CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 holds three of the top seven spots in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma at No. 1, Texas at No. 4 and Oklahoma State at No. 7. Baylor is No. 25 while Kansas received votes.
- In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Oklahoma is No. 1, Texas is No. 5, Oklahoma State is No. 6 and Baylor is No. 21. Kansas received votes.
- In the RPI rankings released on April 2 the Big 12 ranks second in RPI and is one of three leagues that has all of its teams ranked inside the top 100. Oklahoma is No. 1, Texas is No. 4, Oklahoma State is No. 10, Baylor is No. 14, Kansas is No. 30, Texas Tech is No. 32, UCF is No. 43, BYU is No. 47, Houston is No. 81 and Iowa State is No. 88.
- The Conference has the second-highest non-conference winning percentage (.775) of any league entering the ninth week of the season.
- Oklahoma's Jayda Coleman (Player) and Oklahoma State's Lexi Kilfoyl (Pitcher) collected Big 12 softball weekly awards for the eighth week of the season (March 25-31). Coleman was named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA DI Player of the Week, the fifth time this season a league player has earned the honor while Kilfoyl was announced as the Wilson/NFCA DI Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season.
- Coleman reached in 13 of her 14 plate appearances in the Sooners' three-game sweep of then RV/No. 24 Kansas. The senior drew seven walks, scored eight runs and hit three home runs during the series. Her batting average (.857) was the highest in the Big 12 while her on-base percentage (.929) and slugging percentage (2.143) were the top marks in the country during the week.
- Kilfoyl pitched two complete game shutouts against then No. 2/2 Texas to help OSU take the top 10 series over UT. The two shutouts are the only times this season that the Longhorns have been held scoreless. Kilfoyl did not allow an extra-base hit while striking out 11 and allowed just two walks in her 14.0 innings of work.
- Texas will host Oklahoma this week in a matchup of two teams in the top four of the national rankings and top three of the league standings. Friday's game will be featured on ESPN+ at 5:30 p.m. CT while Saturday's contest will be spotlighted on ESPN at 7 p.m. CT.
- The Big 12 is the only league entering Week 9 to have three teams rank in the top 10 of earned run average (3. Oklahoma-1.40, 4. Texas-1.41, 10. Oklahoma State-1.76).
- This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
- The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-11. All 10 teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.
- All-Session tickets are now on sale and can be purchased [here](#). New for the 2024 season all lower bowl seats will be reserved seating as the Championship increases to nine games over four days.
- ESPN and FOX Sports selected 10 league games for national broadcasts this season, including the 2024 Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship Final with a 6:30 p.m. CT start time on ESPN2 on Saturday, May 11.

Last Friday's 8-5 UCF victory against Texas Tech was Knights' head coach Cindy Ball-Malone's 200th win at the helm of the program. Saturday's 12-9 win was her 300th career victory.



Entering the week, Houston has scored five or more runs in an inning 13 times this season.



Iowa State used a three-run, seventh-inning rally to earn a win over then-No. 23/21 Baylor to secure the Cyclones' first ranked victory of the season.
