LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

SERIES ONE, SERIES WON

The UCF softball team etched another chapter in program history over the weekend, winning its first series in Big 12 Conference play, two games to one, over the visiting Kansas Jayhawks. The Knights prevailed by 7-1 and 3-2 (8 inn.) final scores, respectively, in the series' first two games before dropping game three of the set, 1-0. The teams' series finale represented just the second time in 22 games this season the Knights suffered a shutout loss, after the team fell to then-No. 5 Tennessee, 3-0, during the 2024 Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, California, Feb. 24. In taking the series from Kansas, the Black and Gold snapped the Jayhawks' 10-game win streak and put an end to Kansas left-hander **Kasey Hamilton's** 28-inning scoreless streak she brought with her to Orlando. UCF also clinched a series win over a Jayhawks team ranked No. 34 in the NCAA's RPI rankings through games played March 12.

AMONG THE BIG 12'S BEST IN WEEK ONE

The Black and Gold's series victory over Kansas was powered by their dominant efforts in the circle in all three games, recording a stifling 1.27 ERA in 22 innings of work while allowing only four total runs and limiting the Jayhawks to a .208 batting average-against. Right-handers **Kaitlyn Felton** and **Sarah Willis** spearheaded the charge, combining to allow just three runs in 15 innings pitched including two complete games. Willis struck out a career-high-tying nine Jayhawks in her first seven-inning complete game of the season Friday, while Felton spun a career-high eight innings in the Knights' 3-2 win Saturday, representing the squad's first walk-off victory of the spring. In spite of the team's loss in the series finale Sunday afternoon, UCF's pitching staff enjoyed a third straight dazzling performance, as the combination of **Sona Halajian**, **Angelina DeVoe** and **Grace Jewell** yielded only one run on one hit, a leadoff single in the top of the 2nd inning. Throughout the first weekend of conference play, the Knights' four total runs allowed were good for second-fewest in the Big 12, one shy of No. 1 Oklahoma's three, translating to a 1.27 ERA that ranked second-lowest to the Sooners' 1.24. UCF's 22 innings pitched also marked the most in the conference over the weekend, tied with No. 10 Baylor.

WILLIS' HISTORIC START

In throwing her first seven-inning complete game of the season in the series-opener against Kansas March 8, right-hander **Sarah Willis** accomplished a feat that hadn't been achieved by a Knight in close to 10 years. The senior right-hander also drove in two runs at the plate in UCF's 7-1 victory, making her the first Knights pitcher to throw a complete game and record multiple RBI in the same game since 2014. **Lena Springer** (2014) last accomplished the feat in the Black and Gold's 12-5 win at UConn May 4, allowing five runs (four earned) with six strikeouts in seven innings pitched while also going 2-for-4 with a run scored and a two-run double in the fifth inning. Newly-minted Knights Hall-of-Famer **Shelby Turner** (2013-16) also hit both marks in the same game in 2014, yielding two runs on three hits with 11 strikeouts in seven innings while also going 1-for-2 with a walk and a two-run triple in the fifth inning of the Knights' 4-2 win over Jacksonville at home March 5.

KNIGHTS ON MILESTONE WATCH

A pair of Knights are on immediate record watch as the team's series in Stillwater begins, as utility player **Jada Cody** brings with her a career doubles total of 48 into Friday's action. With three more two-baggers, Cody will break the UCF all-time career doubles record of 50, currently held by **Janis Shinoster** (2002-05). Cody also broke a tie for fifth place on UCF's career triples list with **Denali Schappacher** (2018-22) (now 10) during the Knights' 11-3 win over Princeton March 2, and enters the weekend series tied for fourth on the all-time list with **Natalie Land** (2009-12). Head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone** is also quickly approaching a pair of career milestones. The Knights' sixth-year leader needs just one more victory to eclipse 200 in her Knights career, and two more wins to reach the 300-win milestone in her nine-plus-year head coaching career. Ball-Malone enters the series against the No. 4 Cowgirls with a 199-88-2 (.692) record at in her five-plus seasons with UCF, and a 298-204-2 (.593) record in her nine-plus seasons as a Division I head coach between UCF and Boise State (2015-18). First baseman **Shannon Doherty** boasts a career hit total of 185 entering the weekend series, in need of 15 to become the 12th player in program history to record 200 hits in a Knights uniform. Against Princeton March 2, Doherty's fourth-inning RBI single pushed the veteran infielder past Shinoster's career RBI total of 140 and into sole possession of third place on the UCF all-time RBI list (now 145).

