### LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

#### FIVE IN A ROW, ANOTHER WALK-OFF AND THE FIRST CONFERENCE SWEEP

- The UCF Knights made history with their 5-4 walk-off win over the BYU Cougars in eight innings Saturday, April 6, as the squad clinched the first Big 12 Conference series sweep in program history with the winning effort, as well as the team's third Big 12 Conference series win, joining the Knights' series wins over Kansas March 8-10 and Texas Tech March 28-30.
- UCF enters its midweek contest against Jacksonville riding a season-long-tying five-game win streak, joining its five straight wins against Kennesaw State, Princeton, Stetson and Kansas March 2-9, and has won seven of its last eight games dating back to the beginning of its road series at Texas Tech March 28.
- The Knights' walk-off win over BYU April 6 also marked UCF's second eight-inning walk-off win of the season, joining its series win-clinching 3-2 win over Kansas March 9.
- Dating back to the beginning of the Knights' recent strong stretch in the series-opener at Texas Tech March 28, the Knights are hitting a collective .381/.447/.562 (86-for-226), outscoring their opposition by an aggregate 61-33 with 26 extra-base hits (17 doubles, 3 triples, 6 home runs).
- The team has also posted a 3.63 ERA in 54 innings pitched in that span, led by right-handers Sarah Willis and Katelyn Cochran. In a team-leading 18.1 innings in UCF's last eight games, Willis has posted a 2.29 ERA (6 ER) with a team-best 13 strikeouts, while Cochran has spun 13 innings, allowing just one earned run (0.54 ERA), striking out 11 and limiting her opposition to a batting average-against of just .140.

#### AUTISM AWARENESS AND ACCEPTANCE

- The Knights on Wednesday host their second Autism Awareness and Acceptance game after the program debuted the game last season against Florida International April 11.
- Returning this year from last year's event is the pregame United in Autism Awareness and Acceptance activity, where fans can follow Knights players' lead in signing their names and tracing their hands on a large banner set up on the concourse. In a special effort to be inclusive and mindful to those in attendance with high sensory sensitivity, the UCF softball program will also hold a silent first inning with no music played or PA announcements, with sound slowly and progressively getting louder throughout the contest. The game's theme will be represented by the players themselves on the field as well, as the team will don specially made pregame warm-up shirts, socks and helmet decals.

#### ONE MORE FOR THE DOUBLES CROWN

- Fifth-year utility player Jada Cody again made history during the Knights' three-game series against BYU April 4-6, doubling in back-to-back games Thursday and Friday to record her 49th and 50th career doubles. With the 50th double of her four-plus-year career, Cody tied Jania Shinhoster (2002-05) atop the UCF all-time career doubles list, and with her next double will become UCF's all-time career doubles leader.

#### COMING THROUGH IN A PINCH

- UCF recorded two hits in pinch-hit at-bats during its series against BYU April 4-6, a single by Kennedy Searcy in the sixth inning April 6 and a double off the bench by Sona Halajian in the sixth inning April 5. The two pinch hits added to the Knights' total of seven in conference play, which leads all Big 12 squads. Texas owns six hits off the bench in conference play, while Oklahoma comes in third in that span with five pinch hits.
- The Knights' 12 pinch hits overall this season are good for a share of third-most in the Big 12 this season with Oklahoma, trailing only Texas (18) and Oklahoma State (16), entering play Sunday, April 7. Junior Savannah Adams leads the Knights with five pinch hits on the season, a mark that ranks second-most in the Big 12 only to Texas' Victoria Hunter (7). Halajian's three pinch hits rank second on the team, and are good for a share of fifth-most in the Big 12.

#### SARAH AND SHANNON BOTH APPROACHING 200

- First baseman Shannon Doherty and right-handed pitcher Sarah Willis both find themselves on the cusp of major program milestones as well. Doherty enters Wednesday's midweek matchup against Jacksonville the owner of 196 hits in her four-plus-year career, and with four more will become the 12th player in program history to reach the 200-hit mark with UCF.
- Willis is also approaching a '200' milestone, as she enters Wednesday with 193 strikeouts in her first year-plus with the Knights, and with seven more strikeouts would become the 9th player in program history to hit the 200-strikeout plateau. Willis has notched 69 punchouts through her first 76 innings this season, and enters Wednesday's action with a strikeouts/7 IP mark of 6.4, the seventh-best mark in the Big 12 Conference.

## KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10, 2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

*"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir*

### MUST BE IN THE NAME

- Knights middle infielder **Aubrey Evans** earned the first walk-off hit, and the second game-ending hit, of her young collegiate career during UCF's weekend series against BYU, plating teammate **Stormy Kotzelnick** with a double in the bottom of the eighth inning Saturday that clinched UCF's first Big 12 Conference series sweep. Aubrey also delivered UCF's run-rule clinching single in the '23 AAC Tournament Title game May 13.
- The win marked UCF's second by way of the walk-off this season, after **Chloe Evans** delivered a walk-off double in the eighth inning to lift the Knights to a 3-2 win over Kansas March 9. Since the beginning of last season, Chloe and Aubrey have combined to record each of UCF's four walk-off hits, after Chloe came through with a walk-off single against South Florida April 21 and a walk-off two-run homer against Boise State Feb. 10.

### STORM WARNING

- Redshirt-junior utility player **Stormy Kotzelnick** has caught fire offensively the last few weeks. The Carmel, Indiana, native recorded her first three-hit game as a Knight during UCF's series finale against BYU April 6, a contest that also featured her first multi-double game since joining the Black and Gold prior to this season.
- The contest represented only the latest Space Game that saw Kotzelnick enjoy a prolific performance at the plate, as she now boasts a .533/.563/.933 (8-for-15) line with four runs scored, three doubles, one home run, six RBI and 14 total bases in her first five Space Games.
- In her last 16 games overall, Kotzelnick has hit safely in 12, hitting .340/.377/.480 (17-for-50) with five runs scored, four doubles, one home run, seven RBI and 24 total bases in that span.

### TWIN BILL SWEEP

- On the heels of its road series win against the Texas Tech Red Raiders, the UCF softball team swept both ends of its most Tuesday doubleheader against the UNF Ospreys April 2, toppling the visitors by respective 11-4 and 9-0 final scores in games one and two at the UCF Softball Complex April 2. With the two Tuesday wins, UCF won four of its previous five games on the heels of its seven-game losing streak.
- The Knights exploded for 20 runs in their doubleheader sweep of the Ospreys, including six extra-base hits, 34 total bases and a collective .420/.491/.680 line (21-for-50). **Sona Halajian** and **Jada Cody** both hit home runs, with the former's representing her first career grand slam, and Cody, **Chloe Evans** and **Samantha Rey** each notched a triple between the two wins as well.

### SONA SLAM

- Sona Halajian's** grand slam, which ended game two of the Knights' twin-bill against North Florida in the bottom of the fifth inning with a 9-0 final score, represented UCF's first grand slam since **Kennedy Searcy's** go-ahead slam in the top of the eighth inning on the road against the Houston Cougars April 22, 2022, which lifted the Black and Gold to their 4-1 victory.
- Her home run marked the Knights' first run-rule-ending grand slam since former UCF catcher and current assistant coach **Cassady Brewer's** grand slam in the bottom of the sixth inning against the UConn Huskies April 30, 2017, also concluding the game with a 9-0 final score.
- Halajian's slam also marked the first run-rule-clinching long ball for the Knights since **Jada Cody's** three-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning of UCF's 11-2 win over FGCU March 5, 2022, and it represented the first grand slam to prove the decider in a run-rule contest since UCF right-hander **Grace Jewell's** pinch-hit grand slam in the top of the fifth inning at FIU Feb. 23, 2022, which at the time gave the Knights an 8-0 advantage in the team's eventual 11-0 victory in five innings.

### JADA JOINS THE ORDER

- In seeing its players receive the most prestigious honor that can be bestowed upon a student at UCF, the UCF softball team has now gone back-to-back. As announced by the university April 2, fifth-year utility player **Jada Cody** has become the third player in program history, and the second in as many years, to be honored with the Order of Pegasus award, as well as the lone student-athlete to be selected in 2024.
- The Order of Pegasus award is given annually to those who display incredible academic achievement, university involvement, leadership and community service, and Cody joins **Shannon Doherty** (2023) and **Shelly Frick** (2010) as the third Knights softball player to receive the honor.

