• The Knights' series finale in Houston April 14 saw a pair of Knights reach significant career milestones and continue climbing the program's all-time record lists. First baseman **Shannon Doherty** recorded the 200th hit of her Knights career with her first-inning single, becoming the 12th player in program history to eclipse the 200-hit milestone. Doherty enters UCF's Wednesday midweek contest against FAU tied with **Amber Lamb** (2004-07) for 11th on the program's all-time hits list (200).

• Right-handed pitcher **Sarah Willis** reached her own milestone in the bottom of the first inning, notching the 200th strikeout of her Knights career. With the punchout, the senior became the ninth pitcher in program history to reach 200 strikeouts at UCF.

### ONE MORE FOR THE DOUBLES CROWN

Fifth-year utility player Jada Cody again made history during the Knights' three-game series against BYU April 4-6, doubling in back-to-back
games Thursday and Friday to record her 49th and 50th career doubles. With the 50th double of her four-plus-year career, Cody tied Jania
Shinhoster (2002-05) atop the UCF all-time career doubles list, and with her next double will become UCF's all-time career doubles leader.

### KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10.2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II. the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC. Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

### NENE'S SPARK IN THE LEADOFF SPOT

Center fielder Johneisha Rowe is enjoying a career season throughout her first 40 games this spring, as she brings a .402 average (39-for-97) into Wednesday's contest against FAU, good for the highest mark on the team (min. 50 ÅB). Her .402 mark would represent her highest season 963 batting average since the .481 average she posted during her freshman 442 debut season at FGCU in 2020, and she has excelled in her most recent role as the Knights' leadoff hitter.

 Since she was appointed UCF's regular atop the lineup in UCF's nightcap against North Florida April 2, Rowe is hitting .500/.560/.500 (11-for-22) with 10 runs scored, three walks and six stolen bases in six tries in eight games. Her .500 average in that span leads the squad among players with at least 20 at-bats in that span.

### KENNEDY SEARCY, PINCH HIT EXTRAORDINAIRE

• As she works her way back from an injury she sustained during the 2024 Knights Classic Tournament March 1 against Princeton, senior utility player Kennedy Searcy has quickly become one of the Knights' most reliable bats off the bench.

 Searcy most recently came through for her team in UCF's seriesopener in Houston April 12, clinching the Knights' run-rule victory with a two-run single in the top of the sixth inning that gave the Black and Gold a 9-0 advantage.

 The hit off the bench came in Searcy's seventh pinch-hit plate appearance since UCF's series-opener against then-No. 2 Texas March 22, a span in which the senior has made just one out. Since becoming available as a pinch-hit option, Searcy has gone 3-for-4 (.750) with 4 RBI and 3 walks, including Friday's 2-run single and a go-ahead 2-run single that proved instrumental in the Knights' 8-5 comeback win at Texas Tech March 28.

### COMING THROUGH IN A PINCH

• UCF recorded two hits in pinch-hit at-bats during its series against Houston April 12-14, a single by **Kennedy Searcy** in the sixth inning April 12 and a home run off the bench by Sona Halajian in the fourth inning April 13. The two pinch hits added to the Knights' total of 10 in conference play, which leads all Big 12 squads. Texas and Houston both own six hits off the bench in conference play, while Oklahoma comes in fourth in that span with five pinch hits.

• The Knights' 15 pinch hits overall this season are good for third-most in the Big 12 this season, trailing only Texas (18) and Oklahoma State 15-3/2nd (16), entering play Wednesday, April 17. Junior Savannah Adams leads the Knights with five pinch hits on the season, a mark that ranks second-most in the Big 12 only to Texas' Victoria Hunter (7). Halajian's four pinch hits rank second on the team, and are good for a share of third-most in the Big 12.

### JADA JOINS THE ORDER

 In seeing its players receive the most prestigious honor that can be bestowed upon a student at UCF, the UCF softball team has now gone back-to-back. As announced by the university April 2, fifth-year utility player Jada Cody has become the third player in program history, and the second in as many years, to be honored with the Order of Pegasus award, as well as the lone student-athlete to be selected in 2024. • The Order of Pegasus award is given annually to those who display incredible academic achievement, university involvement, leadership and community service, and Cody joins Shannon Doherty (2023) and Shelly Frick (2010) as the third Knights softball player to receive the honor.

### AMONG THE FINEST IN THE FIELD

• On the heels of the Knights' series sweep against Houston, UCF's .980 fielding percentage ranks third in the Big 12 Conference and sixth the nation, trailing Oklahoma (.985), Omaha (.981), Arizona (.981), Oklahoma State (.981) and Seton Hall (.981).

 Entering play Wednesday, the team's 11 total double plays turned in conference play led all Big 12 programs. In conference play, the Knights' 362 putouts ranked second in the Big 12, and their 163 assists also ranked second in the conference behind Oklahoma's 167.

