LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

THE STAFF STEPS UP

- Despite the UCF softball team's trio of losses to No. 2 Texas in Orlando March 22-24, the Knights pitching staff enjoyed a strong overall weekend against one of the most prolific offensive teams in the country. Entering the series, Texas had scored an aggregate 40 runs in its previous four games and had scored an average of 8.89 runs per game throughout the spring, good for fourth in the nation.
- The Longhorns also ranked first in NCAA Division I softball in team batting average (.403), third in on-base percentage (.479), fourth in slugging percentage (.673) and ninth in home runs per game (1.50) prior to their arrival in Orlando.
- The combination of **Angelina DeVoe**, **Grace Jewell**, **Sona Halajian**, **Katelyn Cochran**, **Ava Justman**, **Sarah Willis** and **Kaitlyn Felton**, meanwhile, held Texas to just 12 total runs throughout the series, yielding a .284 batting average-against, a .344 opposing on-base percentage, a .383 opposing slugging percentage, and one home run in the three games.
- UCF's pitching corps also limited the Longhorns to five or fewer runs in three consecutive games, marking just the second time this spring Texas had been held to five or fewer runs per game over a three-game span (Feb. 24-28 vs. then-No. 9 Stanford, Louisiana and Texas State).
- Cochran threw a team-high five innings between her two appearances, allowing four hits and one walk without surrendering a run while striking out three. Justman and Jewell also impressed in their respective Saturday and Sunday relief appearances, spinning four combined scoreless frames with two hits allowed and one strikeout.

FINEST IN THE FIELD

- The Black and Gold's pitching efforts were bolstered throughout the weekend series against No. 2 Texas by another strong display by their defense, which committed just one error and turned a trio of double plays in the three-game set. Entering the series against Texas Tech, UCF's .984 fielding percentage ranks first in the Big 12 and second in the nation, trailing only the Florida Gators' .985 mark.
- The team's five total double plays turned in conference play also rank second-most in the Big 12, only to Kansas' six. In conference play, the Knights' 183 putouts rank tied for second in the Big 12 with Oklahoma State, trailing Kansas' 188, and their 93 assists lead the Big 12.

KNIGHTS ON MILESTONE WATCH

- A pair of Knights are on immediate record watch as the team's series against at Texas Tech begins, as utility player **Jada Cody** brings with her a career doubles total of 48 into Thursday's action. With three more two-baggers, Cody will break the UCF all-time career doubles record of 50, currently held by **Janina Shinhoster** (2002-05). Cody also broke a tie for fourth place on UCF's career triples list with **Natalie Land** (2009-12) (now 11) during the Knights' 6-4 loss to No. 4 Oklahoma State March 17, and enters the weekend two triples shy of tying **Stephanie Best** and **Janina Shinhoster's** respective career totals of 13 for second most on the UCF all-time triples list.
- Head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone** is also quickly approaching a pair of career milestones. The Knights' sixth-year leader needs just one more victory to eclipse 200 in her Knights career, and two more wins to reach the 300-win milestone in her nine-plus-year head coaching career. Ball-Malone enters the series against the No. 2 Longhorns with a 199-94-2 (.678) record at in her five-plus seasons with UCF, and a 298-210-2 (.586) record in her nine-plus seasons as a Division I head coach between UCF and Boise State (2015-18).
- First baseman **Shannon Doherty** boasts a career hit total of 187 entering the weekend series, in need of 13 to become the 12th player in program history to record 200 hits in a Knights uniform. Against Princeton March 2, Doherty's fourth-inning RBI single pushed the veteran infielder past Shinhoster's career RBI total of 140 and into sole possession of third place on the UCF all-time RBI list (now 143).

HALAJIAN'S HEROICS

- Knights right-handed pitcher/designated player **Sona Halajian** produced a strong showing in the Knights' series finale against the No. 4 Oklahoma State Cowgirls March 17, throwing four innings of one-run ball in relief while also hitting a key three-run home run in the top of the sixth inning off of Oklahoma State right-hander **Lexi Kilfoyl** that trimmed the Cowgirls' lead to 5-4 at the time.
- Halajian's home run represented just the third long ball allowed by Kilfoyl through her first 64.1 innings pitched this spring, and prior to the three run shot, Kilfoyl had yielded just one earned run in her previous 50 innings pitched dating back to her seven-inning complete game shutout on the road at No. 16 Florida Feb. 19.

JAS FINDS HER GROOVE

- UCF shortstop **Jasmine Williams** hit her first home run of the season and the 14th of her career in the Knights' 10-4 loss to No. 4 Oklahoma State March 16, a game-tying two-run shot in the fifth inning that followed designated player **Stormy Kotzelnick's** two-run shot.
- In addition to representing her first home run of the spring, Williams' long ball also marked her second game-tying home run in the fifth inning or later against a top five nationally-ranked opponent in her Knights career. During the 2023 Judi Garman Classic hosted by Cal State Fullerton, Williams hit a game-tying solo home run in the top of the sixth inning against then-No. 2 UCLA March 3.