FELTON GOES THE (EVEN LONGER) DISTANCE

UCF right-hander **Kaitlyn Felton** recorded one of the stronger starts of her two-plus-year career in the Knights' 3-2 eight-inning walk-off win over Kansas March 9, as her eighth innings pitched marked a personal single-game career-high. The right-hander struck out four throughout her afternoon outing, which represented her eighth career complete game and her second in her previous three appearances after the junior allowed one run in seven innings of work against the Kennesaw State Owls during UCF's Knights Classic tournament March 3. Throughout the Knights' eight-game homestand March 1-10, Felton threw a team-leading 20 innings while posting a team-best 1.75 ERA (5 ER) with 11 strikeouts, two complete games, one save and a batting average-against of just .214.

CHLOE COMES UP CLUTCH

Right fielder **Chloe Evans** came through for her team March 9 against Kansas in the bottom of the eighth inning, lining a game-winning, walk-off RBI double down the right field line. The timely hit clinched the Knights' first Big 12 Conference series win in program history, and marked Evans' third walk-off hit as a member of the Knights. The Seymour, Wisconsin, native notched a pair of walk-off hits in 2023, a two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh inning vs. Boise State (W, 9-8, Feb. 10) and an eighth-inning RBI single vs. South Florida (W, 2-1, April 21).

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10, 2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY STRONG

• Against Kansas Friday evening, the Knights extended a decade-long streak of beginning conference play with a win. UCF has now won its conference-opener in each of the last 10 seasons dating back to March 22, 2014's 1-0 win over Memphis (excluding the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season), and the Black and Gold last year earned a top-25 win over the then-No. 22 Wichita State Shockers by a 3-1 score March 24 to begin their final conference season as a member of the American Athletic Conference.

FRESHMAN FIREWORKS

• Freshman infielder **Sierra Humphreys** has wasted no time taking advantage of early opportunities in head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone's** lineup, most recently putting together the most productive three-game span in her young collegiate career during the Knights Classic tournament and in UCF's midweek tilt against the Hatters. In her three starts against Princeton, Kennesaw State and Stetson March 2-6, Humphreys went 7-for-8 with one triple, one home run, four runs scored, 12 total bases, one walk, six RBI and four stolen bases in four tries.

• Against Princeton March 2, Humphreys hit her first collegiate home run, a two-run shot on an 0-2 count in the bottom of the first inning before swatting her first career triple to clear the bases an inning later, giving the infielder 5 RBI through two innings and aiding the Knights in erasing an early 3-0 first-inning deficit. The contest gave Humphreys her first career multi-extra-base hit game.

• With her perfect 4-for-4 showing in stolen bases over the homestand, Humphreys also pushed her season total to six bags in six tries, tied for the ninth-most steals in the Big 12 Conference and four behind teammate **Johnheisha Rowe's** season total of 10.

• Entering the team's weekend matchups against No. 4 Oklahoma State, Humphreys is hitting .432/.475/.622 (16-for-37) with 11 runs scored, two 2B, one 3B, one HR, 23 total bases, two BB, 11 RBI and six stolen bases.

HOME RUN HISTORY

• First baseman **Shannon Doherty** and utility player **Jada Cody** both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin Feb. 16, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer **Stephanie Best's** career total of 71 from 2002-05. Cody hit her 35th career home run in the sixth inning of the Knights' 7-1 win over Kansas March 8.

