Conference News & Notes

The Big I2 holds the top two spots and three of the top eight in this week's USA Today/
NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma at No. I, Texas at No. 2 and Oklahoma State at No. 8. Baylor is No. 23 while Kansas received votes.

In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Oklahoma is No. I, Texas is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 10, Baylor is No. 21 and Kansas is No. 24.

In the RPI rankings released on March 26 the Big I2 ranks second in RPI and has all of its teams ranked inside the top IOO. Texas is No. 3, Oklahoma is No. 4, Baylor is No. IO, Oklahoma State is No. I3, Kansas is No. 26, Texas Tech is No. 29, UCF is No. 46, BYU is No. 48, Houston is No. 78 and lowa State is No. 90.

The Conference has the second-highest winning percentage (.772) of any league entering the eighth week of the season.

Oklahoma's Alynah Torres (Player) and Texas' Teagan Kavan (Pitcher) secured weekly league softball honors for the seventh week of the season (March 18-24).

Torres led the Big I2 in home runs (4), RBIs (I0) and total bases (I7) during the week while hitting .625 with a league-leading 2.I25 slugging percentage. The senior helped the Sooners go undefeated during the week including a sweep over then-No. 22/I9 Baylor to keep OU atop the Conference standings with a mark of 9-0.

Kavan started her week with a seven-inning complete-game shutout at UCF. The freshman allowed just five hits and one walk while tossing four strikeouts in the 5-0 Longhorn victory. Entering a 3-I game with two outs in the bottom of the fifth on Sunday, Kavan retired all seven batters to secure her second save of the season. This is Kavan's second Pitcher of the Week honor as she becomes the first Longhorn freshman to win the award twice since Blaire Luna in 2010.

The top four teams in the Big I2 standings are set to face off this week as OU travels to Lawrence for a matchup with Kansas while Oklahoma State hosts Texas in a top IO showdown. Friday's game between the Cowgirls and Longhorns will be featured on ESPN2.

This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big I2 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.

The Phillips 66 Big I2 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-II. All IO teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.

All-Session tickets are now on sale and can be purchased here. New for the 2024 season all lower bowl seats will be reserved seating as the Championship increases to nine games over four days.

ESPN and FOX Sports selected nine league games for national broadcasts this season, including the 2024 Phillips 66 Big I2 Softball Championship Final with a 6:30 p.m. CT start time on ESPN2 on Saturday, May II. The full selection of games can be found on Big12Sports.com.

Entering the week, Baylor has played I4 games against teams with a Top 25 RPI (as of 3/25 RPI rankings). The Bears have won six games against the RPI Top 25, the third most in the Big I2.

BYU's II-8 victory over Oklahoma State was the Cougars' first over a top-IO opponent since 2014.

UCF's pitching staff allowed just 12 runs in three games to a Texas offense that scored close to nine runs per game entering last weekend.

Houston's Turiya Coleman enters the week on a five-game hitting streak.

Ashley Minor recorded a game-high three hits and all three ISU RBIs in the Cyclones' game against Kansas City.

Kansas has secured back-to-back Big I2 sweeps for the first time since 2005. The Jayhawks' seven Conference wins are their most since 2016.

A total attendance of 17,469 saw Oklahoma sweep Baylor over the three-game series, establishing a new program record for the largest attendance of a single series. The first game was played at Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium. During the game, OU's Tiare Jennings broke the Oklahoma record for career doubles (previous mark was 58).

OSU's Tallen Edwards went 3-4 with two doubles and a career-high five RBIs to push the Cowgirls to a IO-2 run-rule victory over BYU in the third game of the series. Oklahoma State has won all three of its Big I2 series this season.

Entering Week 8, Texas has outscored opponents 79-6 in the third inning and is 25-0 this season when scoring first.

Texas Tech's Kailey Wyckoff has a hit in nine of her last II games entering this week.

Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big I2 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.

OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big I2 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).

Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.

Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.

The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason All-Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