### MUST BE IN THE NAME

 Knights middle infielder Aubrey Evans earned the first walk-off hit, and the second game-ending hit, of her young collegiate career during UCF's series against BYU April 4-6, plating teammate Stormy Kotzelnick with a double in the bottom of the eighth inning Saturday that clinched UCF's first Big 12 Conference series sweep. Aubrev also delievered UCF's run-rule clinching single in the '23 AAC Tournament Title game May 13. The win marked UCF's second by way of the walk-off this season, after Chloe Evans delivered a walk-off double in the eighth inning to lift the Knights to a 3-2 win over Kansas March 9. Since the beginning of last season, Chloe and Aubrey have combined to record each of UCF's four walk-off hits, after Chloe came through with a walk-off single against South Florida April 21 and a walk-off two-run homer against Boise State Feb. 10.

### COACH BEAR CLINCHES 200, THEN 300

 Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone reached a pair of significant career milestones in the Knights' series win over the Texas Tech Red Raiders March 28-30, notching the 200th win of her UCF head coaching career in the Black and Gold's series-opening 8-5 win Thursday night, before earning her overall 300th head coaching victory with the Knights' 12-9 win in game two Friday evening. Entering UCF's Wednesday contest against FAU, Coach Bear owns a career 210-95-2 (.687) record in five-plus seasons with UCF, and a career 309-211-2 (.594) head coaching record in nine-plus seasons.

 Ball-Malone beat her predecessor, Renee Gillispie, to the 200 UCF wins mark, needing just 296 games to reach the milestone against the 344 Gillispie needed to reach 200 wins in her sixth season at the helm of the Knights in 2007.

### SONA SLAM

• Sona Halajian's grand slam, which ended game two of the Knights' twin-bill against North Florida April 2 in the bottom of the fifth inning with a 9-0 final score, represented UCF's first grand slam since Kennedy **Searcy**'s go-ahead slam in the top of the eighth inning on the road against the Houston Cougars April 22, 2022, which lifted the Black and

Gold to their 4-1 victory. • Her home run marked the Knights' first run-rule-ending grand slam since former UCF catcher and current assistant coach Cassady Brewer's grand slam in the bottom of the sixth inning against the UConn Huskies April 30, 2017, also concluding the game with a 9-0 final score. Halajian's slam also marked the first run-rule-clinching long ball for the Knights since Jada Cody's three-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning of UCF's 11-2 win over FGCU March 5, 2022, and it represented the first grand slam to prove the decider in a run-rule contest since UCF right-hander Grace Jewell's pinch-hit grand slam in the top of the fifth

inning at FIU Feb. 23, 2022, which at the time gave the Knights an 8-0

advantage in the team's eventual 11-0 victory in five innings.

### HALAJIAN'S HEROICS

 Knights right-handed pitcher/designated player Sona Halaiian produced a strong showing in the Knights' series finale against the No. 4 Oklahoma State Cowgirls March 17, throwing four innings of one-run ball in relief while also hitting a key three-run home run in the top of the sixth inning off of Oklahoma State right-hander Lexi Kilfoyl that trimmed the Cowgirls' lead to 5-4 at the time.

 Halajian's home run represented just the third long ball allowed by Kilfoyl through her first 64.1 innings pitched this spring, and prior to the three run shot. Kilfovl had vielded just one earned run in her previous 50 innings pitched dating back to her seven-inning complete game shutout on the road at No. 16 Florida Feb. 19.

### WILLIS' HISTORIC START

• In throwing her first seven-inning complete game of the season in the series-opener against Kansas March 8, right-hander Sarah Willis accomplished a feat that hadn't been achieved by a Knight in close to 10 years. The senior right-hander also drove in two runs at the plate in UCF's 7-1 victory, making her the first Knights pitcher to throw a complete game and record multiple RBI in the same game since 2014. Lena Springer (2014) last accomplished the feat in the Black and Gold's 12-5 win at UConn May 4, allowing five runs (four earned) with six strikeouts in seven innings pitched while also going 2-for-4 with a run scored and a two-run double in the fifth inning. Newly-minted Knights Hall-of-Famer Shelby Turnier (2013-16) also hit both marks in the same game in 2014, vielding two runs on three hits with 11 strikeouts in seven innings while also going 1-for-2 with a walk and a two-run triple in the fifth inning of the Knights' 4-2 win over Jacksonville at home March 5.

### STARTING CONFERENCE PLAY STRONG

 Against Kansas March 8, the Knights extended a decade-long streak of beginning conference play with a win. UCF has now won its conferenceopener in each of the last 10 seasons dating back to March 22, 2014's 1-0 win over Memphis (excluding the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season). and the Black and Gold last year earned a top-25 win over the then-No. 22 Wichita State Shockers by a 3-1 score March 24 to begin their final conference season as a member of the American Athletic Conference.

### HOME RUN HISTORY

 First baseman Shannon Doherty and utility player Jada Cody both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin Feb. 16, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer Stephanie Best's career total of 71 from 2002-05. Cody enters the Knights' Wednesday tilt against FAU the owner of 37 home runs in her four-plus-year career.