RANKED MATCHUPS AWAIT

• The Knights' 2024 spring schedule features a plethora of opponents ranked within the Week 1 top 25 polls by USA Today/NFCA Coaches, ESPN/USA Softball, Softball America and D1Softball.com, headlined by a three-game home series against the three-time defending national champion No. 1 Oklahoma Sooners April 26-28. UCF will square off against 10 other ranked foes this season as well, including No. 2 Texas, No. 3 Tennessee, No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 11 Missouri, No. 14 Kentucky, No. 16 Baylor, No. 17 Oregon, No. 19 UCLA, No. 20 South Carolina and No. 22 Northwestern.

• Of the 14 different conferences UCF will meet in 2024, the Knights will also square off against six 2023 conference champions, including four from Power 5 conferences (Oklahoma - Big 12, Tennessee - SEC, Northwestern - Big Ten, UCLA - Pac-12). UCF will also meet the 2023 champions of the Big East (UConn) and the Ivy League (Princeton).

KNIGHTS PICKED FIFTH IN THE BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

• On the heels of its third straight 40-win season, the UCF softball team has been pegged to finish fifth out of 10 programs in its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference this spring.

• Among the three softball newcomers to the Big 12 Conference, the Knights were ranked the highest, picked above BYU (7th) and Houston (10th), and the softball team's No. 5 preseason ranking represents the second highest for any UCF team in preseason projections by Big 12 coaches thus far, behind only UCF women's tennis' No. 4 preseason ranking.

• The three-time defending national champion Oklahoma Sooners, the unanimous favorites, received nine of 10 total first-place votes in the poll en route to their No. 1 selection, with second-place Texas garnering the final first-place vote. The Oklahoma State Cowgirls were picked to finish third, and Baylor was ranked fourth just ahead of the Knights. In rounding out the final five spots in the Big 12's preseason poll, Texas Tech was picked to finish sixth, followed by BYU, Kansas (8th), Iowa State (9th) and Houston.

A STAR-STUDDIED TRANSFER CLASS

• As announced by D1Softball.com Sept. 5, the Knights' summer 2023 transfer class, which includes junior utility infielder **Stormy Kotzelnick**, redshirt-senior pitcher/designated player **Sona Halajian**, and left-handed pitcher **Ava Justman**, has been ranked the No. 14 such class in the country by the publication entering the spring 2024 campaign.

• UCF's newest transfer class slots in ahead of Houston (No. 15) on D1Softball's rankings and just behind Florida Atlantic (No. 13), Oklahoma State (No. 12) and Texas A&M (No. 11) in the first release of the publication's top 15 poll.

• In **Kotzelnick**, the Knights landed a former All-Sun Belt Second Team, All-Louisiana First Team, NFCA All-Central Region Third Team, and Sun Belt Conference Academic Honor Roll selection. The Carmel, Indiana, native hit for a combined .323/.381/.566 (108-for-334) line with 16 home runs, 189 total bases and 79 RBI in two seasons with the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns after taking a redshirt in her lone season with Washington.

• **Halajian** comes to the Knights on the heels of three seasons with the California Golden Bears, where she compiled a career 4.18 ERA in 303 innings pitched with 204 strikeouts and a pair of shutouts, as well as a .292/.387/.553 (86-for-295) line with 22 home runs, 163 total bases and 68 RBI spanning her last three seasons. She was tabbed as a Second Team All-Pac-12 and a First Team All-Region selection in 2022 as a redshirt-sophomore, and threw 1.2 scoreless innings against the eventual-national champion Oklahoma Sooners during the 2023 NCAA Norman Regional.

• **Justman** also enjoyed an impressive debut season in her first year with the Wisconsin Badgers in 2021, allowing only four earned runs in 15.2 innings of work in relief, translating to an ERA of just 1.79 accompanied by 13 strikeouts. She took on an increased workload during her sophomore 2022 slate, throwing 62.1 innings spanning 17 appearances, including 14 starts. She posted a 3.93 ERA in her first multi-win season, recording a season-high 39 strikeouts and her first three collegiate complete games against Utah, Southern Utah and UCF.