STORM WARNING

- Knights designated player **Stormy Kotzelnick** slugged her second home run of the season in the Knights' 10-4 loss to No. 4 Oklahoma State March 16, a two-run shot that ignited a four-run rally that tied the game in the fifth inning.
- Entering UCF's series against Texas Tech, Kotzelnick is hitting .333/.385/.458 (8-for-24) with three runs scored, four RBI, one home run and 11 total bases in her last eight games.

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10, 2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

• Kotzelnick has also excelled in the Knights' first four space games of the season, hitting .455/.500/.818 (5-for-11) with three runs scored, one double, one home run, five RBI and nine total bases when donning the Citronauts' black SpaceU uniforms. She also came through with a timely sixth-inning two-run single that tied the game against Kansas March 9, setting the table for UCF's eventual 3-2 walk-off win in eight innings.

SERIES ONE, SERIES WON

• The UCF softball team etched another chapter in program history March 8-10, winning its first series in Big 12 Conference play, two games to one, over the visiting Kansas Jayhawks. The Knights prevailed by 7-1 and 3-2 (8 inn.) final scores, respectively, in the series' first two games before dropping game three of the set, 1-0. The teams' series finale represented just the second time in 22 games this season the Knights suffered a shutout loss, after the team fell to then-No. 5 Tennessee, 3-0, during the 2024 Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, California, Feb. 24.

• In taking the series from Kansas, the Black and Gold snapped the Jayhawks' 10-game win streak and put an end to Kansas left-hander **Kasey Hamilton's** 28-inning scoreless streak she brought with her to Orlando. UCF also clinched a series win over a Jayhawks team ranked No. 34 in the NCAA's RPI rankings through games played March 12.

AMONG THE BIG 12'S BEST IN WEEK ONE

• The Black and Gold's series victory over Kansas was powered by their dominant efforts in the circle in all three games, recording a stifling 1.27 ERA in 22 innings of work while allowing only four total runs and limiting the Jayhawks to a .208 batting average-against.

• Right-handers **Kaitlyn Felton** and **Sarah Willis** spearheaded the charge, combining to allow just three runs in 15 innings pitched including two complete games. Willis struck out a career-high-tying nine Jayhawks in her first seven-inning complete game of the season Friday, while Felton spun a career-high eight innings in the Knights' 3-2 win Saturday, representing the squad's first walk-off victory of the spring.

• In spite of the team's loss in the series finale March 10, UCF's pitching staff enjoyed a third straight dazzling performance, as the combination of **Sona Halajian**, **Angelina DeVoe** and **Grace Jewell** yielded only one run on one hit, a leadoff single in the top of the 2nd inning.

• Throughout the first weekend of conference play, the Knights' four total runs allowed were good for second-fewest in the Big 12, one shy of No. 1 Oklahoma's three, translating to a 1.27 ERA that ranked second-lowest to the Sooners' 1.24. UCF's 22 innings pitched also marked the most in the conference over the weekend, tied with No. 10 Baylor.

WILLIS' HISTORIC START

• In throwing her first seven-inning complete game of the season in the series-opener against Kansas March 8, right-hander **Sarah Willis** accomplished a feat that hadn't been achieved by a Knight in close to 10 years. The senior right-hander also drove in two runs at the plate in UCF's 7-1 victory, making her the first Knights pitcher to throw a complete game and record multiple RBI in the same game since 2014.

Lena Springer (2014) last accomplished the feat in the Black and Gold's 12-5 win at UConn May 4, allowing five runs (four earned) with six strikeouts in seven innings pitched while also going 2-for-4 with a run scored and a two-run double in the fifth inning. Newly-minted Knights Hall-of-Famer **Shelby Turner** (2013-16) also hit both marks in the same game in 2014, yielding two runs on three hits with 11 strikeouts in seven innings while also going 1-for-2 with a walk and a two-run triple in the fifth inning of the Knights' 4-2 win over Jacksonville at home March 5.

FELTON GOES THE (EVEN LONGER) DISTANCE

• UCF right-hander **Kaitlyn Felton** recorded one of the stronger starts of her two-plus-year career in the Knights' 3-2 eight-inning walk-off win over Kansas March 9, as her eight innings pitched marked a personal single-game career-high. The right-hander struck out four throughout her afternoon outing, which represented her eighth career complete game and her second in her previous three appearances after the junior allowed one run in seven innings of work against the Kennesaw State Owls during UCF's Knights Classic tournament March 5.

• Throughout the Knights' eight-game homestand March 1-10, Felton threw a team-leading 20 innings while posting a team-best 1.75 ERA (5 ER) with 11 strikeouts, two complete games, one save and a batting average-against of just .214.

