist, Cody was also tabbed the No. 89 overall player in the nation on Softball America's preseason top 100 player rankings, as well as the No. 8 overall third baseman by the publication. D1Softball.com recognized Cody on its preseason D100 list as well, pegging the utility player at No. 90 in the
- Fresh off her 2023 AAC Pitcher of the Year season, RHP/OF Sarah Willis was honored as the Knights' representative on the Big 12 Conference's preseason All-Conference team. She also joined Cody on Softball America's preseason top 100, coming in at No. 38 overall and No. 19 among pitchers, as well as D1Softball.com's D100 rankings, at No. 70 in the nation overall.

RANKED MATCHUPS AWAIT

- The Knights' 2024 spring schedule features a plethora of opponents ranked within the Week 1 top 25 polls by USA Today/NFCA Coaches, ESPN/USA Softball, Softball America and D1Softball.com, headlined by a three-game home series against the three-time defending national champion No. 1 Oklahoma Sooners April 26-28. UCF will square off against 10 other ranked foes this season as well, including No. 2 Texas, No. 3 Tennessee, No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 11 Missouri, No. 14 Kentucky, No. 16 Baylor, No. 17 Oregon, No. 19 UCLA, No. 20 South Carolina and No. 22 Northwestern
- · Of the 14 different conferences UCF will meet in 2024, the Knights will also square off against six 2023 conference champions, including four from Power 5 conferences (Oklahoma - Big 12, Tennessee - SEC. Northwestern - Big Ten, UCLA - Pac-12). UCF will also meet the 2023 champions of the Big East (UConn) and the Ivy League (Princeton).

KNIGHTS PICKED FIFTH IN THE BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

- On the heels of its third straight 40-win season, the UCF softball team has been pegged to finish fifth out of 10 programs in its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference this spring. Among the three softball newcomers to the Big 12 Conference, the Knights were ranked the highest, picked above BYU (7th) and Houston (10th), and the softball team's No. 5 preseason ranking represents the second highest for any UCF team in preseason projections by Big 12 coaches thus far, behind only UCF women's tennis' No. 4 preseason
- The three-time defending national champion Oklahoma Sooners, the unanimous favorites, received nine of 10 total first-place votes in the poll en route to their No. 1 selection, with second-place Texas garnering the final first-place vote. The Oklahoma State Cowgirls were picked to finish third, and Baylor was ranked fourth just ahead of the Knights. In rounding out the final five spots in the Big 12's preseason poll, Texas Tech was picked to finish sixth, followed by BYU, Kansas (8th), Iowa State (9th) and Houston.

A STAR-STUDDED TRANSFER CLASS

- As announced by D1Softball.com Sept. 5, the Knights' summer 2023 transfer class, which includes junior utility infielder Stormy Kotzelnick. redshirt-senior pitcher/designated player Sona Halajian, and lefthanded pitcher **Ava Justman**, has been ranked the No. 14 such class in the country by the publication entering the spring 2024 campaign. • UCF's newest transfer class slots in ahead of Houston (No. 15) on
- D1Softball's rankings and just behind Florida Atlantic (No. 13), Oklahoma State (No. 12) and Texas A&M (No. 11) in the first release of the nublication's top 15 poll
- In Kotzelnick, the Knights landed a former All-Sun Belt Second Team, All-Louisiana First Team, NFCA All-Central Region Third Team, and Sun Belt Conference Academic Honor Roll selection. The Carmel, Indiana, native hit for a combined .323/.381/.566 (108-for-334) line with 16 home runs, 189 total bases and 79 RBI in two seasons with the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns after taking a redshirt in her lone season with Washington.
- Halaiian comes to the Knights on the heels of three seasons with the California Golden Bears, where she compiled a career 4.18 ERA in 303 innings pitched with 204 strikeouts and a pair of shutouts, as well as a .292/.387/.553 (86-for-295) line with 22 home runs, 163 total bases and 68 RBI spanning her last three seasons. She was tabbed as a Second Team All-Pac-12 and a First Team All-Region selection in 2022 as a redshirt-sophomore, and threw 1.2 scoreless innings against the eventual-national champion Oklahoma Sooners during the 2023 NCAA Norman Regional.
- Justman also enjoyed an impressive debut season in her first year with the Wisconsin Badgers in 2021, allowing only four earned runs in 15.2 innings of work in relief, translating to an ERA of just 1.79 accompanied by 13 strikeouts. She took on an increased workload during her sophomore 2022 slate, throwing 62.1 innings spanning 17 appearances, including 14 starts. She posted a 3.93 ERA in her first multiwin season, recording a season-high 39 strikeouts and her first three collegiate complete games against Utah, Southern Utah and UCF.

INTERNATIONAL EXPLOITS

- The Knights were well-represented on the global stage throughout the offseason, as UTL Katie Burge, LHP Ava Justman, UTL Jada Cody, UTL Samantha Delhoyo, head coach Cindy Ball-Malone, and assistant coach Jenn Salling each participated with teams around the world.
- Burge returned to the Great Britain Women's National Team for the sixth straight season, competing against, among others, **Ball-Malone**'s Team USA in Group A play for a spot in this summer's WBSC (World Baseball Softball Confederation) Softball World Cup Finals.
- Cody also donned the stars and stripes last summer, returning to Japan in August to compete with Team USA in the Japan All-Star Series for the second time in her collegiate career.
- Justman returned to the Israeli Women's National Team roster for the third consecutive summer to partake in competition during the International Softball Championship Canada Cup. She met Salling and Team Canada during the tournament, and thanks to Canada's performance, **Salling** and the team will also return to Italy this summer to compete in the WBSC Finals.
- **Delhoyo**, after already competing with the Puerto Rico junior national team in 2021, made her debut with the National Team in November 2023, helping the team win the silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile.
