541及 The Big 12 holds three of the top four spots in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma at No. I, Texas at No. 2 and Oklahoma State at No. 4. Baylor rose to No. 19.
$3 \sqrt[115]{ }$ In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Texas is No. I, Oklahoma is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 7 and Baylor is No. 14. This is the first time UT has held the top spot since April 2006.
$2 \$ 11$ The Big I2 is the only league to have three teams in the top seven in both the USA Today/ NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.
In the RPI rankings released on March 4 the Big 12 ranks third in RPI and has $90 \%$ of the league ranked inside the top 70 . Texas is No. 4, Oklahoma is No. 6, Oklahoma State is No. IO, Baylor is No. 26, Kansas is No. 35, Texas Tech is No. 38, Houston is No. 46, UCF is No. 62 and BYU is No. 70.
27415 The Conference has the second-highest winning percentage (.770) of any league entering the fifth week of the season.
51 41 League play begins Thursday with BYU taking on Texas Tech for the Cougars' first Conference game while Houston hosts Texas for its Big I2 debut and UCF welcomes Kansas to Orlando for the Knights' inaugural Conference matchup.
3, 415 Baylor and Oklahoma State are set for a top-20 showdown this weekend in Waco. All three games can be seen on Big 12 Now on ESPN + .
2411 Iowa State's Angelina Allen (Player) and Texas' Teagan Kavan (Pitcher) earned Big 12 softball awards for the fourth week of the season (Feb. 26-March 3). Allen is ISU's first player of the week since Sami Williams secured the honor March 2, 2021 while Kavan is UT's fifth award winner this season.
Allen tallied 13 hits in her 19 at-bats for a .684 batting average with eight of her hits being for extra bases. The 2023 Academic All-Big 12 First Team member had her second multi-homer game of the season and recorded multiple hits in all five of her games. The junior avoided striking out and drew two walks while slugging l.526. Allen led the Big 12 in hits, runs scored (8), home runs (4), doubles (4) and total bases (29) for the week.

Kavan tossed her second career seven-inning complete shutout as the freshman held Texas State to just two hits while she matched her career high of nine strikeouts in a I-O UT victory. Her .I21 opponent batting average was the lowest by any Big 12 pitcher who faced 30 or more batters throughout the week. Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.
This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
$2 \sqrt{211}$ The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-II. All IO teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.

Baylor's Lexie Warncke got her first career start in BU's third game against Morgan State and tossed a career-high six strikeouts.
Violet Zavodnik led BYU with a .500 batting average this week, posting two home runs and one double for an extra-base hit in each of the Cougars' three games at the Capital Classic.
UCF's Sierra Humphreys went a perfect 5-for-5 at the plate in her two games against Princeton and Kennesaw State, including the freshman's first collegiate triple and home run in a five-RBI showing against Princeton.
Houston's 22 runs in its second game against Texas A\&M Commerce is tied for the second most in the program's single-game history, matching its 22 against UConn on April 9, 2017. The program record is 25 runs, set against Texas Southern on April 23, 2003. The win marked Head Coach Kristin Vesely's 200th at the helm of the Cougars.
Iowa State's Angelina Allen enters the week leading the league for the season in batting average (.543), hits (38) and total bases (70).

Kansas enters the week on a nine-game winning streak. The last time KU had a winning streak of more than nine was from March 7-22, 2015, when the Jayhawks won 10 straight.

Oklahoma's weekend attendance mark hit I3,350 with a third sellout on Sunday, establishing a program record in the Sooners' debut weekend at Love's Field.
Micaela Wark tallied a hit in all four of OSU's contests last week, including launching home runs in three of the four games played.
Texas has outscored its opponents 170-20 entering the fifth week of the season, which is the highest runs scored and the least amount of runs given up by a Big 12 team so far this season.
Texas Tech's Maddie Kuehl improved to 5-3 after striking out nine batters in a 9-I victory over New Mexico State, which set a career-high in strikeouts for the junior. Kuehl allowed just two hits and one run through the 5.0-inning outing.
OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
2 Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason AllAmericans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