CHLOE COMES UP CLUTCH

• Right fielder **Chloe Evans** came through for her team March 9 against Kansas in the bottom of the eighth inning, lining a game-winning, walk-off RBI double down the right field line. The timely hit clinched the Knights' first Big 12 Conference series win in program history, and marked Evans' third walk-off hit as a member of the Knights. The Seymour, Wisconsin, native notched a pair of walk-off hits in 2023, a two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh inning vs. Boise State (W, 9-8, Feb. 10) and an eighth-inning RBI single vs. South Florida (W, 2-1, April 21).

STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY STRONG

• Against Kansas March 8, the Knights extended a decade-long streak of beginning conference play with a win. UCF has now won its conference-opener in each of the last 10 seasons dating back to March 22, 2014's 1-0 win over Memphis (excluding the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season), and the Black and Gold last year earned a top-25 win over the then-No. 22 Wichita State Shockers by a 3-1 score March 24 to begin their final conference season as a member of the American Athletic Conference.

FRESHMAN FIREWORKS

• Freshman infielder **Sierra Humphreys** has wasted no time taking advantage of early opportunities in head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone's** lineup, most recently putting together the most productive three-game span in her young collegiate career during the Knights Classic tournament and in UCF's midweek tilt against the Hatters March 6. In her three starts against Princeton, Kennesaw State and Stetson March 2-6, Humphreys went 7-for-8 with one triple, one home run, four runs scored, 12 total bases, one walk, six RBI and four stolen bases in four tries.

• Against Princeton March 2, Humphreys hit her first collegiate home run, a two-run shot on an 0-2 count in the bottom of the first inning before swatting her first career triple to clear the bases an inning later, giving the infielder 5 RBI through two innings and aiding the Knights in erasing an early 3-0 first-inning deficit. The contest gave Humphreys her first career multi-extra-base hit game.

• With her perfect 4-for-4 showing in stolen bases over the homestand, Humphreys also pushed her season total to six bags in six tries, four behind teammate **Johnneisha Rowe's** season total of 10.

• Entering the team's weekend matchups against Texas Tech, Humphreys is hitting .375/.412/.521 (18-for-48) with 11 runs scored, two 2B, one 3B, one HR, 25 total bases, two BB, 11 RBI and six stolen bases.

HOMERUN HISTORY

• First baseman **Shannon Doherty** and utility player **Jada Cody** both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin Feb. 16, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer **Stephanie Best's** career total of 71 from 2002-05. Cody hit her 35th career home run in the sixth inning of the Knights' 7-1 win over Kansas March 8.

A STAR-STUDED TRANSFER CLASS

• As announced by D1Softball.com Sept. 5, the Knights' summer 2023 transfer class, which includes junior utility infielder **Stormy Kotzelnick**, redshirt-senior pitcher/designated player **Sona Halajian**, and left-handed pitcher **Ava Justman**, has been ranked the No. 14 such class in the country by the publication entering the spring 2024 campaign.

• UCF's newest transfer class slots in ahead of Houston (No. 15) on D1Softball's rankings and just behind Florida Atlantic (No. 13), Oklahoma State (No. 12) and Texas A&M (No. 11) in the first release of the publication's top 15 poll.

• In **Kotzelnick**, the Knights landed a former All-Sun Belt Second Team, All-Louisiana First Team, NFCA All-Central Region Third Team, and Sun Belt Conference Academic Honor Roll selection. The Carmel, Indiana, native hit for a combined .323/.381/.566 (108-for-334) line with 16 home runs, 189 total bases and 79 RBI in two seasons with the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns after taking a redshirt in her lone season with Washington.

• **Halajian** comes to the Knights on the heels of three seasons with the California Golden Bears, where she compiled a career 4.18 ERA in 303 innings pitched with 204 strikeouts and a pair of shutouts, as well as a .292/.387/.553 (86-for-295) line with 22 home runs, 163 total bases and 68 RBI spanning her last three seasons. She was tabbed as a Second Team All-Pac-12 and a First Team All-Region selection in 2022 as a redshirt-sophomore, and threw 1.2 scoreless innings against the eventual-national champion Oklahoma Sooners during the 2023 NCAA Norman Regional.

• **Justman** also enjoyed an impressive debut season in her first year with the Wisconsin Badgers in 2021, allowing only four earned runs in 15.2 innings of work in relief, translating to an ERA of just 1.79 accompanied by 13 strikeouts. She took on an increased workload during her sophomore 2022 slate, throwing 62.1 innings spanning 17 appearances, including 14 starts. She posted a 3.93 ERA in her first multi-win season, recording a season-high 39 strikeouts and her first three collegiate complete games against Utah, Southern Utah and UCF.