### AMONG THE FINEST IN THE FIELD

- On the heels of the Knights' series sweep against BYU, UCF's .980 fielding percentage ranks second in both the Big 12 Conference and sixth the nation, trailing Oklahoma (.986), UIW (.981), Arizona (.981), Omaha (.981) and Boston (.980).
- Entering play Tuesday, the team's eight total double plays turned in conference play were good for a share of first in the Big 12 with Kansas and Texas. In conference play, the Knights' 308 putouts ranked first in the Big 12, and their 143 assists ranked second in the conference behind Oklahoma's 148.

### COCHRAN KEEPS ROLLING

- Knights sophomore right-hander **Katelyn Cochran** turned in yet another dazzling performance in the circle in game two of UCF's Tuesday twin-bill, tossing a run-rule-shortened five-inning, one-hit, complete-game shutout to record her first collegiate win.
- Cochran's five innings bested her previous single-game career-high she set in her previous appearance at Texas Tech March 30, when she threw 4.2 innings of one-hit ball, and the sophomore later nailed down her second collegiate save against BYU April 5, tossing 2.2 innings of one-run ball with three strikeouts in relief.
- Dating back to her two-inning relief appearance against then-No. 2 Texas March 22, Cochran has spun 18 innings, second on the team only to Sarah Willis' 23, while yielding only one run on 10 hits with 14 strikeouts, translating to a .167 batting average-against in her six appearances (one start), including one complete game.

### COACH BEAR CLINCHES 200, THEN 300

- Head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone** reached a pair of significant career milestones in the Knights' series win over the Red Raiders, notching the 200th win of her UCF head coaching career in the Black and Gold's series-opening 8-5 win Thursday night, before earning her overall 300th head coaching victory with the Knights' 12-9 win in game two Friday evening. Entering UCF's Wednesday contest against Jacksonville, Coach Bear owns a career 206-95-2 (.683) record in five-plus seasons with UCF, and a career 305-211-2 (.591) head coaching record in nine-plus seasons.
- Ball-Malone beat her predecessor, **Renee Gillispie**, to the 200 UCF wins mark, needing just 296 games to reach the milestone against the 344 Gillispie needed to reach 200 wins in her sixth season at the helm of the Knights in 2007.

### WILLIS' HISTORIC START

- In throwing her first seven-inning complete game of the season in the series-opener against Kansas March 8, right-hander **Sarah Willis** accomplished a feat that hadn't been achieved by a Knight in close to 10 years. The senior right-hander also drove in two runs at the plate in UCF's 7-1 victory, making her the first Knights pitcher to throw a complete game and record multiple RBI in the same game since 2014.
- Lena Springer** (2014) last accomplished the feat in the Black and Gold's 12-5 win at UConn May 4, allowing five runs (four earned) with six strikeouts in seven innings pitched while also going 2-for-4 with a run scored and a two-run double in the fifth inning. Newly-minted Knights Hall-of-Famer **Shelby Turnier** (2013-16) also hit both marks in the same game in 2014, yielding two runs on three hits with 11 strikeouts in seven innings while also going 1-for-2 with a walk and a two-run triple in the fifth inning of the Knights' 4-2 win over Jacksonville at home March 5.

### STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY STRONG

- Against Kansas March 8, the Knights extended a decade-long streak of beginning conference play with a win. UCF has now won its conference-opener in each of the last 10 seasons dating back to March 22, 2014's 1-0 win over Memphis (excluding the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season), and the Black and Gold last year earned a top-25 win over the then-No. 22 Wichita State Shockers by a 3-1 score March 24 to begin their final conference season as a member of the American Athletic Conference.

### HOME RUN HISTORY

- First baseman **Shannon Doherty** and utility player **Jada Cody** both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin Feb. 16, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer **Stephanie Best's** career total of 71 from 2002-05. Cody enters the Knights' Wednesday tilt against Jacksonville the owner of 37 home runs in her four-plus-year career.

### HALAJIAN'S HEROICS

- Knights right-handed pitcher/designated player **Sona Halajian** produced a strong showing in the Knights' series finale against the No. 4 Oklahoma State Cowgirls March 17, throwing four innings of one-run ball in relief while also hitting a key three-run home run in the top of the sixth inning off of Oklahoma State right-hander **Lexi Kilfoyl** that trimmed the Cowgirls' lead to 5-4 at the time.
- Halajian's home run represented just the third long ball allowed by Kilfoyl through her first 64.1 innings pitched this spring, and prior to the three run shot, Kilfoyl had yielded just one earned run in her previous 50 innings pitched dating back to her seven-inning complete game shutout on the road at No. 16 Florida Feb. 19.