AWARDS SEASON CAME EARLY

• In the weeks leading up to the commencement of the regular season, a pair of Knights have been recognized with preseason awards and rankings, headlined by UTL **Jada Cody's** addition to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Preseason Top 50 Watchlist. Cody was also tabbed the No. 89 overall player in the nation on Softball America's preseason top 100 player rankings, as well as the No. 8 overall third baseman by the publication. D1Softball.com recognized Cody on its preseason D100 list as well, pegging the utility player at No. 90 in the nation overall.

• Fresh off her 2023 AAC Pitcher of the Year season, RHP/OF **Sarah Willis** was honored as the Knights' representative on the Big 12 Conference's preseason All-Conference team. She also joined Cody on Softball America's preseason top 100, coming in at No. 38 overall and No. 19 among pitchers, as well as D1Softball.com's D100 rankings, at No. 70 in the nation overall.

INTERNATIONAL EXPLOITS

• The Knights were well-represented on the global stage throughout the offseason, as UTL **Katie Burge**, LHP **Ava Justman**, UTL **Jada Cody**, UTL **Samantha Delhoyo**, head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone**, and assistant coach **Jenn Salling** each participated with teams around the world.

• **Burge** returned to the Great Britain Women's National Team for the sixth straight season, competing against, among others, **Ball-Malone's** Team USA in Group A play for a spot in this summer's WBSC (World Baseball Softball Confederation) Softball World Cup Finals.

• **Cody** also donned the stars and stripes last summer, returning to Japan in August to compete with Team USA in the Japan All-Star Series for the second time in her collegiate career.

• **Justman** returned to the Israeli Women's National Team roster for the third consecutive summer to partake in competition during the International Softball Championship Canada Cup. She met **Salling** and Team Canada during the tournament, and thanks to Canada's performance, **Salling** and the team will also return to Italy this summer to compete in the WBSC Finals.

• **Delhoyo**, after already competing with the Puerto Rico junior national team in 2021, made her debut with the National Team in November 2023, helping the team win the silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile. Puerto Rico entered the tournament with a world ranking of No. 3 by the WBSC, and earned wins over two top-10 opponents in No. 5 Canada and No. 7 Mexico en route to its silver medal finish.

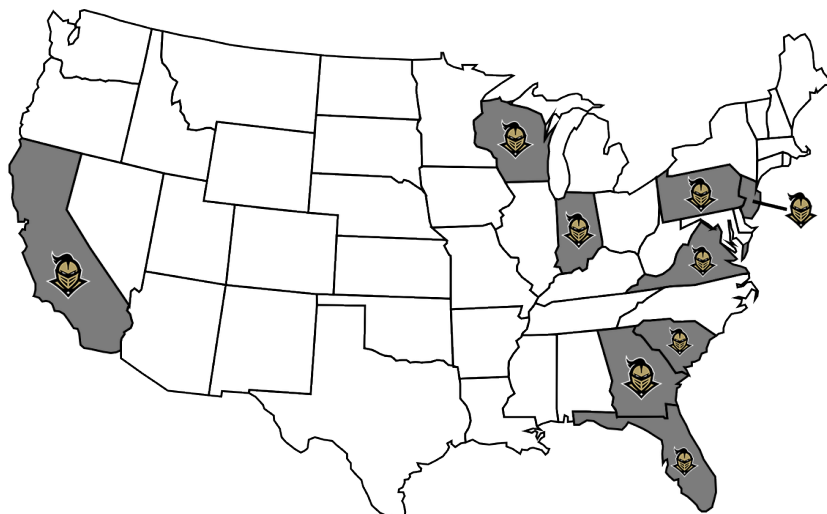

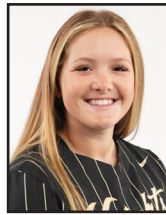

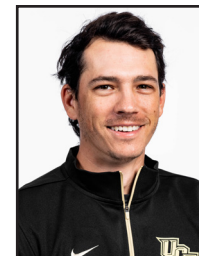
