Oklahoma's Cydney Sanders (Player) and Baylor's RyLee Crandall (Pitcher) collected Big 12 softball accolades for the fifth week of the season (March 4-10). Sanders was also named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA DI Player of the Week.

5at1 Sanders enjoyed a weekend that saw her hit four home runs in seven at-bats while driving in nine runs. The junior drew five walks during a $4-0$ week for Oklahoma that included defeating Texas A\&M-Commerce and sweeping lowa State. Sanders finished with a .714 batting average, a .833 on-base percentage and a 2.571 slugging percentage to earn her first career Big 12 weekly award.
5, Crandall made three appearances in the circle this week and finished with a 0.64 ERA in II innings of work. The spotlight performance for the sophomore was her complete game one-hit shutout of then-No. 4 Oklahoma State in a 2-0 Baylor victory. She took a perfect game into the fifth inning and then retired the last nine batters in a row.

Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.

This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school. ball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-II. All 10 teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.

UCF took its debut Big 12 series 2-I over Kansas. The Knights' pitching staff recorded a 1.27 ERA in 22 innings and had two complete games throughout the weekend while striking out 14 and limiting Kansas to a 208 batting average.
Houston's 12-10 win over then-No. 2 Texas is the Cougars' highest-ranked victory in program history.
Iowa State has homered in 16 of its first 22 games this season.
Kansas' Kasey Hamilton tossed a complete game shutout in a $1-0$ win over UCF. Hamilton struck out three batters while allowing just one walk.
Oklahoma's Kierston Deal enters Week 6 on a 22-scoreless inning streak.
Oklahoma State is now 7-I in Big I2 opening series in the Kenny Gajewski era.
In 23 games so far this season, Reese Atwood has already driven in 40 runs, six shy of tying for ninth on Texas' single-season records.

Texas Tech's RPI ranking of 26 entering the week is the Red Raiders' highest since the 2019 season.
OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Lowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.
The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason AllAmericans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
