CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 holds three of the top five spots in this week's USA Today/NFCA Division 1 Top 25 Coaches Poll with Oklahoma at No. 1, Texas at No. 2 and Oklahoma State at No. 5. Baylor and Kansas each received votes.
- In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Texas is No. 1, Oklahoma is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 5 and Baylor is No. 24. Kansas and UCF each received votes.
- The Conference is the only league to have three teams in the top five of both polls.
- In the RPI rankings released April 9, the Big 12 ranks second in RPI and is one of three leagues that has all of its teams ranked inside the top 100. Texas is No. 1, Oklahoma is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 7, Baylor is No. 17, Kansas is No. 30, UCF is No. 34, Texas Tech is No. 37, BYU is No. 63, Houston is No. 77 and Iowa State is No. 93.
- The Big 12 is the only league with three teams inside the top seven of the RPI (as of April 9).
- The Conference has the second-highest non-conference winning percentage (.776) of any league entering the 10th week of the season.
- The league has a 29-27 (.518) mark against other Power Five conferences this season.
- Oklahoma State's Caroline Wang (Player) and Texas' Estelle Czech (Pitcher) collected weekly Conference honors for their efforts during the ninth week of the season (April 1-7).
- Both student-athletes also earned national honors as Wang was named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA Player of the Week while Czech was selected as the Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week. This is the second consecutive week the Big 12 has swept both awards and the third overall time this season.
- In the three games at Houston, Wang went a combined 7-for-9 (.778) with two doubles, four home runs and 10 RBIs. In Sunday's 10-2 OSU victory, the senior became the first Cowgirl to record seven RBIs in a game since Madi Sue Simpson on Feb. 22, 2019.
- Against an Oklahoma offense that entered last weekend leading the nation with a .394 team batting average and a Big 12-leading 9.20 runs per game, Czech tossed six scoreless innings in her two appearances. The senior helped the Longhorns become the first team to take a league series over OU since 2011 while being the only qualified Big 12 pitcher in Week 9 to not surrender a run.
- The Big 12 is the only league entering Week 10 to have three teams rank in the top 10 of earned run average (3. Oklahoma-1.47, 4. Texas-1.50, 10. Oklahoma State-1.70).
- Kansas' 10 Conference wins are its most since 2001.
- Baylor and Texas are featured nationally this week with an ESPN2 broadcast set for Saturday's game in Austin between the two schools.
- The Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship returns to Oklahoma City's USA Softball Hall of Fame Stadium at OGE Energy Field, the home of the Women's College World Series, from May 8-11. All 10 teams will compete in the single-elimination format with the top six finishing regular season teams receiving a first-round bye.
- All-Session tickets are now on sale and can be purchased [here](#). New for the 2024 season all lower bowl seats will be reserved seating as the Championship increases to nine games over four days.

UCF clinched the first Big 12 Conference series sweep in program history after taking three games from BYU. The Knights enter the week with the No. 9 strength of schedule in the country.



Houston's Jazmyn Rollin posted her second multi-home run game against a top 10 team this season, with a pair against Oklahoma State on Sunday. She also hit two home runs in Houston's 12-10 win over Texas on March 8.



After nine weeks, Iowa State's Angelina Allen ranks third among Big 12 hitters with her .444 batting average. Allen's 52 hits lead league players entering the week.



Kansas has swept three Big 12 opponents this season for the first time since 2005.



Oklahoma's Tiare Jennings' has a 17-game on-base streak entering the week with a nine-game hitting streak.



OSU's Lexi Kilfoyl is the only Big 12 pitcher with an ERA under 1.00 (0.84) after nine weeks.



Texas' series win over OU was the Longhorns' first over the Sooners since 2009.

Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntlyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.



Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.



The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason All-Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.



This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
